



# Tusindfryd - Baby Blanket

## Materials

1 skein Sultan Deluxe col 32

Double pointed needles 3.5 mm  
Circular needles 80, 100 and 150 cm/ 3.5 mm  
Stitch markers

## Yarn

**Sultan Deluxe**, Cottons Kings  
100% cotton/ 250 g = 1000 meters

## Gauge

24 sts og 36 rows for 10 cm in pattern

## Measurements

90 x 90 cm

## Pattern information

Begin on the double pointed needles. Work in the round and switch to circular needles as the work grows, using the magic loop technique until there are enough sts to work in the round. Switch to the longer circular needles when needed.

Increases are made by making a yarn over, then working it as a stitch on the next round. Every fourth round is purled.

## Pattern instructions

Cast on 6 sts on 2 double pointed needles and work flat.

Work 8 rows of stockinette stitch, starting with the first row purled.

Continue working in the round using all 5 double pointed needles.

### **Now, pick up sts along the edge of the small square as such:**

Pick up 6 sts along the left side of the square, 6 sts along the cast-on edge, and 6 sts along the right side = 4 x 6 sts = 24 sts in total.

Here is the beginning of the round. Place a marker

Round 1: \*yo, p6\*, repeat between \*\* until end of round = 4 yo's = 4 increases.

Round 2: \*yo, k1, yo, k6\*, repeat between \*\* until end of round = 4 x 9 sts = 36 sts.

Round 3: Knit.

Round 4: \*yo, k1, yo, k8\*, repeat between \*\* until end of round = 8 sts increased = 44 sts.

Place a marker **around** the st between increases (the 2nd st of every row) = 4 markers.

Switch to 80 cm circular needles and work using the magic loop technique.

### **From here on, work pattern with increases:**

Round 1: Purl.

Round 2: \*knit until the marked st, yo, k1, yo\*, repeat between \*\* until end of round.

Round 3: Knit.

Round 4: \*knit until the marked st, yo, k1, yo\*, repeat between \*\* until end of round.

Repeat these 4 rounds.

Switch to 100 cm /150 cm circular needles as needed.

When the blanket measures about 43 cm from the middle to the edge:

Work 6 rounds of garter stitch (1 round purled, 1 round knit) while continuing the increases on every other row

Bind off loosely, cut the yarn and weave in ends.
