



# Crayons - Headband

## Materials

Babywool col. 01  
Super Kid Silk Print col. 1010  
Crochet hook size 4 mm

## Gauge

Approx. 21 sts x 22 row = 10 x 10 cm – there will be plenty of positive ease.

**Usage:** Babywool/ Super Kid Silk  
Approx. 40/12 (45/15) 50/18g

**Size:** 50 (54) 58cm

**Width:** Approx. 11 cm

## Abbreviations

**Ch:** Chain stitch

**St(s):** Stitch(es)

**Sc:** Single crochet

**Tbl:** Through back loop

## PLEASE NOTE

You work with 1 thread Babywool and 1 thread Super Kid Silk.

Begin each round with ch1. This ch st does not replace any other sts and is not counted in the total number of sts. From row 2 all sts are worked through back loop. Work the last stitch through both loops to create a more even edge.

**Pattern** – You can find a picture guide below, under the written pattern.

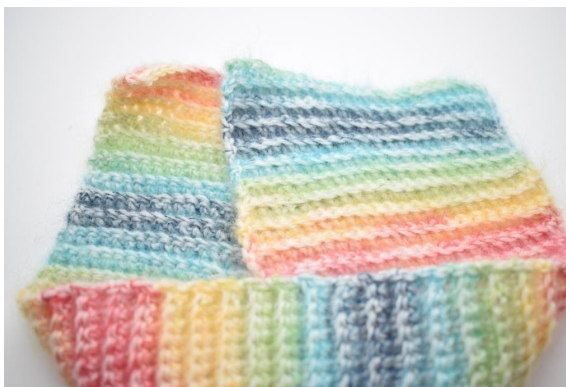
1. Ch24. Work 1 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook. Work sc in each st on entire row. (23)
2. Turn with ch1. Work sc tbl on entire row. (23)

Repeat row 2 until you have worked a total of 85 (90) 95 rows. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

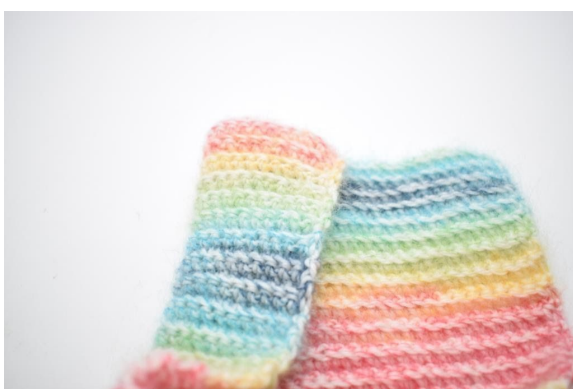
## Assembly:



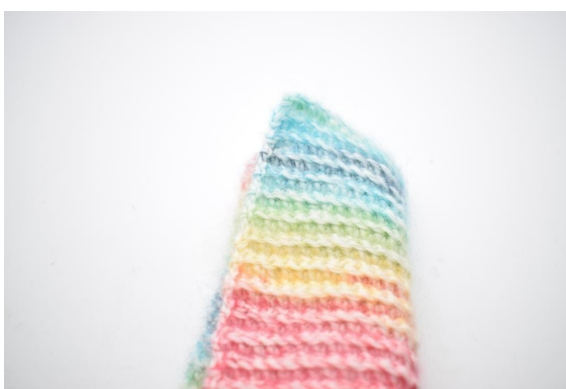
1. Lay down piece as shown on the photo here.



2. Lay the right part over the left part, so it covers half of the left part.



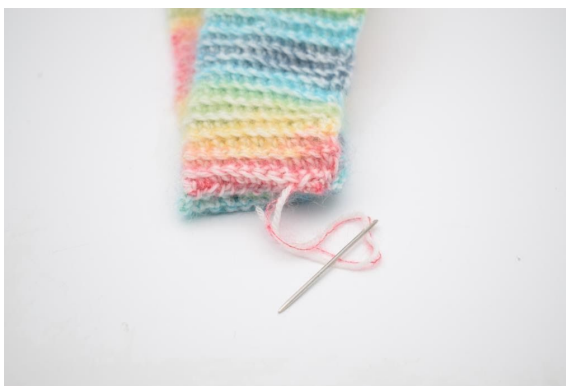
3. Fold the other (and uncovered) half of the left part over the right part.



4. Fold the other (and uncovered) half of the right part over the left part.



5. The end pieces are now folded on top of each other as shown on this photo.



6. Sew the end together through all 4 layers. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.



7. Turn the seam around to WS. There is now a pretty little “knot” in the front of the headband, and it’s finished.

**Picture guide** – This guide is made with less stitches, but the procedure is the same.

### Row 1



1. Ch24.



2. Work 1 sc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from hook.



3. Like this.



4. Work sc on entire row. (23)

## Row 2



5. Turn with ch1.



6. Work 1 sc tbl in first st. The needle shows in which loop you work your sc.



7. Like this.



8. Work sc tbl on entire row. (23)

### Row 3



9. This row is worked as row 2.  
Turn with ch1.



10. Work 1 sc tbl in first st.



11. Like this.



12. Work sc tbl on entire row. (23)

### Row 4 and forward



13. Repeat the procedure for row 2 until you  
have worked a total of 85 (90) 95 rows.



14. Cut the yarn and weave in ends.
