



Kawaii Cupcake

No. 1011-202-8722

Level: Experienced **Crochet Hook:** 3.5 mm

Materials: Sewing pins, black embroidery thread, filling, stitch marker, a small piece of cardboard, size 7 mm safety eyes, sewing

thread, sewing needle

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/8 White (#01) - 1 skein

Antique Rose (#61) - 1 skein Light Pink (#62) - 1 skein Pastel Yellow (#53) - 1 skein

Red (#58) - 1 skein

Light Green (#19) - 1 skein

Abbreviations:

st: stitch

ch: chain stitch **sc:** single crochet

1 inc: crochet 2 single crochet into same

stitch

1 dec: crochet 2 stitches together

sl: slip stitch

hdc: half double crochet

Tip!

Place a stitch marker or a safety pin in the first stitch so you can keep track of where the round starts.

A chopstick is a handy tool to have on hand when you need to stuff the cupcake firmly.

CUPCAKE LINER Using Antique Rose

Start with a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)

Round 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Round 3: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Round 4: [2 sc, 1 inc] x6 (24)

Round 5: Into the back loop of the stitch, 24 sc (24)

Round 6: 24 sc (24)

Round 7: [3 sc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

Rounds 8-9: 30 sc (2 rounds, 30)

Round 10: [4 sc, 1 inc] x6 (36)

Round 11: 36 sc (36)

Turn the liner so the opening faces you. Now you will again crochet into the back loops.

Round 12: *Into the back loop of the stitch,* [4 hdc into the same st, skip 1 st, 1 sl, skip 1 st] repeat to end of round.

Weave in the ends. Place the bottom onto a piece of cardboard, draw around it and cut it out. this little round piece will be placed at the bottom of your cupcake so that it can stand up straight.

Attach the safety eyes. Place them between rounds 9 and 10 with a 5 st gap in between. Embroider a black mouth and cheeks using Light Pink yarn.

CUPCAKE

Using Pastel Yellow

Now you will crochet into the front loop of the stitches of your cupcake liner.

Rounds 1-3: 36 sc (3 rounds, 36m)

Round 4: [4 sc, 1 dec] x6 (30)

Place the cardboard piece at the bottom.

Round 5: [3 sc, 1 dec] x6 (24)

Round 6: [2 sc, 1 dec] x6 (18)

Stuff the cupcake with filling

Round 7: [1 sc, 1 dec] x6 (12)

Round 8: [1 dec] x6 (6)

Break the yarn and weave in the ends.

FROSTING

Using White

Start with a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)



Round 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Round 3: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Round 4: [2 sc, 1 inc] x6 (24)

Round 5: [3sc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

Round 6: [4 hdc into the same st, skip 1 st, 1 sl, skip 1 st] repeat to end of round.

Finish with 1 sl. Break the yarn and leave a long tail for assembly.

Sew the frosting onto the top of your cupcake.

CREAM

Using White

Start with a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)

Round 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Round 3: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Round 4: Into the front loop of the stitch [4 sc into the same st] repeat to end of round.

Finish with 1 sl. Break the yarn and leave a long tail for assembly.

Sew the cream onto the top of your frosting.

STRAWBERRY

Using Red

Start with a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)

Round 2: 6 sc (6)

Round 3: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Rounds 4-5: 12 sc (2 rounds, 12 sts)

Fill the strawberry with filling.

Round 6: Into the back loop of the stitch, [1 dec] x6 (6)

Sew the hole shut and weave in the ends.

STRAWBERRY LEAF

Using Light Green

Make a magic ring but don't tighten it completely.

[Ch 3, 1 sc into the 2nd ch st from the needle, 1 sc, 1 sl into the magic ring] Repeat for a total of 5 times.

Break the yarn and leave a long tail for assembly.

Sew the leaf onto the strawberry.

Sew the strawberry onto the top of the cream.

Finished!
