



Reindeer Christmas Stocking

No. 1011-204-9537

Skill level: Intermediate

Crochet hook: 5.5 and 3.5 mm

Approx. size: 36 x 23 cm

Materials: Stitch marker, black embroidery thread, white sewing thread, sewing needle

Yarn: Baby Snuggle Solid

Cream (#02) - 1 skein

Teddy Bear (#08) - 1 skein

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/8

Red (#058) - 1 skein

Rose (#044) - 1 skein

White (#001) - 1 skein

Light Brown (#006) - 1 skein

Abbreviations:

ch - chain stitch

sc - single crochet

hdc - half double crochet

1 inc - work 2 sts in same st

1 dec - work 2 sts together

sl st - slip stitch

Tip!

You are going to crochet in a continuous spiral, do not join the rounds.
Use a stitch marker or safety pin to keep track of where the round begins.

STOCKING

Using Baby Snuggle Solid in Cream and a 5.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 hdc in the ring (6)

Rnd 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Rnd 3: [1 hdc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Rnd 4: 1 hdc, 1 inc, [2 hdc, 1 inc] x5, 1 hdc (24)

Rnd 5: [3 hdc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

Rnd 6: 2 hdc, 1 inc, [4 hdc, 1 inc] x5, 2 hdc (36)

Rnd 7: 35 hdc, 1 sc (36)

Rnd 8: 1 sl st, change to Baby Snuggle Solid in the color Teddy Bear, 1 sc, 34 hdc (36)

Rnds 9-13: 36 hdc (5 rounds, 36)

Now you are going to crochet the heel. Start by crocheting 20 hdc with Teddy Bear, do NOT cut the yarn. Count back 25 hdc. In that stitch you are going to attach the Cream yarn and crochet the heel.

HEEL:

Using Baby Snuggle Solid in Cream

Rnd 1: 1 sc, 16 hdc, 1 sc, ch 2, turn (18)

Rnd 2: [1 dec] x2, 10 hdc, [1 dec] x2, ch 2, turn (14)

Rnd 3: [1 dec] x2, 6 hdc, [1 dec] x2, ch 2, turn (10)

Rnd 4: [1 dec] x2, 2 hdc, [1 dec] x2, ch 2, turn (6)

Rnd 5: 6 hdc, ch 2, turn (6)

Rnd 6: [1 inc] x2, 2 hdc, [1 inc] x2, ch 2, turn (10)

Rnd 7: [1 inc] x2, 6 hdc, [1 inc] x2, ch 2, turn (14)

Rnd 8: [1 inc] x2, 10 hdc, [1 inc] x2, ch 1, turn (18)

Rnd 9: 1 sc, 16 hdc, 1 sc (18)

Cut yarn, but leave a long tail. Fold the heel and sew the sides together. See pictures below.

Do not fasten the thread yet, you can use it to sew the potential holes that will show between the heel and sock.

Now you are going to continue with the shaft.

SHAFT:

Using Baby Snuggle Solid in Teddy Bear

Put a stitch marker after the first hdc.

Rnd 1: 11 hdc, 18 hdc around the heel, 7 hdc (36)

Rnds 2-12: 36 hdc (11 rounds, 36)

Crochet 25 hdc with Teddy Bear so you end up on the long side of the heel.

Change to Baby Snuggle Solid in Cream. To make the color change more smooth make 1 sc with Teddy Bear, 1 sl st with Cream and 1 sc before making hdc again.

Crochet 2 rounds of hdc in Cream.

To make the hanging loop, ch 10, skip 2 hdc and attach with 1 sl st.

Cut yarn and fasten all threads.

EYE WHITES (make 2)

Using Rainbow 8/8 in White and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)

Rnd 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Rnd 3: [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Finish with 1 sl st. Fasten all threads.

Embroider eyelashes using black.

Pin the eyes to the stocking and sew them on.

CHEEKS (make 2)

Using Rainbow 8/8 in Rose and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)

Rnd 2: [1 inc] x6 (12)

Finish with 1 sl st.

Cut yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

Pin the cheeks to the stocking and sew them on.

HORN part 1 (make 2)

Using Rainbow 8/8 in Light Brown and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

Rnds 2-7: 6 sc (6 rounds, 6)

Finish with 1 sl st.

Cut yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

HORN part 2 (make 2)

Using Rainbow 8/8 in Light Brown and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring

Rnd 1: 6 sc in the ring (6)

Rnds 2-3: 6 sc (2 rounds, 6)

Finish with 1 sl st.

Cut yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

Pin part 2 to part 1 and sew it on.

Sew on the horns to the stocking.

BOW

Using Rainbow 8/8 in Red and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring, and don't pull it together so tight.

You are going to crochet all of the below in the ring, that's why it needs to be wide.

Ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3, 1 sl st, ch 3, 3 dc, ch 3, 1 sl st.

Pull the ring together.

Cut off the yarn but leave a 20 cm long yarn tail, pull the yarn tail around the middle of the bow a couple of times until you think it looks good.

Pin the bow to the stocking and sew it on.

And you're done! 😊
