



# **Uda - Jumper**

# Materials

2 (3) 3 (4) 4 skeins Unicorn, col. 05 4 (5) 5 (6) 6 skeins Kid Silk, col. 16

Circular needle 80 cm, 3,5 and 5 mm Crochet hook 3,5 mm Stitch markers Stitch holder with wire, 2 pcs.

## Yarn

Unicorn, Hobbii 75% merino wool, 25% polyamide/ 100 g = 400 meters Kid Silk, Hobbii 70% kid mohair, 30% silk/ 25 g = 195 meters

# Gauge

18 stitches x 25 rounds = 10 cm with 2 strands on needle 5 mm in stockinette stitch

## Measurements

Width: 46 (48) 51 (54) 57 cm Length: 54 (56) 58 (59) 60 cm

# Pattern information

The jumper is worked in 1 strand Unicorn and 1 strand Kid Silk = 2 strands. The jumper is worked top down. You work short rows in the neckline for a better fit. The jumper has raglan sleeves. After the yoke, you split the piece into body and

sleeves. If only one number is mentioned, it applies for all sizes.

# Pattern

#### Garter edge

CO 96 stitches on circular needle size 3,5 mm (applies for all sizes) and work in the round. Purl 1 round.

#### Marking raglan increases

Insert a marker around the stitches, that will shape the raglan as follow: Insert a marker around 1<sup>st</sup> stitch, then count 10 (10) 8 (8) 6 stitches and insert a marker around the next stitch, count 36 (36) 38 (38) 40 stitches, insert a marker around the next stitch, count 10 (10) 8 (8) 6 stitches, insert a marker around the next stitch, count 36 (36) 38 (38) 40 stitches until 1<sup>st</sup> marker.

You now have 10 (10) 8 (8) 6 stitches for each sleeve and 36 (36) 38 (38) 40 stitches for the front and back piece and 4 marked stitches.

The round begins in between back piece and left sleeve.

#### Yoke

The neckline is shaped working short rows.

Insert a marker in the middle of the front piece.

Change to circular needle size 5 mm and work German Short Rows and increase for the raglan as follows:

**1**<sup>st</sup> **row, RS:** knit until there are 12 stitches left before marker in the middle of the front piece, wrap and turn.

**2<sup>nd</sup> row, WS:** purl until there are 12 stitches left before marker in the middle of the front piece, wrap and turn.

**3. needle, RS:** \*knit until raglan marker, increase 1 stitch, k1, increase 1 stitch\*, repeat from \* to \* in all 4 raglan seams, knit until there are 8 stitches left before marker in the middle of the front piece, wrap and turn = 8 stitches increased.

**NB** Work wrapped stitches as one stitch.

**4**<sup>th</sup> **row, WS:** Purl until there are 8 stitches left before marker in the middle of the front piece, wrap and turn.

**5<sup>th</sup> row, RS:** \*knit until raglan marker, increase 1 stitch, k1, increase 1 stitch\*, repeat from \* to \* in all 4 raglan seams, knit until there are 4 stitches left before marker in the middle of the front piece, wrap and turn.

**6<sup>th</sup> row, WS:** Purl until there are 4 stitches left before marker in the middle of the front piece, wrap and turn.

**7<sup>th</sup> row /round, RS:** Work stockinette stitch in the round over alle stitches and continue increasing for the raglan.

**NB** After a few rounds, 1 stitch between the increases in each raglan will be visible. You can choose to move the markers as you go.

Continue working in stockinette stitch and increase in every  $2^{nd}$  round until you have 50 (52) 54 (58) 60 stitches on each sleeve and 76 (78) 84 (88) 94 stitches on the front and back piece, plus the 4 market stitches. Finish at the beginning of the round after a round with no increases = 256 (264) 280 (296) 312 stitches in total.

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**NB** If you want to make the jumper larger, you can increase a few more times. Don't forget, that you may need extra yarn.

#### Now separate the piece in sleeves and body.

Slip the stitches for each sleeve and the marked stitches on to a stitch holder = 52 (54) 56 (60) 62 stitches for each sleeve. Work the body over the remaining stitches as follows: Slip the stitches for the first sleeve on to the stitch holder, CO 8 new stitches, work front piece, slip the stitches for the second sleeve on a stitch holder, CO 8 new stitches and work the back piece.

#### Body

Work in the round in stockinette stitch over front and back piece = 168 (172) 184 (192) 204 stitches. Work until the piece measures approx. 38 cm from armhole.

#### Garter edge

Change to circular needle size 3,5 mm. Purl 1 round. Bind off loosely.

## Neck edge

To reinforce the edge, crochet 1 round sc around the neck edge.

## Sleeves

Slip the stitches from one sleeve back on a circular needle size 5 mm and pick up 8 stitches from the armhole = 60(62) 64(68) 70 stitches.

Work stockinette stitch in the round using the Magic Loop-technique. Insert a marker in the middle of the 8 new stitches in armhole.

Knit 4 rounds.

**Decrease round:** Work until 3 stitches before marker, k2tog, k2, k2tog tbl, work rest of the round = 2 stitches decreased.

Continue decreasing in every 8<sup>th</sup> round until you have 44 (46) 48 (50) 52 stitches.

Continue until sleeve measures approx. 45 cm from armhole. Decrease 6 stitches evenly on the next round.

#### Garter edge

Change to needle 3,5 mm. Purl 1 round. Bind off loosely. Work the other sleeve in the same way.
