## Materials

2 balls of Twister Solid, color 110
4 balls of Diablo Print, color 01
Circular needle US 8 / $5 \mathrm{~mm}, 31.5$ " / 80 cm Markers

Yarn qualities
(20) Twister Solid, Hobbii

55 \% Cotton, 45 \% Acrylic, $3.5 \mathrm{oz} / 100 \mathrm{~g}=437$ yds / 400 m

## (0) Diablo Print, Hobbii

40 \% Acrylic, 30 \% Mohair, 30 \% Polyamide, $0.9 \mathrm{oz} / 25 \mathrm{~g}=246 \mathrm{yds} / 225 \mathrm{~m}$

## Gauge

15 sts $\times 23$ rows $=4$ " $/ 10 \mathrm{~cm}$ with 2 threads worked in pattern

## Sizes

One size

## Measurements

Width: approx 64.6" / 164 cm
Length: approx $35.4^{\prime \prime} / 90 \mathrm{~cm}$ measured from neck to tip.

## About the pattern

The shawl is worked with 1 thread of each yarn quality $=$ 2 threads.
The shawl is worked top down from the neck in lace pattern. Increases are worked on both sides of the shawl as well as on both sides of the middle.

## Elaboration

Increase (inc): Pick up the bar between the stitches and knit it through the back loop.

## Pattern

## Cast on

Co 3 sts on the circular needle with 1 thread of each yarn quality and work 7 rows in garter stitch.
Do not turn the work, but pick up 3 sts along the left side as well as 3 sts along the cast on edge $=9$ sts.

Place a marker after 3 sts on each side.
Row 1, WS: K3, p3, k3.
Row 2, RS: K3, inc, *k1, inc*, repeat from * to * a total of 3 times, k3 = 13 sts.
Row 3, WS: K3, p7, k3.
Row 4, RS: K3, inc, k2, inc, place marker, k3, place marker, inc, k2, inc, $k 3=17$ sts.
NB! The 3 outermost sts on each side are edge sts and must be k on all rows.
Increase sts within the edge sts as well on each side of the 3 middle sts $=4$ incs.

## Continue working pattern and increases

Row 1 (WS): $k$ all sts.
Row 2, RS: K3, inc, *yo, k2tog*, repeat from * to * until marker, inc, k3, inc, *yo, k2tog*, repeat from * to * until marker, inc,
k3 $=21$ sts.
Row 3 (WS): k all sts.
Row 4, RS: K3, inc, k until marker, inc, k3, inc, k until marker, inc, k3 = 25 sts.
Row 5, WS: K3, p until 3 sts remain, k3.
Row 6, RS: K 3 , inc, k until marker, inc, k 3 , inc, k until marker, inc, $\mathrm{k} 3=29$ sts.
Row 7, WS: K3, p until 3 sts remain, k3.
Row 8, RS: K3, inc, $k$ until marker, inc, $k 3$, inc, $k$ until marker, inc, $k 3=33$ sts.
Row 9, WS: K3, p until 3 sts remain, k3.
Row 10, RS: K3, inc, $k$ until marker, inc, k3, inc, $k$ until marker, inc, $k 3=37$ sts.
Repeat rows $1-10$ while continuing to increase the number of sts between the edge sts and the middle sts.
End with 4 rows of stockinette stitch.

## Edge

Work 6 rows of garter stitch.
