

## Holly - Scarf

## Materials

Diablo Multi col. 18
Crochet hook size 9 mm

Usage: approx. 250 gr. (5 balls)

Measurements: Approx. $210 \times 27,5 \mathrm{~cm}$

Gauge: Approx. $8,5 \mathrm{~m} \times 7$ rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## Abbreviations:

Ch: Chain stitch
St(s): Stitch(es)
Hdc: Half double crochet
Tbl: Through back loop

## Pattern - You can find a picture guide below, under the written pattern.

Please note: From row 2 you work tbl. Work the last st through both loops to make the edge smoother.

1. Ch180. Turn your ch-row and work in the horizontal loops. Work 1 hdc in $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$ from hook. Work hdc on entire row. (179)
2. Turn with ch1. Work hdc tbl on entire row. (179)

Repeat the procedure from row 2 until you have worked a total of 19 rows.
Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

## Guide:

This guide is made with fewer stitches, but the procedure is the same.

## Row 1



1. Ch180.

2. Turn your ch-row to make the horizontal loops visible. Work 1 hdc in $2^{\text {nd }}$ loop from hook.

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3. Like this.

## Row 2



1. Turn with ch1.

2. Like this.

3. Work hdc on entire row. (180)

4. Work 1 hdc tbl. The needle shows in which loop you work your hdc.

5. Work hdc tbl on entire row. (180)


## Row 3 and forward



1. Row 3 is worked as row 2 . Turn with ch1.

2. Like this.

3. Repeat the procedure from row 2 until you have worked a total of 19 rows. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

4. Work 1 hdc tbl. The needle shows in which loop you work your hdc.

5. Work hdc in tbl on entire row. (180)
