## Sweater

## MATERIALS


1 (1) 2 (2) 2 skein(s) Malaga #01- Col. 1  
1 (1) 1 (2) 2 skein(s) Malaga #06 - Col 2.  
2 (2) 2 (3) 3 skein(s) Malaga #20 - Col 3.  
1 skein Fluffy Day #01 - Col 4.

Straight needles 4 mm (US 6) and 5 mm (US 8).  
Circular needle 4 mm (US 6), 40 cm (16").

Tapestry needle

## YARN QUALITY

 **Malaga**, World of Yarn  
100% Premium HB Acrylic  
Skein 100 gr / 3.5 oz = 165 m /180 yds

 **Fluffy Day**, Hobbiii  
100% Acrylic  
Skein 100 gr / 3.5 oz = 285 m /310 yds

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 17 sts x 23 rows  
stockinette stitches using needle 5 mm (US 8)

## NOTIONS

Edge stitch (edge st) = K first and last st on every row.  
Make 1(M1) = Pick up strand between 2 sts, twist and k.

## ABBREVIATIONS

BO = bind off  
CO = cast on  
K = knit  
P = Purl  
RS = right side  
St/sts = stitch /stitches  
St st = Stockinette stitch  
WS = wrong side

## SIZE

4 (6) 8 (10) 12 yrs

## MEASUREMENTS

**Chest:** 70 (76) 82 (88) 94 cm / 27.5" (30") 32.3" (34.6") 37"

**Length:** 43 (46) 50 (54) 58 cm / 17" (18") 19.7" (21.25") 22.8"

**Sleeve, length:** 28 (32) 36 (40) 43 cm / 11" (12.6") 14" (14.7") 17"

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

Sweater is worked in separate pieces, bottom to top.

### BACK

With straight needles 4 mm (US 6) with color 1 CO 65 (71) 77 (83) 91 sts. Work k1 p1 rib. First row is WS. Work 11 (11) 13 (13) 17 rows total. Change to straight needles 5 mm (US 8).

Continue in St st inside edge st in each side. On first row dec 4 (4) 6 (6) 8 sts evenly spaced = 61 (67) 71 (77) 83 sts.

Continue as follows:

Color 1: 2 (2) 4 (4) 4 rows.

Change to color 2. Work chart 1 (= 16 rows).

Color 2: 6 (10) 14 (16) 22 rows.

Work chart 2 (= 8 rows).

Color 3: 2 (2) 4 (4) 4 rows.

Chart 3 (= 15 rows).

Color 3: 15 (15) 17 (19) 19 rows.

Chart 4 (= 8 rows).

Color 3 to end of work.

**NOTE!** When work measures 41 (44) 48 (52) 56 cm / 16.1" (17.3") 18.9" (20.4") 22" BO for neck 21 (21) 23 (23) 25 sts in center of Back and finish each side separately.

**Left side:** WS; work to end. RS; BO for neck 2 sts, work to end. WS; work to end. RS; BO remaining sts.

**Right side:** WS; work to end. RS; work to end. WS; BO for neck 2 sts, work to end. RS; BO remaining sts.

## FRONT

Work same as Back.

NOTE! When work measures 38 (41) 44 (48) 51 cm / 15" (16") 17.3" (18.9") 20" BO for neck 13 (13) 13 (13) 15 sts in center and finish each side separately.

**Right side:** All rows WS; work to end. RS; BO for neck 2 sts. Continue to BO 2-1-1 from RS for All rows RS BO for neck 2-2-1-1 (2-2-1-1) 2-2-1-1-1 (2-2-1-1-1) 2-2-1-1-1 sts.  
RS; BO remaining sts same as on Back.

**Left side:** Work same as Right side but mirrored. BO for neck from WS.

## SLEEVES

Make 2 of the same.

Read through before you begin.

With straight needles 4 mm and color 1: CO 37 (39) 39 (41) 41sts. Work k1 p1 rib. First row is WS.

Work 11 (11) 13 (13) 17 rows total. Change to straight needles 5 mm (US 8).

work St st inside edge sts to end as follows:

Color 1: 2 (2) 4 (4) 4 rows.

