



Horizon - Blanket

Materials

Hobbii Horizon col. 01 Crochet hook, 7 mm

Gauge About 18 sts x 17 rows = 10 x 10 cm

Yarn usage: About 1300g (7 skeins)

Measurements

About 180 x 130 cm - If you want a bigger blanket, it can be sized up by adding an even number of sts.

Abbreviations

ch: chain stitch
st(s): stitch(es)
sc: single crochet



Pattern instructions - Guide with pictures can be found below

1. Ch 232. In the 4th st from the hook, make 1 sc.* ch 1, skip 1 st and sc into the next *. Repeat between ** until end of row

2. Turn and ch 2. Sc into the first ch-sp. * ch 1 and sc into the next ch-sp *. Repeat between ** until end of row.

Repeat row 2 until you have about 305 rows in total, or your blanket is 180 cm long. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

Guide

The guide is shown with fewer sts, but the method remains the same.



1. Ch 232.



2. Sc into the 4th st from the hook.



3. Like so.



4. * ch 1, skip 1 st and sc into the next *.

Row 1





5. Like so.



6. * ch 1, skip 1 st and sc into the next *.





8. Repeat between ** until end of row.

7. Like so.

Row 2



1. Turn and ch 2.



2. Sc into the first ch-sp.







3. Like so.

4. * ch 1 and sc into the next ch-sp *.





6. * ch 1 and sc into the next ch-sp *.



7. Like so.



8. Repeat between ** until end of row.



Row 3



1. This row is worked in the same manner as row 2. Turn and ch 2.



2. Sc into the first ch-sp.





3. Like so.

4. * ch 1 and sc into the next ch-sp *.



5. Like so.



6. Repeat between ** until end of row.



Row 4 and on



 Repeat row 2 until you have about 305 rows in total, or your blanket is 180 cm long. Cut the yarn and weave in ends
