



Julie - Christmas Socks

Materials

1 (1, 1) skein Christmas Sock Wool
col 05

Double pointed needles 2.5 mm
Stitch markers

Yarn

Christmas Sock Wool, Hobbii
73% wool, 25% polyamid, 2% polyester
/ 100 g = 420 meters

Gauge

30 sts og 42 rows = 10x10 cm

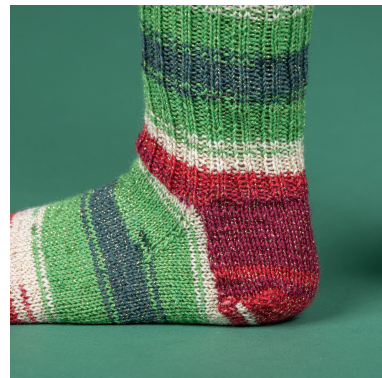
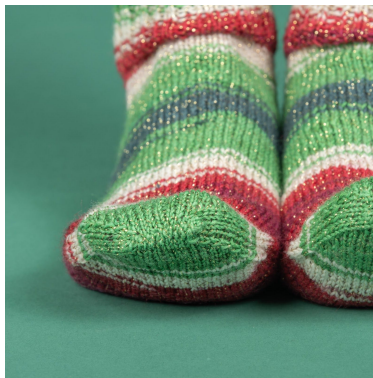

Sizes

Shoe size (US): 5/6 (7) 8/9
Foot length: about 24 (26) 28 cm

Pattern information

The socks are worked from ankle to toe.
Begin the other sock at the same color repeat as
the first if you want them to be similar.



Enjoy!

Leg

Cast on 56 (60) 64 sts evenly distributed on 4 double pointed needles.
Work in the round in rib: k2, p2, until the leg measures 12 (14) 16 cm.

Divide for heel

Work 14 (15) 16 sts so you have 28 (30) 32 sts on 1 double pointed needle. The sts for the bridge of the foot will rest on 2 needles.

Heel

Work flat in stockinette stitch over the 28 (30) 32 sts of the heel, until it measures 5 (5,5) 6 cm. End on a purl row.

Place a marker in the middle of the heel, at 14 (15) 16 sts.

Measure from this marker when measuring the foot length before the toe.

Heel decreases

1st row (Right Side): Work until there are 8 (9) 9 sts left of the row, ssk, k1, turn work.

2nd row (Wrong Side): Work until there are 8 (9) 9 sts left of the row, p2tog, p1, turn work.

3rd row (RS): Work until there are 7 (8) 8 sts left of the row, ssk, k1, turn work.

4th row (WS): Work until there are 7 (8) 8 sts left of the row, p2tog, p1, turn work.

Continue like so, working 1 sts less before each decrease, until all sts on the needle are worked.

Continue in stockinette stitch.

On the next round, pick up 14 (15) 16 sts along the edge of the heel cap.

Divide the heel sts evenly on 2 double pointed needles.

Gusset

Place a marker in each side between the bridge of the foot and the heel cap.

Decrease for the gusset as so:

Work until 2 sts before the marker, k2tog, work the foot bridge sts until next marker, ssk, work until end of round. Work a round without decreases.

Decrease on every other round until you have 56 (60) 64 sts in total on your 4 needles.

Foot

Continue straight in stockinette stitch until the foot measures about 19 (20,5) 22 cm from the marker at the heel = 5 (5,5) 6 cm for the toe.

Toe

Place 1 marker at each side so there are 28 (30) 32 sts each for the top and sole of the toe. Work until the first marker.

Decreases

1st and 2nd double pointed needle: Knit 1, ssk, knit until 3 sts before the marker, k2tog, k1.

3rd and 4th double pointed needle: Knit 1, ssk, knit until 3 sts before the marker, k2tog, k1.

Work 1 round.

Repeat the decreases on either side on every other row until there are 20 (20) 20 sts left in total. Bind off all sts.

Sew up the hole at the toe of the sock.
Work another sock in the same manner.
