RAGLAN SWEATER WITH STRIPES

SIZES: 1-2 YEARS (3-4 YEARS) 5-6 YEARS (7-8 YEARS) 9-10 YEARS (11-12 YEARS)

STRIPED SWEATER - 8 COLOURS

Knit ribbing in all sizes in Colour 2 (Grey), and thereafter: Colour 1 (Light grey): 2 r all sizes. Colour 3 (Off-white): 18 (19) 21 (23) 25 (26) r. Colour 1 (Light grey): 2 r all sizes. Colour 4 (Old rose): 18 (19) 21 (23) 25 (26) r. Colour 1 (Light grey): 2 r all sizes. Colour 5 (White): 18 (19) 21 (23) 25 (26) r. Colour 1 (Light grey): 2 r all sizes. Colour 6 (Spring green): 18 (19) 21 (23) 25 (26) r. Colour 1 (Light grey): 2 r all sizes. (on 2nd r close armhole in all sizes) Colour 7 (Kit): 18 (19) 21 (23) 25 (26) r. Colour 1 (Light grey): 2 r all sizes. Colour 8 (Curry): 18 (19) 21 (23) 25 (26) r. Colour 1 (Light grey): 2 r all sizes.

UK

The Sweater is worked on circular knitting needles, from the bottom up.

BACK AND FRONT

Cast on **156 (176) 184 (196) 208 (216)** sts on 2,5 mm N with Colour 2 (Grey). Knit in rib stitch - k2, p2 - in total **12 (12) 14 (14) 16 (16)** r.

Change to 3,0 mm N and place a M at the beginning of the r as well as after **78 (88) 92 (98) 104 (108)** sts. Knit stripes as directed. The work now measures approx. **26 (27) 30 (33) 35 (37)** cm incl. ribbing.

For armhole bind off 4 sts on each side of M (all sizes). In total **140 (160) 168 (180) 192 (200)** sts.

Set work aside.

SLEEVES

Cast on **44 (44) 48 (48) 52 (52)** sts on 2,5 mm DPNs in Colour 2 (Grey). Knit in rib stitch - k2, p2 - in total **12 (12) 14 (14) 16 (16)** r.

Change to 3,0 mm N and place a M at the beginning of the r.

Knit stripes as directed - AT THE SAME TIME increase every **8th (8th) 8th (8th) 8th (7th)** r - in total **8 (8) 9 (12) 12 (15)** times by knitting as follows: k1, pick up 1 st from the front through the previous row and ktbl.

Knit until last st, pick up 1 st through the previous row on the back and k, k1.

The work now measures approx. **26 (27) 30 (33) 35 (37)** cm incl. ribbing.

For armhole bind off 4 sts on each side of M (all sizes).

In total **52 (52) 58 (64) 68 (74)** sts. Set work aside and knit the second sleeve.

YOKE

Gather the parts together knitting k2tog at the meeting points.

Continue the stripes as directed. In total **240 (260) 280 (304) 324 (344)** sts. A marker (M) is placed before and after each k2tog forming a center st for each raglan part. The round begins between the back and a sleeve.

Knit **3** (**3**) **3** (**3**) **r** stockinette st and continue with raglan decreases every 2nd r (*REMEMBER: start with* 1 r without decrease, then 1 r with decrease, to make the stripe pattern appear properly) by working PSSO after the central st and k2tog before the central st.

Repeat decreases in total 17 (18) 20 (22) 24 (25) times

- altogether **104 (116) 120 (128) 132 (144)** sts. Knit 1 r *(this is the 2nd last r of the stripe pattern).* On the following and last r of the stripe pattern, decrease evenly to **92 (96) 108 (120) 120 (132)** sts.

NECKLINE

Change to 2,5 mm N and Colour 2 (Grey). Knit 1 r and then ribbing - k2, p2 - in total **10 (10) 12 (12) 14 (14)** r. Bind off.

FINISHING

Sew together under the sleeves. Weave in all ends.



Good to know

Needle Size & Tension

Knitters knit very differently: some knit with a needle size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design quality as a person who knits with a needle size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of knitters who join us. The key to knit a specific size is a lot about the knitting style/hands/skills, rather than the size of needles. Therefore, we will recommend a range of needle sizes.
