



# Rigmor - Jumper

No. 2004-204-2560

## Materialer

3 (3, 4, 4, 5) skeins Universe, col. 11

Circular needle 80 cm/size 3 mm and 3,5 mm (US 2,5 and 4).

Crochet hook 3 mm (US C/2) for the edge (optionally).

Stitch holders with wire

Stitch markers

## Yarn

 **Universe**, Hobbii

98% Acrylic, 2% Polyester/ 100 g = 462 meters

## Gauge

25 stitches and 32 rows = 10 x 10 cm on size 3.5 mm needle in stockinette st

## Size

S (M, L, XL, XXL)

## Measurements

This is a wide design

Width: approx. 46 (52, 58, 63, 68) cm,

Length, measured in the middle of front piece: approx. 51 (52, 53, 55, 57) cm

## Pattern information

The blouse is a wide, loose style with three-quarter-length sleeves.

The blouse is knitted from the top down, starting with a garter edge. Then all the increases are completed on the next 2 rows. The sleeves and the body are finished separately. Decreases are made before finishing with a garter edge.

## Yoke

### Neck Edge

CO 108 (118, 128, 138, 148) stitches on circular needle size 3 mm (US 2,5), 80 cm. Work garter st in the round, using the Magic Loop technique: knit 1 round and purl 1 round, until you have worked 4 ridges (= 8 rounds).

### Body

Switch to circular needle size 3,5 mm (US 4) and continue in stockinette st in the round and increase in the following 2 rounds as follows:

**Round 1:** \*k1, yo\*, repeat from \* to \* on entire round = 216 (236, 256, 276, 296) stitches.

**Round 2:** \*k1, yo, k1 tbl, yo\*, repeat from \* to \* on entire round = 432 (472, 512, 552, 592) stitches.

**Round 3:** \*k1, k1 tbl \*, repeat from \* to \* on entire round = 432 (472, 512, 552, 592) stitches.

Continue in stockinette st until piece measures 19 (20, 21, 22, 23) cm.

### Now the body and sleeves are separated.

Insert one marker at the beginning of the round.

Insert a marker after 102 (106, 110, 114, 120) stitches for the sleeve and insert one more marker after 114 (130, 146, 162, 176) stitches for the body. Repeat this one more time.

## Sleeves

Knit the sleeve stitches in the round on the circular needle using magic loop and let the other stitches rest. Knit approx. 32 cm of stockinette st.

### Sleeve Edge

Switch to circular needle size 3 mm (US 2,5) and continue as follows: k2tog on entire round = 51 (53, 55, 57, 60) stitches

Work 1 round K and 1 round P until there are 4 garter ridges.

BO all stitches.

Move the stitches before the next stitch marker onto the extra needle.

Work the other sleeve in the same way.

## Body

Using circular needle size 3,5 mm (US 4), work stockinette st in the round on the 228 (260, 292, 324, 352) stitches for the body.

Continue until the piece measures approx. 32 cm or a desired length, measured from the armhole.

### Body Edge

Switch to circular needle 3 mm (US 2,5) and continue as follows: \*k2, k2tog \*, repeat from \* to \* on entire round = 171 (195, 219, 243, 264) stitches.

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Work 1 round K and 1 round P until there are 4 garter ridges.  
BO all stitches.

NB! To make a firm and neat neck edge, you can optionally crochet 1 round sc around the neck edge.
