



Poppy - Beret

Sizes: 3-6 (9-12) months, 2-3 (4-5) years

Head circumference: 14.6-16.1"
(17.3-18.5") 18.9-19.7" (20.5-21.3") / 37-41
(44-47) 48-50 (52-54) cm

Circular needles: US 1.5 (2.5 mm) and US
4 (3.5 mm) / 23.6" (60 cm).

Double pointed needles: US 1.5 (2.5 mm)
and US 4 (3.5 mm)

Accessories: 5 stitch markers

Gauge: 25 sts x 34-35 rnds in stockinette
stitch with needle US 4 (3.5 mm) = 4" (10 cm)

NB: Make a swatch to be sure to get the right
gauge. Change to a larger or smaller needle
size if necessary. It is also advisable to
measure the gauge during the work.

Yarn: Rainbow Cotton 8/4

Light Lime (#017) - 1 (1) 1 (1) skein

Dusty Lime (#074) - 1 (1) 2 (2) skein(s)

ELABORATIONS

Inc 1 st = Pick up the bar between 2 sts and k it through the back loop (tbl).

Stockinette stitch in the round = k all sts on all rnds.

ABBREVIATIONS

p = purl

dec = decrease

dec rnd = round with decreases

st(s) = stitch(es)

k = knit

circ needle = circular needle

st st = stockinette stitch

k2tog = knit 2 sts together

dpn = double pointed needles

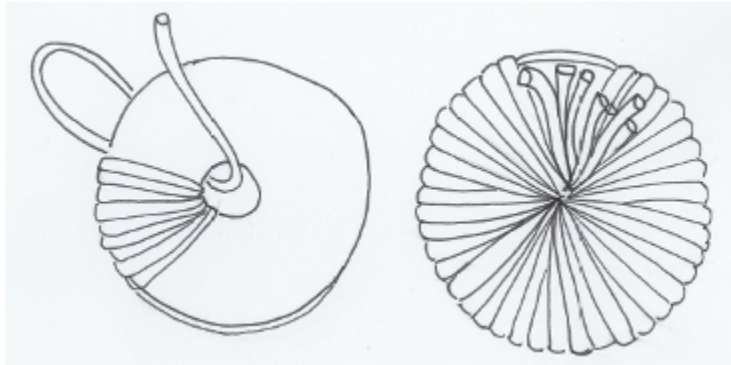
rnd(s) = round(s)

With circ needle or dpn US 1.5 (2.5 mm) and col 1 (Light Lime 017), co 114 (118) 124 (130) sts. If you use dpn, distribute the sts evenly on the 4 needles. Place a marker at the beginning of the rnd. Work approx 1-1.2" (2.5-3 cm) in rib (k1, p1). On the last rnd, adjust the number of sts to 115 (120) 125 (130) sts. Change to circ needle or dpn US 4 (3.5 mm) and col 2 (Dusty Lime 074). Work st st in the round.

NB: On the first rnd of st st, place 5 markers like this: Place the first marker at the beginning of the rnd and the remaining 4 markers with an interval of 23 (24) 25 (26) sts. On the next rnd, inc by 1 st to the left of each marker. Repeat the increases on the next rnd and then on every other rnd a total of 5 (6) 6 (6) times = 150 (160) 165 (170) sts. On the next 12 rnds, work pattern according to the chart.

NB: Since the number of sts does not match the pattern, you need to increase or decrease on the first rnd to reach 150 (162) 168 (168) sts on the needle. After working the pattern, adjust the number of sts back to 150 (160) 165 (170) sts. When the work measures approx 3" (3.1") 3.3" (3.3") / 7.5 (8) 8.5 (8.5) cm, decrease on the next rnd like this: Dec 1 st (= k2tog) to the left of the first marker and then on each side of each marker. End with a dec before the first marker at the end of the rnd. For every dec rnd, you have 10 sts less on the needle. Repeat the decreases on every other rnd another 11 (10) 9 (9) times and then on every 4th rnd another 0 (1) 2 (2) time(s). You now have 30 (40) 45 (50) sts on the needle. On the next rnd, k2tog throughout the rnd. Break the yarn and pull the thread through the remaining sts. Tighten and weave in the ends.

Pompom: Make a thick pompom with col 1 with a diameter of approx 1.2-1.6" (3-4 cm). Stitch the pompom onto the top of the beret.

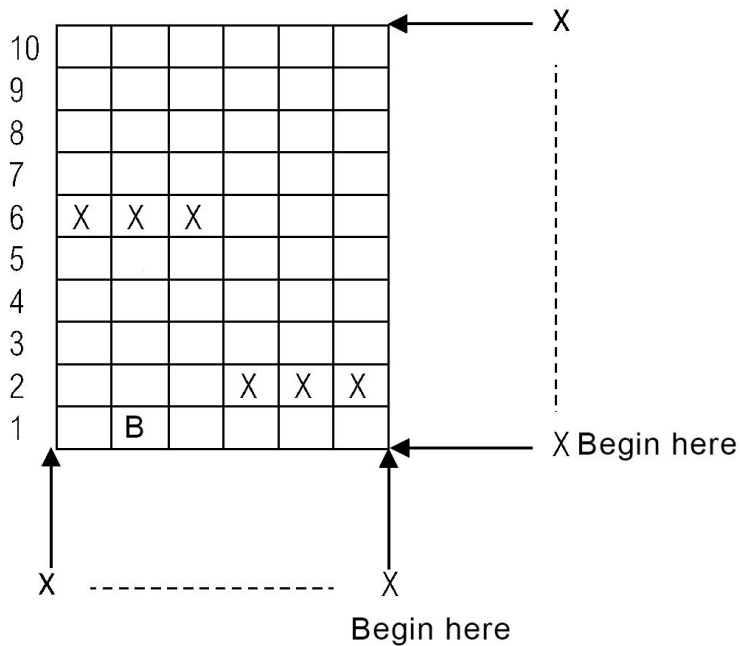


CHART

The chart shows all rnds.

When you work in the flat: first row = RS.

Start at the arrow "Begin here" and repeat the pattern repeat X-X.

B Bobble stitch: K 4 sts in the same st = k1, k1 tbl, k1, k1 tbl. Turn and p4. Turn and k2, pass the first st over the second st, k2tog, pass 1 st over the sts that were k tog.
