## MATERIALS

1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 col. nude 03  
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 col. red 058  
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 col. dark green 022  
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 col. orange 057  
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 col. white 001

Crochet hook 2.75 mm

Safety eyes 10 mm  
Stuffing  
Embroidery needle  
White thread  
Pipe cleaner/metal wire

## YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii  
100% cotton / 50 g = 170 meter

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain  
sc = single crochet  
inc = increase: 2 sts in same st  
dec = decrease: 2 sts together

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

15 cm tall made with the indicated yarn

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This cute Christmas Goose is ready for Christmas! He is crocheted in Rainbow Cotton 8/4, but if you want him even bigger you can use the Rainbow Cotton 8/6 or 8/8.

*Note: we don't recommend the use of pipe cleaner or metal wire if it is for kids.*

# Pattern



## EYES

(make 2 in white yarn)

**Rnd 1:** start with 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

**Rnd 2:** inc in all 6 sts [12]

**Rnd 3:** (sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) 3 times [15]. Weave in the yarn end and put aside. Sew onto the head later on using white thread.

## BODY

(in nude yarn)

**Rnd 1:** start with 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

**Rnd 2:** inc in all 6 st [12]

**Rnd 3:** (sc in next st, inc in next st) 6 times [18]

**Rnd 4:** (sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) 6 times [24]

**Rnd 5:** (sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) 6 times [30]

**Rnd 6:** (sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st) 6 times [36]

**Rnd 7:** (sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st) 6 times [42]

**Rnd 8:** (sc in next 6 sts, inc in next st) 6 times [48]

**Rnds 9-14:** sc in all 48 sts [48]

**Rnd 15:** dec in next st, sc in next 5 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 39 sts [46]

**Rnd 16:** sc in next 14 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 18 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 10 sts [44]

**Rnd 17:** sc in next 3 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 30 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 7 sts [42]

**Rnd 18:** sc in all 42 sts [42]

**Rnd 19:** sc in next 9 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 24 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 5 sts [40]

**Rnd 20:** dec in next st, sc in next 14 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 22 sts [38]

**Rnd 21:** sc in next 5 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 11 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 18 sts [36]

**Rnd 22:** dec in next st, sc in next 6 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 26 sts [34]

**Rnd 23:** sc in next 4 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 15 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 11 sts [32]

**Rnd 24:** sc in next 12 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 10 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 6 sts [30]

**Rnd 25:** dec in next st, sc in next 5 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 21 sts [28]

**Rnd 26:** sc in next 2 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 13 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 9 sts [26]

**Rnd 27:** dec in next st, sc in next 2 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 20 sts [24], stuff the body with stuffing.

**Rnd 28:** (sc in next 2 sts, dec in next st) 6 times [18]

**Rnd 29:** (sc in next st, dec in next st) 6 times [12]

**Rnd 30:** dec in all 12 sts [6], stuff the body firmly with stuffing, fasten off and weave in the yarn end.

## HEAD

(in nude yarn)

**Rnd 1:** start with 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

**Rnd 2:** inc in all 6 sts [12]

**Rnd 3:** (sc in next st, inc in next st) 6 times [18]

**Rnd 4:** (sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) 6 times [24]

**Rnd 5:** (sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) 6 times [30]

**Rnd 6:** (sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st) 6 times [36]

**Rnd 7:** (sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st) 6 times [42]

**Rnds 8-10:** sc in all 42 sts [42]

**Rnd 11:** (sc in next 6 sts, inc in next st) 6 times [48]

**Rnds 12-15:** sc in all 48 sts [48]

**Rnd 16:** (sc in next 6 sts, dec in next st) 6 times [42]

**Rnd 17:** (sc in next 5 sts, dec in next st) 6 times [36]. Sew the eyes to the head between round 8 and 13 by pushing the crochet hook in between stitches. If the toy is not for smaller children, you can remove the pin and glue on the eyes.

**Rnd 18:** (sc in next 4 sts, dec in next st) 6 times [30]

**Rnd 19:** (sc in next 3 sts, dec in next st) 6 times [24], stuff the head with stuffing.

**Rnd 20:** (sc in next st, dec in next st) 8 times [16]

**Rnd 21:** dec in all 16 sts [8], stuff the head firmly.

**Rnds 22-32:** sc in all 8 sts (8), fasten off and weave in the yarn end. Stuff the neck firmly with pipe cleaner. Put the end of the pipe cleaner into the body, to make the neck stand up. Sew the head to the body between rnd 6 and 7.

## BEAK

(in orange yarn)

**Rnd 1:** start with 4 sc in a magic ring [4]

**Rnd 2:** (sc in next st, inc in next st) 2 times [6]

**Rnd 3:** (sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st) 2 times [8]

**Rnd 4:** (sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) 2 times [10]

**Rnd 5:** (sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st) 2 times [12]

**Rnd 6:** (sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st) 2 times [14]

**Rnd 7:** (sc in next 6 sts, inc in next st) 2 times [16]

**Rnd 8:** (sc in next 7 sts, inc in next st) 2 times [18]

**Rnd 9:** sc in all 18 sts [18]

**Rnd 10:** (sc in next 8 sts, inc in next st) 2 times [20]. Fasten off and stuff the beak with stuffing. Sew to the head between rnd 12 and 18.

