



## Bunny – Snuggle Rag

No. 1020-202-6828

**Skill level:** Intermediate

**Crochet hook:** E/4 (3.5 mm)

**Materials:** Grey 8/4 cotton yarn for the snout, black 8/4 cotton yarn for eyes, filling

**Yarn:** Rainbow Organic 8/8

**Old Rose (#46)** - 2 skeins

**Hvid (#01)** - 2 skeins

**Abbreviations:**

sc = single crochet

sl st = slip stitch

mr = magic ring

inc = increase

dec = decrease

rnds = rounds

(xx) = brackets after the round = number of stitches after finished round

ch = chain

**Info:** All parts are worked in spiral.

### Tips:

Fill the head firmly.  
Work tightly to avoid holes between the stitches.

### Head:

In white

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr.  
Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12)  
Rnd 3: 1 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (18)  
Rnd 4: 2 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (24)  
Rnd 5: 3 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (30)  
Rnd 6: 4 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (36)  
Rnd 7: 5 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (42)  
Rnd 8: 6 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (48)  
**Rnd 9-17:** 1 sc in every sc (48) All in all 9 rnds.

Fill the head with filling while you work.

Rnd 18: 6 sc, dec. Rep 6 times (42)  
Rnd 19: 5 sc, dec. Rep 6 times (36)  
Rnd 20: 4 sc, dec. Rep 6 times (30)  
Rnd 21: 3 sc, dec. Rep 6 times (24)  
Rnd 22: 2 sc, dec. Rep 6 times (18)  
Rnd 23: 1 sc, dec. Rep 6 times (12)  
Rnd 24: 2 sc, dec. Rep 6 times (9)

Bind off with an adequate length of yarn for gathering the last 9 sc. Gather all 9 outer loops with a needle and tighten the yarn so it closes nicely and fasten the yarn.

### The body:

Make 1 in White and 1 in Old Rose.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr.  
Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12)  
Rnd 3: 1 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (18)  
Rnd 4: 2 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (24)  
Rnd 5: 3 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (30)  
Rnd 6: 4 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (36)  
Rnd 7: 5 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (42)  
Rnd 8: 6 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (48)  
Rnd 9: 7 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (54)  
Rnd 10: 8 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (60)  
Rnd 11: 9 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (66)

Rnd 12: 10, sc inc. Rep 6 times (72)  
Rnd 13: 11, sc inc. Rep 6 times (78)  
Rnd 14: 12, sc inc. Rep 6 times (84)  
Rnd 15: 13, sc inc. Rep 6 times (90)  
Rnd 16: 14, sc inc. Rep 6 times (96)  
Rnd 17: 15, sc inc. Rep 6 times (102)

In the next row, we make parallel decreases on 2 of the sides so the piece is a bit oblong.

Rnd 18: 15 sc, dec 2 times, 14 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc, 15 sc, dec 2 times, 14 sc, inc, 16 sc, inc (102)

Rnd 19: 32 sc, inc, 17 sc, inc, 32 sc, inc, 17 sc, inc (106)

Rnd 20: 33 sc, inc, 18 sc, inc, 33 sc, inc, 18 sc, inc (110)

Rnd 21: 34 sc, inc, 19 sc, inc, 34 sc, inc, 19 sc, inc (114)

Bind off.

Stretch the body a bit since it will gather itself a bit. It should be slightly oblong.

Lay both pieces together wrong side to wrong side and work them together using sc.

### **Legs:**

Start in White, make 4.

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr.

Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: 2 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (24)

**Rnd 5-7:** 1 sc in every sc (24) All in all 3 rnds

Rnd 8: 2 sc, dec. Rep 6 times (18)

Switch to Old Rose

Rnd 9-10: 1 sc in every sc (18)

Rnd 11: 4 sc, dec. Rep 3 times (15)

**Rnd 12-26:** 1 sc in every sc (15) All in all 15 rnds

Bind off with an adequate length of yarn for sewing.

Fill up the legs tightly in the bottom but lightly up the legs and place them on the corners of the crocheted body as shown in the picture.

Sew or crochet them on to the corners as shown in the picture so the stitches won't be visible. That way they are nicely hidden on the inside.



## Ears:

In White

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr.

Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (18)

Rnd 4: 5 sc, inc. Rep 3 times (21)

Rnd 5: 6 sc, inc. Rep 3 times (24)

**Rnd 6-17:** 1 sc in every sc (24) All in all 13 rnds

Rnd 18: 6 sc, dec. Rep 3 times (21)

**Rnd 19-20:** 1 sc in every sc (21) 2 rnds

Rnd 21: 5 sc, dec. Rep 3 times (18)

**Rnd 22-24:** 1 sc in every sc (18) 3 rnds

Rnd 25: 4 sc, dec. Rep 3 times (15)  
**Rnd 26-28:** 1 sc in every sc (15) 3 rnds  
Rnd 29: 3 sc, dec. Rep 3 times (12)  
Rnd 30: 1 sc in every sc (12)

Bind off with an adequate length of yarn for sewing.

### **Tail:**

In Old Rose

Rnd 1: 6 sc in mr  
Rnd 2: inc 6 times (12)  
Rnd 3: 1 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (18)  
Rnd 4: 2 sc, inc. Rep 6 times (24)  
**Rnd 5-7:** 1 sc in every sc (24)

Fill up the neck with filling while you work.

Rnd 8: 2 sc, dec. Rep 6 times (18)  
Rnd 9: 1 sc, dec. Rep 6 times (12)

Bind off with an adequate length of yarn for sewing.

### **Assembling:**

Embroider eyes to rnd 12-14 tilted (from the top of the head and down) and down to 15th rnd.

Embroider the snout from rnd 14 and down to rnd 17 (counted from the top of the head).

The ears are sewn to rnd 6 counted from the top of the head.

The head is sewn on to the center of the top of the body.

Sew the tail on to the center of the bottom of the body.
