



Havbrise - Bag

Materials:

Rainbow 8/8 - col. 73 and 91
Rainbow 8/4 - col. 91 - for straps
Prym "Liv" leather bag base
Crochet hook 3 mm
Carabiner 48 mm
Knitting mill

Yarn usage:

Color A: 110g (3 skeins)
Color B: 80g (2 skeins)
Straps: 20g

Measurements: About 25 cm in diameter, 28 cm tall (laying flat)

Abbreviations:

st(s): stitch(es)
ch: chain stitch
sc: single crochet
hdc: half double crochet
b-bl: bottom back loop of stitch
sl st: slip stitch
SPsc: spike stitch

NOTE:

From round 2, every round is started with ch 2. These do not take the place of any sts, neither do they count towards the st total.

Every round is ended with a sl st from the back into the second ch from the beginning of the round. This is a regular sl st, but is worked from the back instead of the front, as usually done. This makes the join between rounds and color changes less noticeable. The join will still pull a bit and lean to one side, as you are working in the round. See the guide with pictures at the end of the pattern instructions.

Pattern instructions – Guide with pictures at the end of the instructions

The bag is made using 8/8 cotton yarn.

1. Use color A. Loop the yarn through a st/loop in the edge of the bag base. Ch 1, then sc into every st/loop around the bag base. Finish round with a sl st. (114)
2. Ch 2. Hcd in every st of the round. End round with a sl st from the back. (114)
3. Switch to color B. Ch 2, then hdc into the b-bl of every st until end of round. Join round with a sl st from the back. (114)
4. Switch to color A. Ch 2, then hdc into the b-bl of every st until end of round. Join round with a sl st from the back. (114)

Repeat rounds 3 and 4 until you have 34 rounds in total.

35. Continue in color A. Ch 1, then sc into b-bl of every st of the round. Join round with a sl st from the back. (114)
36. Ch 1. SPsc into the next 26 sts. SPsc into the next 5 sts, working around a d-ring to attach it. SPsc into the next 52 sts. SPsc into the next 5 sts, working around another d-ring to attach it. SPsc into the next 26 sts. Join the round with a sl st. (114)
37. Work sl st into every st of the round. (114) Cut yarn and weave in ends.

Straps:

Using the knitting mill and the Rainbow 8/4 yarn, make 5 i-cords of about 65 cm each. Sew them together and attach them as pictured below:



1. Using the knitting mill and the Rainbow 8/4 yarn, make 5 i-cords of about 65 cm each.



2. Sew the ends of the 5 i-cords together.



3. Thread the cords through the d-ring of the carabiner.



4. Sew the cords around the d-ring.



5. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



6. Repeat the same steps for the other end.



7. Clip the carabiners to the d-rings crocheted to the bag.



8. Like so.

Guide:

Round 1



1. Use color A. Loop the yarn through a st/loop in the edge of the bag base.



2. Ch 1, then sc into every st/loop around the bag base.

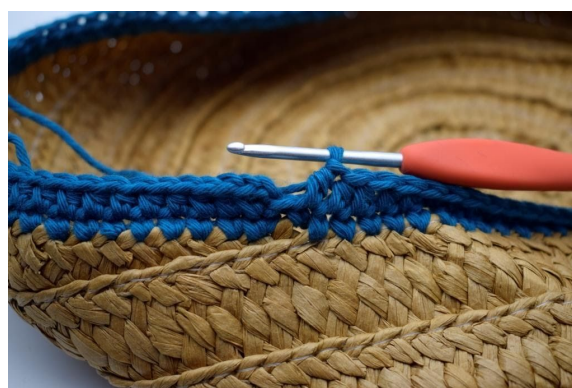


3. Finish round with a sl st. (114)

Round 2



1. Ch 2.



2. Hdc in every st of the round.



3. Join round with a sl st from the back. Lift the loop off the hook and thread the hook through the 2nd ch from the beginning of the round as shown in the picture.



4. Catch your loop.



5. Pull the loop through the st. You have now made a sl st from the back. (114)

Round 3



1. Switch to color B. Ch 2.



2. Now make a hdc in the b-bl. The bottom back loop is the loop that is shown when you tip your work a bit towards you. It is just behind the two loops you normally work through. The needle in the picture shows where you should make your first hdc.



