

## Bumpy Cuddle Bug

No. 1018-203-9240

## Level: Intermediate

Hook size: 6 mm (US size J), 5 mm (US size H), and 4 mm (US size G)
Size: Approximately 74 cm (29 inches)
Materials: Small amount of black felt,
stuffing, tapestry needle, scissors, thread, hot glue

Yarn: Horizon
Sunset (\#03)-1 skein
Sunup Sky (\#13)-1 skein
Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/8
White (\#001)-1 skein

## Abbreviations:

$\mathrm{CH}=$ chain stitch
SC = single crochet
INC = increase
SC2TOG = single crochet 2 together
(xx) bracket after round = amount of stitches after ended round

NOTE! We always recommend sewing when assembling if the product is for kids.

## Tip

Use a larger size wooden crochet hook or a chop stick to push down the stuffing when stuffing the monster.

## Pattern notes

CH 1 always counts as first SC.
Join = 1 slip stitch in the first CH from the round.

## Pattern

## Head

Use J hook and 2 strands of Horizon held together

Round 1: CH 2, 6 SC into the 2nd ch from hook, join to form a small circle (7)
Round 2: CH 1, INC x 7, join. (14)
Round 3: CH 1, (1 INC, 1 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 4: CH 1, (1 INC, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (28)
Round 5: CH 1, (1 INC, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (35)
Round 6: CH 1, (1 INC, 4 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (42)
Round 7: CH 1, (1 INC, 5 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (49)
Round 8: CH 1, (1 INC, 6 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (56)
Round 9: CH 1, (1 INC, 7 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (63)
Rounds 10-29: CH 1, 1 SC into each stitch, join. (63)
Round 30: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 7 SC) Repeat to end of round, join (56)
Round 31: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 6 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (49)
Round 32: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 5 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (42)
Round 33: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 4 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (35)
Round 34: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (28)
*begin stuffing here, continue to add more stuffing after every round from now on until close*
Round 35: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 36: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 1 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (14)
Round 37: CH 1, SC2TOG $\times 7$, close the hole and weave in ends.

## Body Bump \#1

Use J hook and 2 strands of Horizon held together

Round 1: CH 2, 6 SC into the 2nd ch from hook, join to form a small circle (7)
Round 2: CH 1, INC x 7, join. (14)
Round 3: CH 1, (1 INC, 1 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 4: CH 1, (1 INC, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (28)
Round 5: CH 1, (1 INC, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (35)
Round 6: CH 1, (1 INC, 4 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (42)
Round 7: CH 1, (1 INC, 5 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (49)
Round 8: CH 1, (1 INC, 6 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (56)
Rounds 9-25: CH 1, 1 SC into each stitch, join. (56)

Round 26: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 6 SC) Repeat to end of round, join (49)
Round 27: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 5 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (42)
Round 28: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 4 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (35)
Round 29: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (28)
*begin stuffing here, continue to add more stuffing after every round from now on until close*
Round 30: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 31: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 1 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (14)
Round 32: CH 1, SC2TOG $\times 7$, close the hole and weave in ends.

## Body Bump \#2

Use J hook and 2 strands of Horizon held together

Round 1: CH 2, 6 SC into the 2nd ch from hook, join to form a small circle (7)
Round 2: CH 1, INC x 7, join. (14)
Round 3: CH 1, (1 INC, 1 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 4: CH 1, (1 INC, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (28)
Round 5: CH 1, (1 INC, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (35)
Round 6: CH 1, (1 INC, 4 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (42)
Round 7: CH 1, (1 INC, 5 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (49)
Rounds 8-22: CH 1, 1 SC into each stitch, join. (49)
Round 23: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 5 SC) Repeat to end of round, join (42)
Round 24: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 4 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (35)
Round 25: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (28)
Round 26: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 27: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 1 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (14)
Round 28: CH 1, SC2TOG x 7, close the hole and weave in ends.

