



# Willa - Sweater

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Materials 4 (5, 5, 5, 6, 6) skeins of Mohair Delight, col 26

Jumper needles US 10 (6 mm) Circular needle 15.7" (40 cm) / US 10 (6 mm) for the polo neck Cable needle Markers

Yarn quality Mohair Delight, Hobbii 50 % Mohair, 50 % Acrylic/ 1.8 oz (50 g) = 164 yds (150 m)

Gauge 14 sts x 19 rows in stockinette stitch = 4" (10 cm)

Sizes XS (S, M, L, XL, XXL)

## Measurements

Width: 16.1" (17.3", 18.5", 20.5", 21.7", 24") / 41 (44, 47, 52, 55, 61) cm Length: 20.5" (20.9", 21.3", 21.7", 22", 22.4") / 52 (53, 54, 55, 56, 57) cm

# About the pattern

Back piece, front piece and sleeves are worked separately in the flat. A cable is worked on the front piece. The pieces are stitched together and lastly a polo neck is worked on a circular needle.

# **Back piece**

#### Ribbing

Co 57 (61, 65, 73, 77, 85) sts and work in rib like this: **Row 1, WS:** P1, \*k1, p1\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the row. **Row 2, RS:** K1, \*p1, k1\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the row. Repeat rows 1-2, until the ribbing measures approx 2" / 5 cm. End with a WS row.

#### Body

Continue in stockinette stitch.

K1, inc1 (i.e. knit the bar between the sts tbl), work rest of row = 58 (62, 66, 74, 78, 86) sts. Work even, until the work measures approx 19.7" (20.1", 20.5" 20.9", 21.3", 21.7") / 50 (51, 52, 53, 54, 55) cm. End with a WS row. Bo all sts. **NB** The back piece is shorter than the front piece.

# **Front piece**

#### Ribbing

Co 57 (61, 65, 73, 77, 85) sts and work in rib like this: **Row 1, WS:** P1, \*k1, p1\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the row. **Row 2, RS:** K1, \*p1, k1\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the row. Repeat rows 1-2, until the ribbing measures approx 2" / 5 cm. End with a WS row.

**NB** A cable is worked in the middle of the front piece. The cable is worked over 12 sts with 2 p sts on each side.

## Body

Continue in stockinette stitch, prepare for the cable and inc by 5 sts like this: **RS:** K1, inc1, k 23 (25, 27, 31, 33, 37), inc1, k4, inc1, k5, inc1, k 23 (25, 27, 31, 33, 37), inc1, k1 = 62 (66, 70, 78, 82, 90) sts. **WS:** P 23 (25, 27, 31, 33, 37), k2, p12, k2, p 23 (25, 27, 31, 33, 37). Work 2 rows according to the sts.

#### From here the cables are worked

**Next row, RS:** K 23 (25, 27, 31, 33, 37), p2, place 4 sts on a cable needle in front of the work, k4, k the 4 sts on the cable needle, k4, p2, k 23 (25, 27, 31, 33, 37). Work 5 rows according to the sts.



**Next row, RS:** K 23 (25, 27, 31, 33, 37), p2, k4, place 4 sts on a cable needle behind the work, k4, k the 4 sts on the cable needle, p2, k 23 (25, 27, 31, 33, 37). Work 5 rows according to the sts.

Repeat these 12 rows, until the work measures approx 18.1" (18.5", 18.5", 18.9", 18.9", 19.3") / 46 (47, 47, 48, 48, 49) cm measured from the cast on edge. End 3 rows after a cable.

#### Neckline, left-hand side

RS: K 23 (25, 27, 31, 33, 37). Work these sts and place the remaining sts on a stitch holder.
WS: p all sts.
RS: k until 2 sts remain, k2tog tbl.
WS: p all sts.
Repeat the last 2 rows, until 20 (22, 24, 26, 28, 30) sts remain.
Work even, until the work measures 20.5" (20.9", 21.3", 21.7", 22", 22.4") / 52 (53, 54, 55, 56, 57) cm.
Place a marker at the sleeve side = the middle of the shoulder.
Work even for 0.8" / 2 cm.
Bo.

Place the 16 middle sts on a stitch holder.

#### Neckline, right-hand side

RS: k all sts.
WS: p all sts.
RS: k2tog, work rest of row.
WS: p all sts.
Repeat the last 2 rows, until 20 (22, 24, 26, 28, 30) sts remain.
Work even, until the work measures 20.5" (20.9", 21.3", 21.7", 22", 22.4") / 52 (53, 54, 55, 56, 57) cm.
Place a marker at the sleeve side = the middle of the shoulder.
Work even for 0.8" / 2 cm.
Bo.

## Sleeves

#### Ribbing

Co 29 (29, 31, 31, 33, 35) sts and work in rib like this:



Row 1, WS: P1, \*k1, p1\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the row.
Row 2, RS: K1, \*p1, k1\*, repeat from \* to \* throughout the row.
Repeat rows 1-2, until the ribbing measures approx 2" / 5 cm. End with a WS row.

#### Sleeve

NB The sleeves are worked in stockinette stitch with increases on each side.

#### Increases

**RS:** K1, inc1 (i.e. knit the bar between the sts tbl), work until

1 st remains, inc1, k1 = 2 incs.

Continue increasing on both every 4th and 6th row, until you reach 53 (55, 57, 59, 61, 63) sts.

Work even, until the work measures approx 17.8" / 45 cm. End with a WS row.

#### Sleeve cap

Bo 5 sts at the beg of the next 6 rows = 23 (25, 27, 29, 31, 33) sts. Bo all sts. Place a marker around the middle st = the middle of the shoulder. Same procedure for the second sleeve.

# Finishing

Stitch the back piece and the front piece together with Kitchener Stitch. Stitch the sleeves onto the sweater with the markers facing each other at the middle of the shoulder.

Stitch together the sleeve and side seams.

# **Polo neck**

Begin at the left shoulder and pick up approx 80-100 sts along the neckline from the RS. Work rib in the round on the circular needle like this: \*K1, p1\*. On the first rnd, work 3 x 2 sts together over the cable of 12 sts. Work until the polo neck measures approx 5.5" / 14 cm.

Bo very loosely from the WS or by means of stretchy bind off.