3. Like so.



4. Make a hdc in the b-bl of the next st.



5. Like so.



6. Repeat this all the way around.



7. Join your round with a sl st from the back. Slip your loop off the hook, thread the hook from the back through the 2nd ch from the beginning.



8. Catch your loop and pull through the st.



9. Like so. (114)

Round 4



1. Switch to color A.



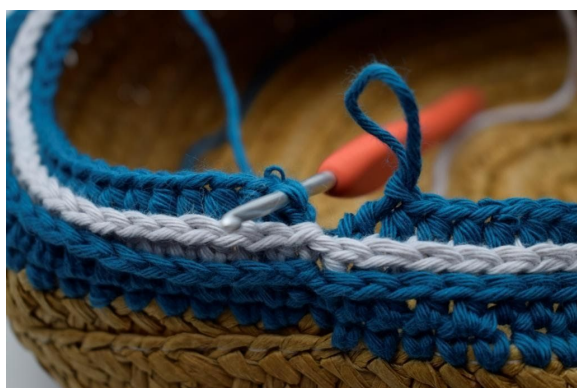
2. Make a hdc in the b-bl of the first st.



3. Like so.



4. Repeat the hdc in the b-bl of the sts until end of round.

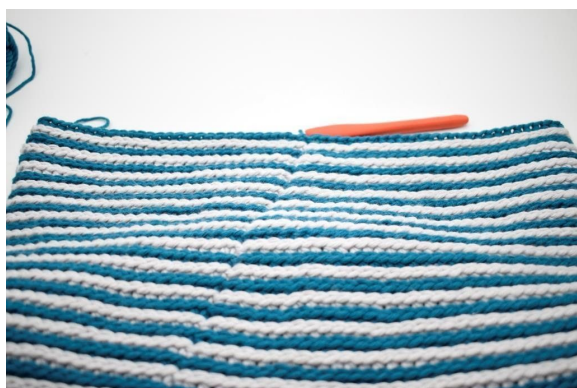


5. Join round with a sl st from the back.



6. Like so. (114)

Round 5 to 34



1. Repeat rounds 3 and 4 until you have 34 rounds in total.

Round 35



1. Continue in color A. Ch 1,



2. then sc into b-bl of every st of the round.
Join round with a sl st from the back. (114).

Round 36



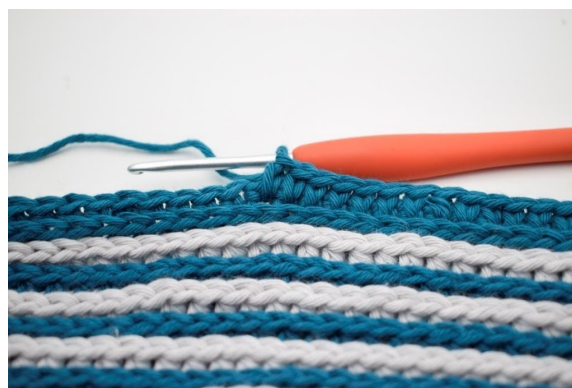
1. Ch 1.



2. SPsc into the next st. A SPsc is a sc that is worked into the st below the one you would normally work in. The needle shows where to work your first SPsc.



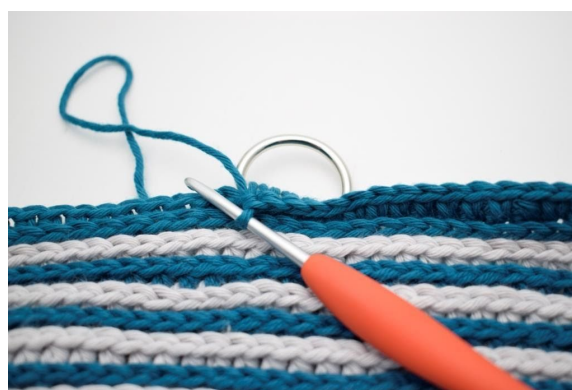
3. Like so.



