



Kawaii Watermelon - Cuddle cloth

No. 1011-202-6248

Difficulty: Advanced

Crochet hook: 2.5 mm and 5 mm

Materials: Pins, black embroidery thread, safety eyes (7 mm), stuffing, sewing thread, sewing needle

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/4

Petunia Pink (#87) - 1 skein

Light Green (#19) - 1 skein

Malachite Green (#099) - 1 skein

White (#001) - 1 skein

Yarn: Baby Merino XL

Pink (#44) - 1 skein

Abbreviations:

st(s): stitch(es)

ch: chain stitch

sc: single crochet

hdc: half double crochet

dc: double crochet

sc2in1: work 2 sc in same st

sc2tog: work 1 sc over 2 sts

sl st: slip stitch

ch-sp: chain space

Tip:

Use a stitch marker or a safety pin to mark the beginning of the round.

A wooden chopstick is great to have on hand when the head and other details are to be stuffed.

WATERMELON

Using **Malachite Green**

Chain 14 and begin in the 2nd st from the hook.

Round 1: 12 sc, 3 sc in the same st, 11 sc, sc2in1 (28)

Round 2: sc2in1, 11 sc, sc2in1, 1 sc, sc2in1, 11 sc, sc2in1, 1 sc (32)

Round 3: 1 sc, sc2in1, 12 sc, sc2in1, 2 sc, sc2in1, 12 sc, sc2in1, 1 sc (36)

Round 4: 2 sc, sc2in1, 13 sc, sc2in1, 3 sc, sc2in1, 13 sc, sc2in1, 1 sc (40)

Round 5: 40 sc (40)

Switch to Light Green

Round 6-7: 40 sc (2 rounds, 40)

Switch to White

Round 8: 40 sc (40)

Switch to Petunia Pink

Round 9: 40 sc (40)

Round 10: 2 sc, sc2tog, 13 sc, sc2tog, 3 sc, sc2tog, 13 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc (36)

Round 11-13: 36 sc (3 rounds, 36)

Round 14: 2 sc, sc2tog, 12 sc, sc2tog, 2 sc, sc2tog, 12 sc, sc2tog (32)

Round 15-16: 32 sc (2 rounds, 32)

Now, embroider the mouth and cheeks into the head and fasten the safety eyes.

Embroider a V as a mouth at the middle of the 10th round. Place the eyes between rounds 11 and 12. Embroider a cheek on each side of the eyes.

Round 17: sc2tog, 1 sc, sc2tog, 11 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc, sc2tog, 11 sc (28)

Round 18-19: 28 sc (2 rounds, 28)

Fill the watermelon with stuffing, and continue filling it as you work on.

Round 20: sc2tog, sc2tog, 10 sc, sc2tog, sc2tog, 10 sc (24)

Round 21-22: 24 sc (2 rounds, 24)

Round 23: [2 sc, sc2tog] x6 (18)

Round 24: 18 sc (18)

Round 25: [1 sc, sc2tog] x6 (12)

Round 26: [sc2tog] x6 (6)

Cut the yarn, sew up the small hole and weave in ends.

Embroider a few black seeds onto the Petunia Pink part of the watermelon.

CUDDLE CLOTH

Worked as a granny square.

Using Baby Merino XL in Pink and a 5 mm crochet hook

Ch 5 and join with a sl st into the first ch.

Round 1: ch 3, 2 dc into the ring, [ch 3, 3 dc] x 3, end round with ch3 and a sl st into the 3rd ch from the beginning of round.

Round 2: ch 3, 2 dc in first ch-sp, ch 3, 3 dc in same ch-sp, [ch 2, 3 dc in next ch-sp, ch 3, 3dc in same ch-sp] x 3. End round with ch 2 and a sl st into the 3rd ch from the beginning of round.

Round 3: ch 3, 2 dc in first ch-sp, ch 2, [3 dc into next ch-sp, ch 3, 3 dc into same ch-sp, ch 2, 3 dc into next ch-sp, ch 2] x 3, 3 dc into next ch-sp, ch 3, 3 dc into same ch-sp. End round with ch 2 and a sl st into the 3rd ch from the beginning of round.

Repeat this method until the cloth has the desired size.

EDGE

Using Rainbow Cotton 8/4 in Petunia Pink and a 2.5 mm hook

Round 1: Begin at the middle of one side. Sl st into a ch-sp, then [ch 5, sl st into next ch-sp]. Repeat this until end of round.

Begynd et stykke fra kanten, 5 lm, 1 km i hullerne, [5 lm, 1 km i næste hul] Gentages på hele omgangen.

Round 2: [3 sc, ch 2 , 3 sc] in every ch-sp. Repeat until end of round.

Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

ORBS (make 4)

Using Light Green and a 2.5 mm crochet hook

Begin by making a magic ring

Round 1: 6 sc into the ring

Round 2: [sc2in1] x6 (12)

Round 3: [1 sc, sc2in1] x6 (18)

Round 4-6: 18 sc (18)

Round 7: [1 sc, sc2tog] x6 (12)

Fill with stuffing.

Round 8: [sc2tog] x6 (6)

Cut the yarn and weave in ends

FINISHING

Sew an orb to each corner of the cloth.

Secure the watermelon to the middle of the cloth and sew on well.

Now you are done!
