

Hammerhead Shark

No. 1027-203-1545

Skill level: Intermediate

Crochet hook: 2.75 mm (US size C/2)

Size approx.: 10 cm tall made with the indicated yarn

Materials: Safety eyes 10 mm, fiberfill for stuffing, embroidery needle, cardboard

Note: *We don't recommend to use cardboard if the amigurumi is for babies/children*

Yarn: Baby Cotton Organic

Silver Grey (#03) - 1 skein

Grey (#05) - 1 skein

White (#01) - 1 skein

Abbreviations:

mr - magic ring

st(s) - stitch(es)

ch - chain stitch

sc - single crochet

inc - work 2 sc in same st

dec - work 2 sc together

hdc - half double crochet

hdc inc - half double crochet increase

Note

The color is changed by pulling the new color through the loop of the final stitch of the previous round.

HEAD (in silver grey)

Rnd 1: ch 36, join to a circle with 1 sc in the first ch [36]

Now crochet in the round.

Rnd 2-4: 1 sc in each st [36]

Rnd 5: (16 sc, 1 dec) x 2 [34]

Rnd 6: (15 sc, 1 dec) x 2 [32]

Rnd 7: 1 sc in each st [32]

Rnd 8: (14 sc, 1 dec) x 2 [30]

Rnd 9-11: 1 sc in each st [30]

Rnd 12-24: 1 sc in each st [30], ch 1 and turn

Rnd 25: 1 sc in each st [30]

Now crochet in the round.

Rnd 26-30: 1 sc in each st [30]

Rnd 31: (14 sc, 1 inc) x 2 [32]

Rnd 32: 1 sc in each st [32]

Rnd 33: (15 sc, 1 inc) x 2 [34]

Rnd 34: (16 sc, 1 inc) x 2 [36]

Rnd 35-37: 1 sc in each st [36], fasten off and weave in the ends.

BODY (start in silver grey)

Crochet in the open hole in the head. Hold the head so the open hole points upwards. Start on the right side and crochet on the side closest to you.

Rnd 1: 1 sc in each st [30]

Rnd 2: 2 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 7 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc [26]

Rnd 3: (11 sc, 1 dec) x 2 [24]

Rnd 4: 5 sc, 1 dec, 11 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc [22]

Rnd 5: 1 sc in each st [22]

Rnd 6: (10 sc, 1 inc) x 2 [24]

Rnd 7: 1 sc in each st [24]

Rnd 8: 3 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 14 sc [26]

Rnd 9: 5 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc, 1 inc, 17 sc [28]

Rnd 10: 1 sc, 1 inc, 15 sc, 1 inc, 10 sc [30]

Rnd 11: 6 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 17 sc [32]

Rnd 12: 2 sc, 1 inc, 18 sc, 1 inc, 10 sc [34]

Rnd 13: 9 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc, 17 sc [36]

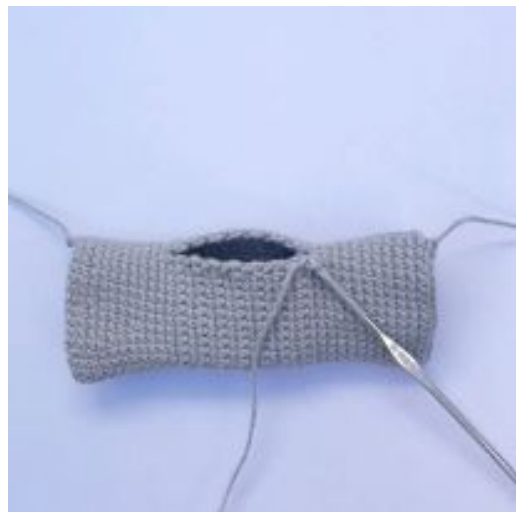
Rnd 14 (grey): 6 sc, 1 inc, 18 sc, 1 inc, 10 sc [38]

Rnd 15: 4 sc, 1 inc, 21 sc, 1 inc, 11 sc [40]

Rnd 16: 13 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc, 19 sc [42]

Rnd 17 (silver grey): 6 sc, 1 inc, 21 sc, 1 inc, 13 sc [44]

Rnd 18: 13 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc [46]



Rnd 19: 9 sc, 1 inc, 19 sc, 1 inc, 16 sc [48]
Rnd 20 (grey): 1 sc in each st [48]
Rnd 21: 18 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc, 1 inc, 24 sc [50]
Rnd 22: 9 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc, 1 inc, 16 sc [52]
Rnd 23 (silver grey): 1 sc in each st [52]
Rnd 24: 20 sc, 1 inc, 7 sc, 1 inc, 23 sc [54]
Rnd 25: 1 sc in each st [54]
Rnd 26-28 (grey): 1 sc in each st [54]
Rnd 29 (silver grey): 1 sc in each st [54]
Rnd 30: 17 sc, 1 dec, 13 sc, 1 dec, 20 sc [52]
Rnd 31: 11 sc, 1 dec, 24 sc, 1 dec, 13 sc [50]
Rnd 32 (grey): 20 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec, 23 sc [48]
Rnd 33: 12 sc, 1 dec, 20 sc, 1 dec, 12 sc [46]
Rnd 34: 14 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 16 sc [43]
Rnd 35 (silver grey): 12 sc, 1 dec, 18 sc, 1 dec, 9 sc [41]
Rnd 36: 15 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, 12 sc [38]
Rnd 37: 15 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc, 1 dec, 11 sc [36]
Rnd 38 (grey): 14 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc [34]
Rnd 39: 5 sc, 1 dec, 10 sc, 1 dec, 7 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc [31]
Rnd 40: 10 sc, 1 dec, 8 sc, 1 dec, 9 sc [29]
Rnd 41 (silver grey): 6 sc, 1 dec, 15 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc [27]. Stuff the body with fiberfill.
Rnd 42: 8 sc, 1 dec, 7 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc, 1 dec [24]
Rnd 43: 10 sc, 1 dec, 4 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc [22]
Rnd 44: 6 sc, 1 dec, 9 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc [20]
Rnd 45: 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec, 6 sc [17]
Rnd 46: 3 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec, 7 sc [15]
Rnd 47: 1 dec, 8 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc [13]
Rnd 48: 1 sc, 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc [11]. Stuff the body with fiberfill.
Rnd 49: 3 sc, 1 dec, 3 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc [9]
Rnd 50: 1 sc in each st [9]. Fasten off. Leave a long tail for sewing the back fin to the body.

