



Kawaii Strawberry - Cuddle cloth

No. 1011-202-2223

Difficulty: Advanced

Crochet hook: 2.5 mm and 5 mm

Materials: Pins, black embroidery thread, safety eyes (7 mm), stuffing, sewing thread, sewing needle

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/4

Red (#58) - 1 skein

Light Green (#19) - 1 skein

Light Pink (#62) - 1 skein

Yarn: Baby Merino XL

Baby Turquoise (#24) - 1 skein

Abbreviations:

st(s): stitch(es)

ch: chain stitch

sc: single crochet

hdc: half double crochet

dc: double crochet

sc2in1: work 2 sc in same st

sc2tog: work 1 sc over 2 sts

sl st: slip stitch

ch-sp: chain space

Tip:

Use a stitch marker or a safety pin to mark the beginning of the round.

A wooden chopstick is great to have on hand when the head and other details are to be stuffed.

STRAWBERRY

Using **Red**

Begin with a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc into the magic ring (6)

Round 2: [sc2in1] x6 (12)

Round 3: 12 sc (12)

Round 4: [1 sc, sc2in1] x6 (18)

Round 5: 18 sc (18)

Round 6: [2 sc, sc2in1] x6 (24)

Round 7: 24 sc (24)

Round 8: [3 sc, sc2in1] x6 (30)

Round 9: 30 sc (30)

Round 10: [4 sc, sc2in1] x6 (36)

Round 11: 36 sc (36)

Round 12: [5 sc, sc2in1] x6 (42)

Round 13: 42 sc (42)

Round 14: [6 sc, sc2in1] x6 (48)

Round 15-21: 48 sc (7 rounds, 48)

Now, embroider the mouth and cheeks into the head and fasten the safety eyes.

Embroider a V as a mouth at the middle of the 14th round. Place the eyes between rounds 15 and 16. Embroider a cheek on each side of the eyes.

Round 22: [6 sc, sc2tog] x6 (42)

Round 23: [5 sc, sc2tog] x6 (36)

Round 24: [4 sc, sc2tog] x6 (30)

Fill the strawberry with stuffing, and continue filling it as you work on.

Round 25: [3 sc, sc2tog] x6 (24)

Round 26: [2 sc, sc2tog] x6 (18)

Round 27: [1 sc, sc2tog] x6 (12)

Round 28: [sc2tog] x6 (6)

Cut the yarn, leaving a 30 cm long tail end and sew up the small hole.

Use a long darning needle to pull the tail end through the strawberry from top to bottom and back again. Tighten this thread to create a flatter bottom, which makes it easier to sew the berry onto the cloth later.

STRAWBERRY LEAF

Using **Light Green**

Begin with a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc into the magic ring (6)

Round 2: [sc2in1] x6 (12)

Round 3: [1 sc, sc2in1] x6 (18)

Round 4: 1 sc, sc2in1, [2 sc, sc2in1] x5, 1 sc (24)

Round 5: [3 sc, sc2in1] x6 (30)

Round 6: 2 sc, sc2in1, [4 sc, sc2in1] x5, 2 sc (36)

Now, you are going to make the points of leaves that hangs over the strawberry.

* ch 6, begin in the 3rd st from the hook and hdc in every ch st (4)

make 3 sl sts along the main circle *

Repeat between ** around the entire circle.

STEM

Using **Light Green**

Ch 6, begin in the 2nd st from the hook, sc into the next 5 sts.

Cut the yarn with a long tail end for sewing it onto the strawberry

Secure the stem with a few pins and sew into the top of the leaf and strawberry.

SMALL STRAWBERRIES (make 4)

Using **Red**

Begin with a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc into the ring (6)

Round 2: 6 sc (6)

Round 3: [sc2in1] x 6 (12)

Round 4-5: 12 sc (12)

Fill the strawberry with stuffing

Round 6: *working in the back loops of the sts* [sc2tog] x 6 (6)

Fill the berry well with stuffing and sew up the small hole. Weave in ends.

SMALL STRAWBERRY LEAVES (make 4)

Using **Light Green**

Begin with a magic ring, but do not join fully.

* ch 3, 1 sc in the 2nd st from the hook, 1 sc, 1 sl st into the ring* Repeat between ** 5 times in total

Leave a tail end of 20 cm. Sew the leaves onto the strawberries.

CUDDLE CLOTH

Worked as a granny square.

Using Baby Merino XL in Baby Turquoise and a 5 mm crochet hook

Ch 5 and join with a sl st into the first ch.

Round 1: ch 3, 2 dc into the ring, [ch 3, 3 dc] x 3, end round with ch3 and a sl st into the 3rd ch from the beginning of round.

Round 2: ch 3, 2 dc in first ch-sp, ch 3, 3 dc in same ch-sp, [ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-sp, ch 3, 3dc in same ch-sp] x 3. End round with ch 2 and a sl st into the 3rd ch from the beginning of round.

Round 3: ch 3, 2 dc in first ch-sp, ch 2, [3 dc into next ch-sp, ch 3, 3 dc into same ch-sp, ch 2, 3 dc into next ch-sp, ch 2] x 3, 3 dc into next ch-sp, ch 3, 3 dc into same ch-sp. End round with ch 2 and a sl st into the 3rd ch from the beginning of round.

Repeat this method until the cloth has the desired size.

EDGE

Using Rainbow Cotton 8/4 in Light Pink and a 2.5 mm hook

Round 1: Begin at the middle of one side. Sl st into a ch-sp, then [ch 5, sl st into next ch-sp]. Repeat this until end of round.

Begynd et stykke fra kanten, 5 lm, 1 km i hullerne, [5 lm, 1 km i næste hul] Gentages på hele omgangen.

Round 2: [3 sc, ch 2 , 3 sc] in every ch-sp. Repeat until end of round.

Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

FINISHING

Sew the leaf onto the big strawberry and tack the points of the leaf along the strawberry.

Sew a small strawberry onto each corner of the cloth.

Secure the strawberry to the middle of the cloth with pins and sew it onto it well.