## Body Bump \#3

Use J hook and 2 strands of Horizon held together

Round 1: CH 2, 6 SC into the 2nd ch from hook, join to form a small circle (7)
Round 2: CH 1, INC x 7, join. (14)
Round 3: CH 1, (1 INC, 1 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 4: CH 1, (1 INC, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (28)
Round 5: CH 1, (1 INC, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (35)
Round 6: CH 1, (1 INC, 4 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (42)
Rounds 7-19: CH 1, 1 SC into each stitch, join. (42)
Round 20: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 4 SC ) Repeat to end of round, join (35)
Round 21: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (28)
*begin stuffing here, continue to add more stuffing at the end of each round until the piece is closed*
Round 22: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 23: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 1 SC ) Repeat to end of round, join. (14)
Round 24: CH 1, SC2TOG x 7, close the hole and weave in ends.

## Body Bump \#4

Use J hook and 2 strands of Horizon held together
Round 1: CH 2, 6 SC into the 2nd ch from hook, join to form a small circle (7)
Round 2: CH 1, INC x 7, join. (14)
Round 3: CH 1, (1 INC, 1 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 4: CH 1, (1 INC, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (28)
Round 5: CH 1, ( 1 INC, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (35)
Rounds 6-16: CH 1, 1 SC into each stitch, join. (35)
Round 17: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join (28)
*Begin stuffing here, continue to add more stuffing at the end of each round until the piece is closed*
Round 18: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 19: CH 1, (1 SC2TOG, 1 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (14)
Round 20: CH 1, SC2TOG x 7, close the hole and weave in ends.

## Antennae

Use J hook and 2 strands of Horizon held together


Round 1: CH 2, 6 SC into 2nd ch from hook, join to form a small circle. (7)
Rounds 2-27: CH 1, 1 SC into each stitch, join, stuff as you go. (7)
*finish off leaving a long tail for sewing.

## Eyes

Use H hook and White, make two


Round 1: CH 2, 6 SC into 2nd ch from hook, join to form a small circle. (7)
Round 2: CH 1, 2 SC into each stitch, join. (14)
Round 3: CH 1, (1 INC, 1 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (21)
Round 4: CH 1, (1 INC, 2 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (28)
Rounds 5: CH 1, ( 1 INC, 3 SC) Repeat to end of round, join. (35)
Rounds 6-9: CH 1, 1 SC into each stitch, join. (35)
*finish off leaving a long tail for sewing.
*for the pupils cut small circles from felt.

## Mouth

Use J hook and 2 strands of Horizon held together


Round 1: CH 6 , work a slip stitch into the first CH to form a small ring
Round 2: CH 1, 1 SC into each ch, join. (6)
Rounds 3-32: CH 1, 1 SC into each stitch, join, stuff as you go. (6)
*finish off leaving a long tail for sewing, then curl the long tube you just made into a circle and sew the ends together to close it off, leave the remainder of the tail end of yarn for sewing.
*cut a circle from black felt, the same size as the inside rim of the mouth

## Teeth

Use G hook and White, make three


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Round 1: CH 2, 6 SC into the 2nd ch from hook, join to form a small circle (7) Rounds 2-3: CH 1, 1 SC into each stitch, join (7)
*finish off and leave a tail for sewing.

## Assembly

- Sew each of the spheres to each other using your tapestry needle and yarn. Try to work even whip stitches around the "round 3 " areas of each sphere. Tie off and weave in ends as you go.
- Time to assemble the face. Start with the mouth. Position your black felt circle right in the middle of the Pink sphere and either sew it or glue it down. Then sew your mouth down right around it. Tie off and weave in the ends when you're done.
- To add the teeth, position them where you want and sew them down, weaving in the ends as you go, no need to stuff them because they're so small.
- For the eyes, use the mouth as a guide to position them where you want and start sewing them down. Once you've sewn the eye down about $75 \%$ of the way start stuffing, continue sewing and stuffing as needed until the eye is closed off. Repeat for the other eye, tie off and weave in ends. Either sew or glue down the small felt circle you cut for the pupils.
- For the antennae, simply position them on the sides of the head wherever you think they look good and sew them down. Tie off and weave in ends when you're finished.
