Materials

Color A

2 skeins Winter Glow, col. 16

Color B (one strand of each worked together) 3 skeins Friends Extra Fine Merino, col. 52

2 skeins Friends Kid Silk, col. 52

Circular needle 120 cm / 5 mm

Yarn Quality

Color A

Winter Glow. Hobbii

51% wool, 49% acrylic / 200 g = 700 m

Color B (one strand of each worked together)

Friends Extra Fine Merino, Hobbii 100% merino wool / 50 g = 165 m &

Friends Kid Silk, Hobbii

72% Mohair, 25% Silk, 3% Wool / 25 g = 200 m

Knitting Gauge

19 sts and 35 rows = 10 x 10 cm on a 5 mm needle in garter stitch in color A

Size

Onesize

Measurements

Width, long side: about 200 cm Angled sides: about 135 and 150 cm

Pattern information

Altenkirchen is the perfect project for the new knitter. The shawl is started at one corner and then increased on every other row.

It is worked flat on a 5 mm circular needle, or the size that you need to fit the knitting gauge mentioned above.

Keep in mind that the measurements given above are approximations. Your shawl may end up a slightly different size.

You work in stripes of color A and B (remember that color B is two threads worked together).

The shawl is big, warm, and fluffy - perfect for keeping you warm on the cool spring or fall days, and of course throughout the winter.

The shawl is worked in garter stitch for the entire project, which makes it the perfect beginner's project. If you already are an intermediate knitter, the shawl is wonderful for working on as you watch TV, are in a meeting, or just when your brain needs something lovely and simple after a long and tiring day.

Pattern instructions

Cast on

- Cast on 4 sts in color A
- k one row

Part 1 (worked only in color A)

- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (5 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2, 18 times more (23 sts)

The shawl now measures about 12 cm.

Part 2

- Switch to colour B (one strand of Friends Extra Fine Merino and one strand of Friends Kid Silk, worked together as one)
- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (24 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2, 4 times more (28 sts)
- Switch to color A
- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (29 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2, 4 times more (33 sts)
- Switch to color B
- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (34 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2, 4 times more (38 sts)
- Switch to color A
- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (39 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2, 4 times more (43 sts)
- Switch to color B



- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (44 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2, 4 times more (48 sts)

The shawl now measures about 27 cm.

Part 3

- Switch to color A
- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (49 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2, 113 times more (162 sts)

The shawl now measures about 93 cm.

Part 4

- Switch to color B
- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (163 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2, 34 times more (197 sts)

The shawl now measures about 113 cm.

Part 5

- Switch to color A
- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (198 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2, 34 times more (232 sts)

The shawl now measures about 133 cm.

Part 6

- Don't break the yarn, because the color change is now on every other row
- *Switch to color B
- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (233 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Switch to color A
- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (234 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2, 12 times more (258 sts)

The shawl now measures about 147 cm.



Part 7

- Continue in color A
- Row 1: k1, k2 in the next st, k until end of row (259 sts)
- Row 2: knit
- Repeat rows 1-2 once more (260 sts))

The shawl now measures about 150 cm.

- Bind off without tightening too much.
- Weave in ends.
