



Gieleroth - Headband

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Materials 1 skein Metallico, col 05

Circular needles, 4.5 mm, 40 cm or short jumper needles, 4.5 mm

Cable needle (or a single double pointed needle)

Yarn Quality Metallico, Hobbii 70% polyamid, 21% acrylic, 9% merino/ 50 g = 115 m

Knitting gauge

The gauge isn't very important to this project, as you can adjust the length of the headband to fit your preferred size.

Sizes (head circumference) 53-56 (57-60) cm

Measurements 50 (52) cm

Pattern information

The headband is worked flat, until the preferred length is reached. The headband should be blocked or steamed when it is finished, because cable knit has a tendency to curl up. Do this before sewing up the two ends.

Pattern instructions

Cast on 26 sts and work in the flat.

Work as instructed by the diagram *or* follow the written directions below, repeating rows 1 through 8 until you have reached your preferred length:

Row 1: K4, p3, k12, p3, k4, turn.

Rows 2, 4, 6, and 8: P4, k3, p12, k3, p4, turn.

Row 3: Place 2 sts on a cable needle behind the work, k2, k2 from the cable needle, p3, place 6 sts on a cable needle behind the work, k6, k6 from the cable needle, p3, place 2 sts on a cable needle behind the work, k2, k2 from the cable needle, turn. **Row 5:** Work as row 1.

Row 7: Place 2 sts on a cable needle behind the work, k2, k2 from the cable needle, p3, k12, p3, place 2 sts on a cable needle behind the work, k2, k2 from the cable needle, turn.

Bind off when the work measures 50 (52) cm, or your preferred length. End on a row without cable knit sts.

Block or steam, and sew the ends together.