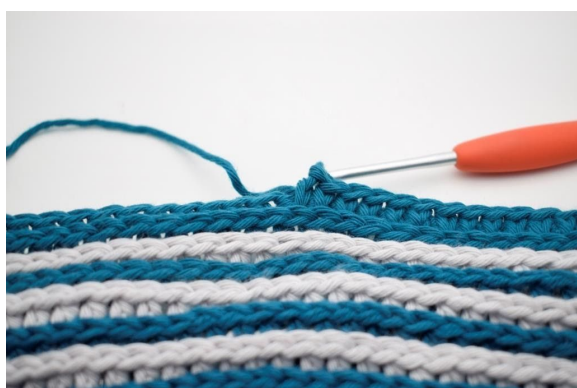
4. SPsc into the next 25 sts.



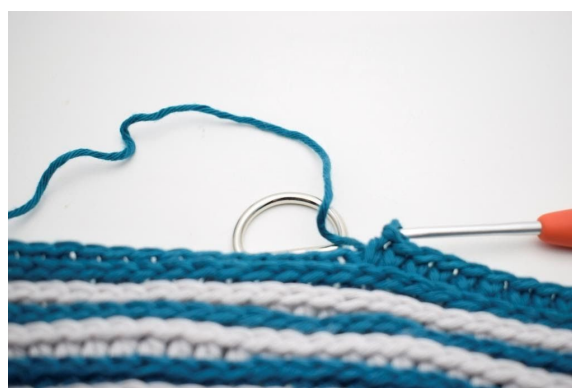
5. SPsc into the next 5 sts, working around a d-ring to attach it.



6. Like so.



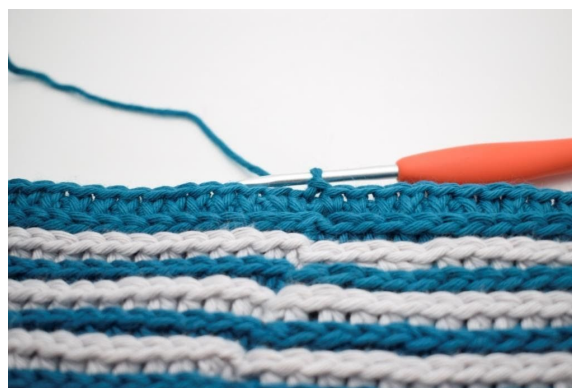
7. SPsc into the next 52 sts.



8. SPsc into the next 5 sts, working around another d-ring to attach it.

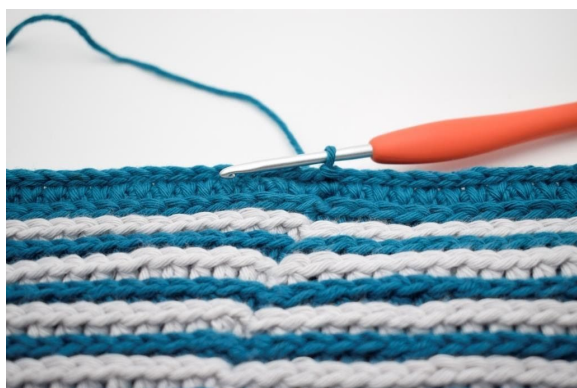


9. Like so.

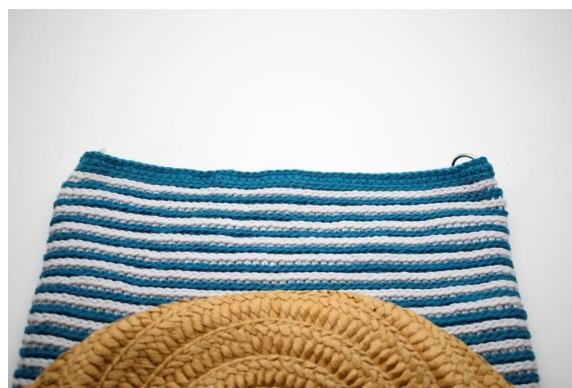


10. SPsc into the next 26 sts. Join the round with a sl st. (114).

Round 37



1. Sl st in every sts of the round. (114)



2. Cut yarn and weave in ends.