## WINGS

(make two in nude yarn)

**Rnd 1:** start with 6 sc in a magic ring [6]

**Rnd 2:** inc in all 6 sts [12]

**Rnd 3:** (sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st) 3 times [15]

**Rnds 4-8:** sc in all 15 sts [15]

Flatten and crochet 7 st through both layers. Sew the wings to the body between rnd 11 and 12.

## LEGS

(make 2 in orange yarn)

**Rnd 1:** ch 6, join in the round [6]

**Rnds 2-8:** sc in all 6 sts [6]

Stuff the legs firmly with pipe cleaner. Sew onto the body between rnd 11 and 14 with 8 sts between the legs.

## FEET

(make two in orange yarn)

**Rnd 1:** ch 6. Stitches are worked around both sides of the foundation chain [6]

**Rnd 2:** (sc in next 4 sts, 3 sc in next st) 2 times [14]

**Rnd 3:** (sc in next 4 sts, inc in next 3 st) 2 times [20]

**Rnds 4-7:** sc in all 20 sts [20]

**Rnd 8:** sc in next 7 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 8 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 1 st [18]

**Rnd 9:** sc in next 6 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 7 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 1 st [16]

**Rnd 10:** sc in all 16 sts [16]

**Rnd 11:** sc in next 6 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 6 sts, dec in next st [14]

**Rnd 12:** sc in next 5 sts, dec in next st, sc in next 5 sts, dec in next st [12]

**Rnds 13-14:** sc in all 12 sts [12]

**Rnd 15:** dec in all 12 sts [6]. Fasten off and weave in the yarn end. Do not stuff.

Sew the feet to the legs.

## HAT

(start in red yarn)

**Rnd 1:** start with 4 sc in a magic ring [4]

**Rnd 2:** sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st [5]

**Rnd 3:** sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st [6]

Change to green yarn.

**Rnd 4:** sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st [7]

**Rnd 5:** sc in next 3 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 3 sts [8]

**Rnd 6:** sc in next 7 sts, inc in next st [9]

Change to red yarn.

**Rnd 7:** sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 4 sts [10]

**Rnd 8:** sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 7 sts [11]

**Rnd 9:** sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 5 sts [12]

Change to green yarn.

**Rnd 10:** sc in next 11 sts, inc in next st [13]

**Rnd 11:** sc in next 8 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 4 st [14]

**Rnd 12:** sc in next 13 sts, inc in next st [15]

Change to red yarn.

**Rnd 13:** sc in next 7 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 7 sts [16]

**Rnd 14:** sc in next 2 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 13 sts [17]

**Rnd 15:** inc in next st, sc in next 16 sts [18]

Change to green yarn.

**Rnd 16:** sc in next 10 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 7 sts [19]

**Rnd 17:** sc in next 7 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 11 sts [20]

**Rnd 18:** sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 15 sts [21]

Change to red yarn.

**Rnd 19:** sc in next 20 sts, inc in next st [22]

**Rnd 20:** sc in next 8 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 13 sts [23]

**Rnd 21:** sc in next 11 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 11 sts [24]

Change to green yarn.

**Rnd 22:** (inc in next st, sc in next 7 sts) 3 times [27]

**Rnd 23:** (sc in next 4 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 4 sts) 3 times [30]

**Rnd 24:** (inc in next st, sc in next 9 sts) 3 times [33]

Change to red yarn.

**Rnd 25:** (sc in next 5 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 5 sts) 3 times [36]

**Rnd 26:** (sc in next 11 sts, inc in next st) 3 times [39]

**Rnd 27:** (sc in next 6 sts, inc in next st, sc in next 6 sts) 3 times [42]

Change to green yarn.

**Rnds 28-30:** sc in all 42 sts [42]

Change to red yarn.

**Rnds 31-33:** sc in all 42 sts [42]

**Rnd 34, in back loop only:** (sc in next 20 sts, inc in next st) 2 times [44]

**Rnds 35-36:** sc in all 44 sts [44]. Fasten off and weave in the yarn end. Fold up rnd 34-36 to make the brim of the hat. Make a pompom in red yarn with a diameter of approx. 2.5 cm. You can use a fork to tie the yarn around. Sew the pompom to the hat.

## SCARF

(in red yarn)

Ch 5

**Row 1:** start in the 2nd chain from the hook, sc in next 4 sts [4], ch 1 and turn.

**Rows 2-55:** sc in all 4 sts, ch 1, turn

**Row 56:** sc in next 4 sts (4). Fasten off and weave in the yarn end.

Add fringes to each end of the scarf.
