Circular needle US $9(5.5 \mathrm{~mm}) / 31.5^{\prime \prime}(80 \mathrm{~cm})$
Double pointed needles US $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) and US 9 (5.5 mm)

## Gauge

15 sts x 21 rnds = 4" (10 cm)
with Mohair Delight and circular needle US 9 ( 5.5 mm )

## Measurements

Width: 17.7" (19.7", 21.7", $23.6^{\prime \prime}$ ) / $45(50,55,60) \mathrm{cm}$ Length: 21.3" (22", 22.8", 23.6") / $54(56,58,60) \mathrm{cm}$

## About the pattern

The jumper is worked top down in the round with raglan increases. Each stripe is only worked once.

## Pattern



## Neckline

All sizes: Co 84 sts with circular needle US $7(4.5 \mathrm{~mm})$ and one strand of Easy Care Classic color A + one strand of Glitter Deluxe color H .
Work 1.6 " ( 4 cm ) in rib like this: *k1 tbl, p1*.

## Yoke

Divide the sts in preparation for raglan increases like this:
Place a marker around the first st, 11 sts for the sleeve, place a marker around the next st, 29 sts for the front piece, place a marker around the next st, 11 sts for the sleeve,
place a marker around the next st, 29 sts for the back piece $=4$ marked sts.
Change to circular needle US 9 ( 5.5 mm ).
Change to color $B$ (for the first stripe).

## Begin working raglan increases:

Work in stockinette stitch and increase 1 st on each side of the marked sts by picking up the bar between the sts and k it tbl $=8$ incs on the rnd.
Increase on every other round.
NB Raglan increases are worked concurrently with the stripes. See below about raglan increases where the final number of sts for each size is stated.

## Stripes <br> 1st stripe

Work 16 rnds with color B.

## 1st bronze stripe

Change to circular needle US 7 ( 4.5 mm ).
Work 2 rnds with color G .

## 2nd stripe

Change to circular needle US 9 ( 5.5 mm ).
Work $17(18,19,20)$ rnds with color C.

## 2nd bronze stripe

Change to circular needle US 7 ( 4.5 mm ).
Work 2 rnds with color G.

## 3rd stripe

Change to circular needle US 9 ( 5.5 mm ).
Work $17(18,19,20)$ rnds with color $D$.

## 3rd bronze stripe

Change to circular needle US 7 ( 4.5 mm ).
Work 2 rnds with color G.

## 4th stripe

Change to circular needle US 9 ( 5.5 mm ).
Work $17(18,19,20)$ rnds with color E.

## 4th bronze stripe

Change to circular needle US 7 ( 4.5 mm ).
Work 2 rnds with color G.

## 5th stripe

Change to circular needle US 9 ( 5.5 mm ).
Work $17(18,19,20)$ rnds with color F .

## Raglan increases

Continue increasing until you have increased a total of $19(23,27,31)$ times.
You now have $236(268,300,332)$ sts.

## Divide the work into sleeves and body.

Divide the sts for body and sleeves like this:
Place $49(57,65,73)$ a stitch holder with wire for the sleeve,
work the next $69(77,85,93)$ sts,
place $49(57,65,73)$ sts on a stitch holder with wire for the sleeve,
work the next $69(77,85,93)$ sts.
Now only work the $138(154,170,186)$ sts of the body.

## Body

Work even with stripes until the 5th stripe is finished.

## Rib edge

Change to circular needle US 7 ( 4.5 mm ).

Work with one strand of color A and one strand of color $H$. Work 1.6 " $(4 \mathrm{~cm})$ in rib like this: *k1 tbl, p1*.
Bo loosely in rib.

## Sleeves

Place the $49(57,65,73)$ sleeve sts on double pointed needles US $9(5.5 \mathrm{~mm})$.
Place a marker at the beginning of the rnd.
NB Now work 23 rnds of each stripe with Mohair Delight in order to reach the correct arm length.
Work even until the sleeve measures approx 15 " ( 38 cm ) or desired length.
On the last rnd, decrease evenly to reach 34 (36) 38 (40) sts.

## Rib edge on the sleeves

Change to circular needle US 7 ( 4.5 mm ).
Work with one strand of color A and one strand of color H. Work 3.1" $(8 \mathrm{~cm})$ in rib like this: *k1 tbl, p1*.
Bo loosely in rib.

Same procedure for the other sleeve.
