



Old Shale - Collar

No. 2016-203-7708

Materials

1 skein of Baby Wool, co. 01
Circular needles 32" (80 cm) / no. 2.5 (3.0 mm)
Crochet hook C/D 2/3 (3.0 mm)
1 button
Stitch markers

Yarn quality

 **BabyWool**, Hobbii
100% wool / 1.75 oz. (50 g) = 180 yds (165 meter)

Gauge

28 sts and 34 rows on 4" (10 cm) in pattern.

Size

Adult - Onesize

Measurements

Width in neckline: 15.8" (40 cm)
Bottom width: 44½" (113 cm)
Height: 5½" (14 cm)

Pattern information

The collar is knitted top-down.
The edges are knitted in garter st.
Has a lace pattern with increases.

Explanations

Est A = edge stitches A

sl1, k3.

Est B = edge stitches B

k3, k1 tbl.

Inc = increase

Pick up horizontal loop before next st and knit into back of it.

SSK = 2 sts kw tog tilting left

Slip 1 st kw and slip another st kw, put left needle through these 2 sts with the tip in front of the work and knit them together kw.

Pattern

Neckline

Cast on 104 sts.

1st row: Est A, k to 4 sts left, Est B.

Rep 1st row until the border measures 0.4" or 1 cm. Finish on a rs-row.

Pattern 1

1st row: Est A, p to 4 sts left, Est B.

2nd row: Est A, k1, yo, SSK, *k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k1, k2tog*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est B. (4 + 3 + (15 x 6) + 3 + 4 =104)

3rd row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

4th row: Est A, k to 4 sts left, Est B.

5th row: Est A, p to 4 sts left, Est B.

6th row: Est A, k1, yo, SSK, *k2tog, yo, k1, yo, k1, k2tog*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est B. (4 + 3 + (15 x 6) + 3 + 4 =104)

7th row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

8th row: Est A, k3, *k1, inc, k4, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est B.

Pattern 2

1st row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

2nd row: Est A, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, k2tog, (yo, k1) 2 times, k2tog, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est B. (4 + 3 + (15 x 8) + 3 + 4 =134)

3rd row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

4th row: Est A, k to 4 sts left, Est B.

5th row: Est A, purl to 4 sts left, Est B.

6th row: Est A, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, k2tog, (yo, k1) 2 times, k2tog, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left,

k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 8) + 3 + 4 = 134$)

7th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

8th row: Est **A**, k3, *k1, inc, k6, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 10) + 3 + 4 = 164$)

Pattern 3

1st row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

2nd row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, k2tog, (yo, k1) 4 times, k2tog, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 12) + 3 + 4 = 194$)

3rd row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

4th row: Est **A**, knit to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

5th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

6th row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, *(k2tog) 2 times, (yo, k1), 4 times, k2tog, k2tog*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 12) + 3 + 4 = 194$)

7th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

8th row: Est **A**, k3, *k1, inc, k10, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 14) + 3 + 4 = 224$)

Pattern 4

1st row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

2nd row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, (k2tog) 2 times, (yo, k1) 4 times, (k2tog) 2 times, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 14) + 3 + 4 = 224$)

3rd row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

4th row: Est **A**, knit to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

5th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

6th row: Est **A** k1, yo, SSK, *k1, (k2tog) 2 times, (yo, k1) 4 times, (k2tog) 2 times, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 14) + 3 + 4 = 224$)

7th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

8th row: Est **A**, k3, *k1, inc, k12, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 16) + 3 + 4 = 268$)

Pattern 5

1st row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

2nd row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, (k2tog) 2 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 2 times, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 16) + 3 + 4 = 268$)

3rd row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

4th row: Est **A**, knit to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

5th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

6th row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, (k2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 3 times, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 18) + 3 + 4 = 284$)

7th row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B.**

8th row: Est **A**, k3, *k1, inc, k16, inc, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k3, Est **B.** ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 20) + 3 + 4 = 314$)

Pattern 6

1st row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

2nd row: Est **A**, k1, yo, SSK, *k1, (k2tog) 3 times, (yo, k1) 6 times, (k2tog) 3 times, k1*, rep *-* to 7 sts left, k2tog, yo, k1, Est **B**. ($4 + 3 + (15 \times 20) + 3 + 4 = 314$)

3rd row: Est **A**, purl to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

4th row: Est **A**, knit to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

Outer edge

1st row: Est **A**, knit to 4 sts left, Est **B**.

Rep 1st row until the edge measures 0.4" or 1 cm. Finish on a ws-row.

Cast off – not too tightly.

Buttonhole

The buttonhole is crocheted as a bridle on the right side of the collar, on the outside of the edge.

Work 1 sl st on the neckband, work 6-7 ch, work 1 sl st in the neckband of the collar. Bind off.

Sew on the button on the left side.
