# Babyfryd - Mini <br> Sensory Cube

## MATERIALS

Baby Cotton col. 3, 7, 8, 41

Crochet hook 2.5 mm

Go Handmade Cube $8 \times 8 \mathrm{~cm}$ (3.2" $\times 3.2^{\prime \prime}$ )
Go Handmade Rattle Ring 63 mm
Go Handmade Teether Link - Star - 2 pcs
Go Handmade Wooden Ring 55 mm

## YARN USAGE

Col. A (7): Approx. 12 g / 0.42 oz (1 skein)
Col. B (8): Approx. 18 g / 0.42 oz (1 skein)
Col. C (41): Approx. 12 g / 0.42 oz (1 skein)
Color D (3): Approx. 12 g / 0.42 oz (1 skein)

## YARN QUALITY

(10) Baby Cotton, Hobbii

100\% Egyptian Cotton/ 50 g (1.75 oz) $=170$
meters (186 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS
mr: Magic ring
ch: Chain
st(s): Stitch(es)
SI st(s) Slip stitch
sc: Single crochet
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## PATTERN INFORMATION

The squares are crocheted in the round. All rounds begin with a ch 1. This does not count as a stitch, neither does it count towards the stitch total. End all rounds with a sl st in the first st.

## Squares

## Photo tutorial for making the squares - Refer to pages 14-21

1. Using col. A. Make a mr. Work 8 sc and end with a sl st. (8)
2. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in the first st. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following st". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the last st. End with a sl st. (16)
3. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in the first 2 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next $\mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the following 3 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last st. End with a sl st. (24)
4. Ch 1 . Work 1 sc in the first 3 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next $\mathrm{st}, 1 \mathrm{sc}$ in the following 5 sts ". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 2 sts. End with a sl st. (32)
5. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in the first 4 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 7 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 3 sts. End with a sl st. (40)
6. Ch 1 . Work 1 sc in the first 5 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 9 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 4 sts. End with a sl st. (48)
7. Ch 1 . Work 1 sc in the first 6 sts." Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 11 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 5 sts. End with a sl st. (56)
8. Ch 1 . Work 1 sc in the first 7 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 13 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 6 sts. End with a sl st. (64)
9. Ch 1 . Work 1 sc in the first 8 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 15 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 7 sts. End with a sl st. (72)

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10. Switch to col. D. Ch 1 . Work 1 sc in the first 9 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 17 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 8 sts. End with a sl st. (80) Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

You can check the size of your square against the cube - Depending on your gauge, you can work more or fewer rounds to make it fit the cube. The square is a bit smaller than the cube before they are sewn together.

Make another square in col. $A$, and afterwards 2 in col. $B$ and $C$ so you now have 6 squares in total.

## ASSEMBLING OF THE SQUARES



1. Sew the squares together using whip stitch in col. D. Sew them as shown in the picture.

2. Tighten gently as you work.

3. Attach the yarn in the middle of the 3 stitches at the corner of both squares. Now, use whip stitch and sew together through the stitches of both squares.

4. Repeat in all stitches along the side of the cube.

5. Like this. Now sew them together to create a box, however, keeping one side open for inserting of the cube.

6. Insert the cube and sew the remaining sides together.

7. Like this. Weave in ends.

## Assembling of the stars

1. Using col. A. Ch 5 . Work 1 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook. Work sc to the end of the row (4)
2. Ch 1 and turn. Work sc to the end of the row. (4)

Repeat row 2 until you have a total of 18 rows.
Fold your piece through the gap on the star and single crochet the ends together.
Leave a long tail for assembling.
Sew the star onto the square using col. A.
Make another strap and sew the second star onto the other square using col. A.