BACK FIN (in silver grey yarn)

Rnd 1: 8 sc in a mr [8]

Rnd 2: inc x 8 [16]

Rnd 3: (1 sc, 1 inc) x 8 [24]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, 1 inc) x 8 [32]

Rnd 5: (3 sc, 1 inc) x 8 [40]

Rnd 6: (4 sc, 1 inc) x 8 [48]

Rnd 7: (5 sc, 1 inc) x 8 [56]

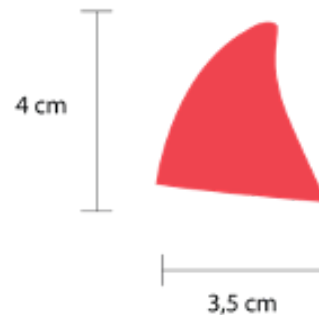
Rnd 8: (6 sc, 1 inc) x 8 [64]

Fold and work 32 sc through both layers. Fasten off and weave in the ends.

TOP FIN (in silver grey yarn)

- Rnd 1:** 4 sc in a mr [4]
Rnd 2: inc x 2, 2 sc [6]
Rnd 3: 1 sc, inc x 2, 3 sc [8]
Rnd 4: 2 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 inc, 3 sc [10]
Rnd 5: 3 sc, inc x 2, 4 sc, 1 inc [13]
Rnd 6: 5 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 1 sc [15]
Rnd 7: 5 sc, inc x 2, 8 sc [17]
Rnd 8: 6 sc, inc x 2, 9 sc [19]
Rnd 9: 8 sc, 1 inc, 8 sc, 1 dec [19]
Rnd 10: 8 sc, inc x 2, 4 sc, 5 hdc [21]
Rnd 11: 4 hdc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc, 5 hdc [22]
Rnd 12: 4 hdc, 6 sc, inc x 2, 5 sc, 5 hdc [24]
Rnd 13: 4 hdc, 6 sc, 1 inc, 8 sc, 5 hdc [25]

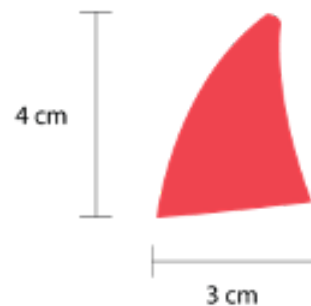
Rnd 14: 4 hdc, 3 sc [7]. Fasten off without finishing the round. Leave a tail for sewing the fin to the body. Cut a piece of cardboard in the shape of the top fin, and stuff inside. Sew the top fin to the body between round 21 and 32. Pin the top fin to the body to make sure it is placed correctly before you sew.



SIDE FIN (make 2 in silver grey yarn)

- Rnd 1:** 4 sc in a mr [4]
Rnd 2: inc x 2, 2 sc [6]
Rnd 3: 1 sc, inc x 2, 2 sc, 1 inc [9]
Rnd 4: 3 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc [10]
Rnd 5: 9 sc, 1 inc [11]
Rnd 6: 4 sc, 1 inc, 6 sc [12]
Rnd 7: 4 sc, 1 inc, 7 sc [13]
Rnd 8: 4 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 2 sc [15]
Rnd 9: 5 sc, 1 inc, 9 sc [16]
Rnd 10: 10 sc, 6 hdc [16]
Rnd 11: 1 hdc, 4 sc, 1 inc, 4 sc, 6 hdc [17]
Rnd 12: 1 hdc, 4 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 3 hdc, 1 hdc inc, 2 hdc [19]
Rnd 13: 1 hdc, 5 sc, 1 inc, 5 sc, 3 hdc, 1 hdc inc, 3 hdc [21]
Rnd 14: 1 hdc, 12 sc, 8 hdc [21]

Rnd 15: 1 hdc, 4 sc [5]. Fasten off without finishing the round. Leave a tail for sewing the fin to the body. Cut a piece of cardboard in the shape of the top fin, and stuff inside. Sew the top fin to the body between round 22 and 33. Pin the side fin to the body to make sure it is placed correctly before you sew.



EYES (make 2 in white yarn)

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr [6]

Rnd 2: inc x 6 [12]

Rnd 3: (1 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [18]

Rnd 4: (2 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [24]

Rnd 5: (3 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [30]

Rnd 6: (4 sc, 1 inc) x 6 [36]

Rnd 7-9: 1 sc in each st [36]. Put in a safety eye between rnd 2 and 3.

Rnd 10: (1 dec, 4 sc) x 6 [30]

Rnd 11: (1 dec, 3 sc) x 6 [24]

Rnd 12: (1 dec, 2 sc) x 6 [18], stuff with fiberfill.

Rnd 13: (1 dec, 1 sc) x 6 [12]

Rnd 14: dec x 6 [6]. Fasten off and weave in the ends.

Stuff the head with fiberfill. Push the eyes into the sockets on each side of the head, so the safety eyes point forward. Sew the eyes in place with silver grey yarn. Pin the eyes to the head to make sure they are placed correctly, before you sew.
