REQUIRED MOUNTING STEPS

Eyes in yarn projects (0-3 years)

For projects for children 0-3 years:

Mounting of eyes requires melting of end pieces and special stitching.

If nothing else is specified,
work in spiral rounds. To finish the work,
join the round with a sl st.
Leave a 20 cm length of yarn and cut.
Pull the yarn through the stitch.

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Filling is placed in the head.

Cut the yarn, thread it through the stitches, pull them tight, and sew the head together.

Shape the head/eye sockets:


Insert the needle beneath the head and up the inner side of the eye. Sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and lead the needle out beneath the head.

Then, insert the needle through the next stitch and up the inner side of the other eye. Again, sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and once again, lead the needle out beneath the head. Tighten the thread, allowing the tension to create indentations.

Hold the tension and tie two knots to preserve the indentations. The eye sockets are done.

The shaping of the head/eye sockets can also be done before the eyes are mounted.

Embroider nose with a shape like the letter "Y".

- 3.) 2 dc inc x 2, 4 dc, 2 dc inc x 5,
3 dc, 2 dc inc (23)

Switch to Colour A.

4. - 5.) 23 dc (23)
- 6.) 1 dc in the back loop (23)
- 7.) 10 dc, dc 2 tog x 4, 5 dc (19)
- 8.) dc 2 tog x 2, 5 dc,
dc 2 tog x 3, 4 dc (14)

Cut the yarn, thread it through the stitches, pull them tight, and sew the head together.*

Shape the head/eye sockets:

Insert the needle beneath the head and up the inner side of the eye. Sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and lead the needle out beneath the head.

Then, insert the needle through the next stitch and up the inner side of the other eye. Again, sew over a stitch at the eye stem, and once again, lead the needle out beneath the head. Tighten the thread, allowing the tension to create indentations.

Hold the tension and tie two knots to preserve the indentations. The eye sockets are done.

The shaping of the head/eye sockets can also be done before the eyes are mounted.

Good to know

Hook Size & Tension

Crocheters crochet very differently: some crochet with a hook size 2,0 mm and obtain the same size of design and quality as a person who crochets with a hook size 4,0 mm. We owe this knowledge to the team of crocheters who join us. The key to crochet a specific size is a lot about the crochet style/hands/skills, rather than the size of hook. Therefore, we will recommend a range of hook sizes.



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