1. Fold your piece through the gap on the star.

2. Single crochet the ends together. Leave a long tail for assembling.

3. Make another strap and sew the second star onto the other square with color A.

4. Like this.

5. Sew the star onto the square using col.
A.

6. Like this.

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## Assembling of the rattle ring

1. Using col. C. Chain 5 . Work 1 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }} \mathrm{ch}$ from the hook. Work sc to the end of the row (4)
2. Ch 1 and turn. Work sc to the end of the row. (4)

Repeat row 2 until you have a total of 15 rows.
Fold your piece around the rattle and single crochet the ends together.
Leave a long tail for assembling.
Sew the rattle onto one of the squares using col. C.

## Assembling of the wooden ring

1. Using col. C. Chain 5 . Work 1 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook. Work sc to the end of the row (4)
2. Ch 1 and turn. Work sc to the end of the row. (4)

Repeat row 2 until you have a total of 10 rows.
Fold your piece around the ring and single crochet the ends together.
Leave a long tail for assembling.
Sew the ring onto one of the squares using col. C.


1. Fold your piece around ring.

2. Single crochet the ends together. Leave a long tail for assembling.

3. Sew the ring onto the other square using col. C.

## Tuft

Using col. B. Cut approx. 25 pieces of yarn each measuring approx. 30 cm . Assemble the pieces as described below:


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3. Use a crochet hook to pull the thread through a stitch in the middle of one of the squares using col. B.

5. Pull the yarn ends through the loop created with the thread and tighten gently.

7. Repeat this procedure in the first 3 rounds on the square to create a fluffy tuft.

4. Pull the thread halfway through the stitch.

6. Like this.

4. Tie a piece of yarn around the tuft.

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5. Trim the tuft to a suitable length.

7. Cut away the small end. Repeat for all the threads.

6. Tie a small knot on each thread.

8. Like this.

## Curls

## Small - make 5

1. Using col. B. Chain 12. Work 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook. Work 2 sc in each ch to the end of the row. Cut the yarn but leave a long tail for assembling.

2. Using col. B. Chain 12.

3. Work 2 sc in the $2^{\text {nd }}$ ch from the hook.

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3. Like this.

5. Cut the yarn but leave a long tail for assembling.

7. Sew them onto the other square using col. B.

4. Work 2 sc in each ch to the end of the row.

6. Make 5.

## Large - make 4

1. Using col. B. Chain 16. Work 2 hdc in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch from the hook. Work 2 hdc in each ch to the end of the row. Cut the yarn but leave a long tail for assembling.

2. Using col. B. Chain 16.

3. Like this.

4. Cut the yarn but leave a long tail for assembling.

5. Work 2 hdc in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ ch from the hook.

6. Work 2 hdc in each ch to the end of the row.

7. Make 4.

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7. Sew them onto the square with the small curls.

14. Work 1 sc in the following 3 sts".

15. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 3 sts".

17. Work 3 sc in the next st.

19. End with a sl st.

16. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 3 sts".

18. Work 1 sc in the last st.

20. Like this. (24)

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Round 4

21. Ch 1.

23. "Work 3 sc in the next st.

25. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 5 sts".

22. Work 1 sc in the first 3 sts.

24. Work 1 sc in the following 5 sts".

26. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 5 sts".

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27. Work 3 sc in the next st.

29. End with a sl st.

## Round 5


31. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in the first 4 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 7 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 3 sts. End with a sl st. (40)

28. Work 1 sc in the last 2 sts.

30. Like this. (32)

## Round 6


32. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in the first 5 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 9 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 4 sts. End with a sl st. (48)

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## Round 7


33. Ch 1 . Work 1 sc in the first 6 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 11 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 5 sts. End with a sl st. (56)

## Round 9


35. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in the first 8 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 15 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 7 sts. End with a sl st. (72)

## Round 8


34. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in the first 7 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 13 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 6 sts. End with a sl st. (64)

## Round 10


36. Switch to col. D. Ch 1. Work 1 sc in the first 9 sts. "Work 3 sc in the next st, 1 sc in the following 17 sts". Repeat from "to" 3 times in total. Work 3 sc in the next st. Work 1 sc in the last 8 sts. End with a sl st. (80) Cut the yarn and weave in ends.

37. Make 2 in each color so you have 6 squares in total.
