Materials

5 (5, 6, 7, 7) skeins of Mohair Delight, co. 12

Knitting needles sz. 8 (5 mm) and 10 (6 mm)

Stitch holders

Markers

Yarn quality

 **Mohair Delight**, Hobbii

50% Mohair, 50% Acrylic/ 1.75 oz. (50 g) =

164 yds (150 meters)

Gauge

12 sts and 32 rows = 4" (10 cm) in honeycomb brioche stitch on a size 10 (6 mm) needle.

Size

S (M, L, XL, XXL)

Measurements

Width: 17.8" (19.7", 21.7", 23.6", 25.6") or 45 (50, 55, 60, 65) cm

Length: 19.7" (20.1", 20.5", 20.9", 21.3") or 50 (51, 52, 53, 54) cm

Pattern information

The blouse is knitted in HoneyComb Brioche. The technique is described at the back. The back, the front and sleeves are knitted separately.

Back

Cast on 54 (60, 66, 72, 78) stitches on a 5 mm (US 8) needle.

Start with a purl row and knit a total of 4 rows of stockinette stitches

Switch to a size 10 (6 mm) needle and knit **honeycomb brioche**:

Note first and last sts are edge stitches.

1st row, wrong side: k1, *yo, slip 1 st pw, k1*, repeat from * - * until you've got 1 st left, k1.

2nd row, right side: k1, *k2, slip the yo (from previous row) pw*, repeat from * - * until you've got 1 st left, k1.

3rd row, wrong side: k1, *knit the yo and the st tog, yo, slip 1 st pw, repeat from * - * until you've got 1 st left, k1.

4th row, right side: *k2, slip the yo (from previous row) pw*, repeat from * - * until you've got 2 sts left, k2.

5th row, wrong side: k1, *yo, slip 1 st pw, knit the yo and the st tog*, repeat from * - * until you've got 1 st left, k1.

Repeat rows 2-5.

Knit honeycomb brioche stitch until the work measures 19.7" (20.1", 20.5", 20.9", 21.3") or 50 (51, 52, 53, 54) cm.

Bind off.

Front

Knitted like the back until the work measures 16.5" (17", 17.3", 17.7", 18.1") or 42 (43, 44, 45, 46) cm. Finish with a wrong side row.

Left side

Neckline

Right side: k 23 (25, 28, 30, 33) sts, set the remaining sts to rest on the needle.

Wrong side: bind off 3 sts and finish the row.

Right side: pattern.

Wrong side: bind off 3 sts and finish the row.

Right side: pattern

Wrong side: bind off 2 sts and finish the row = 15 (17, 20, 22, 25) sts for shoulder.

Work even until the work measures 19.7" (20.1", 20.5", 20.9", 21.3") or 50 (51, 52, 53, 54) cm = center of shoulder.

Bind off.

Place the middle 8 (10, 10, 12, 12) sts on a stitch holder.

Right side

Neckline

Right side: attach yarn and knit the remaining 23 (25, 28, 30, 33) sts.

Wrong side: pattern.

Right side: bind off 3 sts and finish the row.

Wrong side: pattern.

Right side: bind off 3 sts and finish the row.

Wrong side: pattern.

Right side: bind off 2 sts and finish the row.

Wrong side: pattern.

Work even until the work measures 19.7" (20.1", 20.5", 20.9", 21.3") or 50 (51, 52, 53, 54) cm = center of shoulder.

Bind off.

Sleeve

Cast on 32 (34, 36, 38, 40) stitches on a 5 mm (US 8) needle.

Start with a purl row and knit a total of 4 rows of stockinette stitches

Switch to a size 10 (6 mm) needle and knit honeycomb brioche stitch as on the blouse.

Knit until the work measures 1.2" (3 cm).

Increases

*Knit 1, inc 1 (pick up st between sts and knit tbl), knit pattern until you've got 1 st left, inc 1, k1 = 2 sts inc. These new sts are included in the pattern.

Knit until the work measures 2" (5 cm) from last inc*.

Repeat from * - * until you've increased 6 times = 44 (46, 48, 50, 52) sts.

Work even until the sleeve measures approx. 16½" (42 cm) or desired length.

Bind off.

Knit the other sleeve alike.

Assembling and neckband

Sew up left shoulder.

From the right side, knit up approx. 80-100 sts in the neckline using a size 8 (5 mm) needle.

Knit 3 rows of stockinette st. Bind off loosely from the right side.

Sew up the other shoulder and the neckband.

Place a marker in the center of the bind off on the sleeve. Place a marker 7" (7½", 7.9", 8.3", 8.7" or 18 (19, 20, 21, 22) cm down from the middle of the shoulder. Attach the sleeve between the marks.

Sew sleeve- and side seams together.