Color 2: 16 (22) 24 (26) 28 rows.

Chart 2 (= 8 rows).

Color 3 to end or work. Last row is WS.

**NOTE!** Row 3 (3) 5 (5) 5 St st M1 inside edge st in each side. Repeat M1 every third row another 6 (0) 0 (0) 0 times total, every 5th row 3 (9) 10 (5) 7 times total and every 7th row 0 (0) 0 (5) 4 time total = 57 (59) 61 (63) 65 sts. Expand the sides with the color or the chart you are knitting at the time. When work measures 28 (32) 36 (40) 43 cm / 11" (12.6") 14" (14.7") 17" BO remaining sts.

## FINISHING

Block all pieces to measurements.

Sew shoulder seams.

**Neckband: With RS facing, circular needle** 4 mm (US 6), 40 cm (162) and color 3: PU 68 (68) 72 (72) 76 sts along neckline. Work k1 p1 rib. Work 11 (11) 11 (11) 13 rounds. BO. Fold neckband double towards WS and sew.

Sew in sleeves. Sew seams in side and sleeve.

Embroidery: Nose, ears and horns see chart.

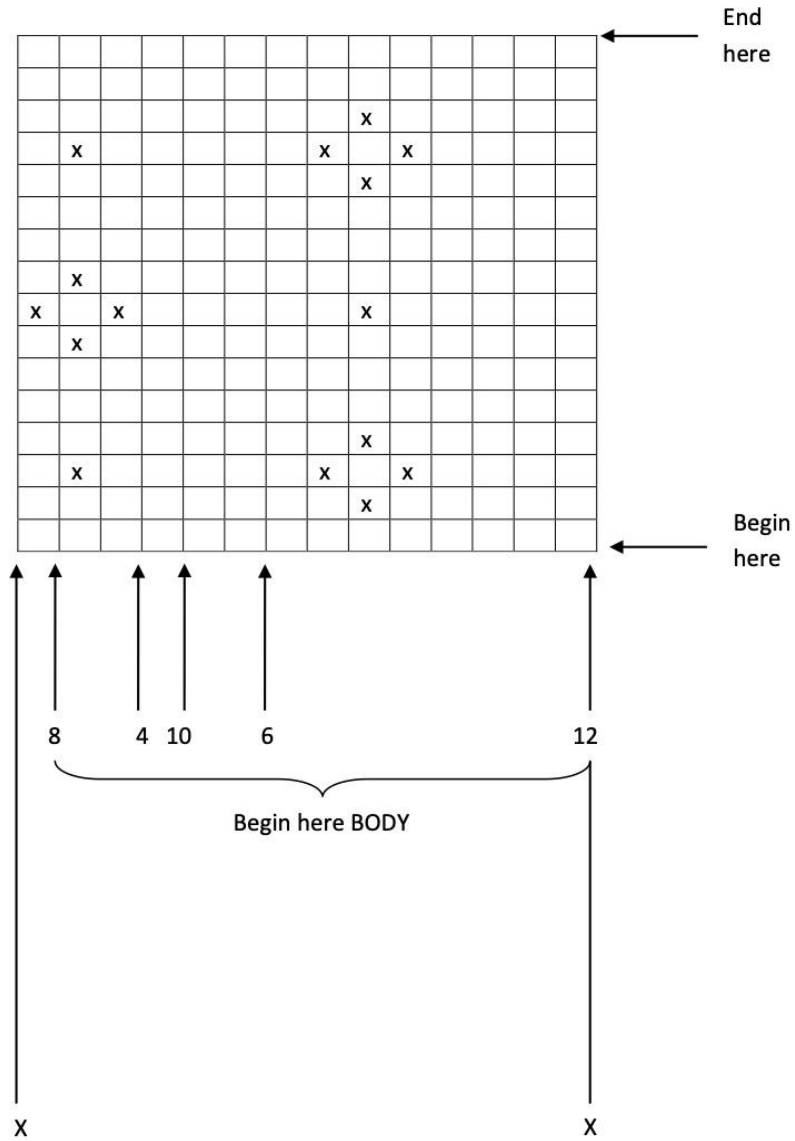

Chart 1

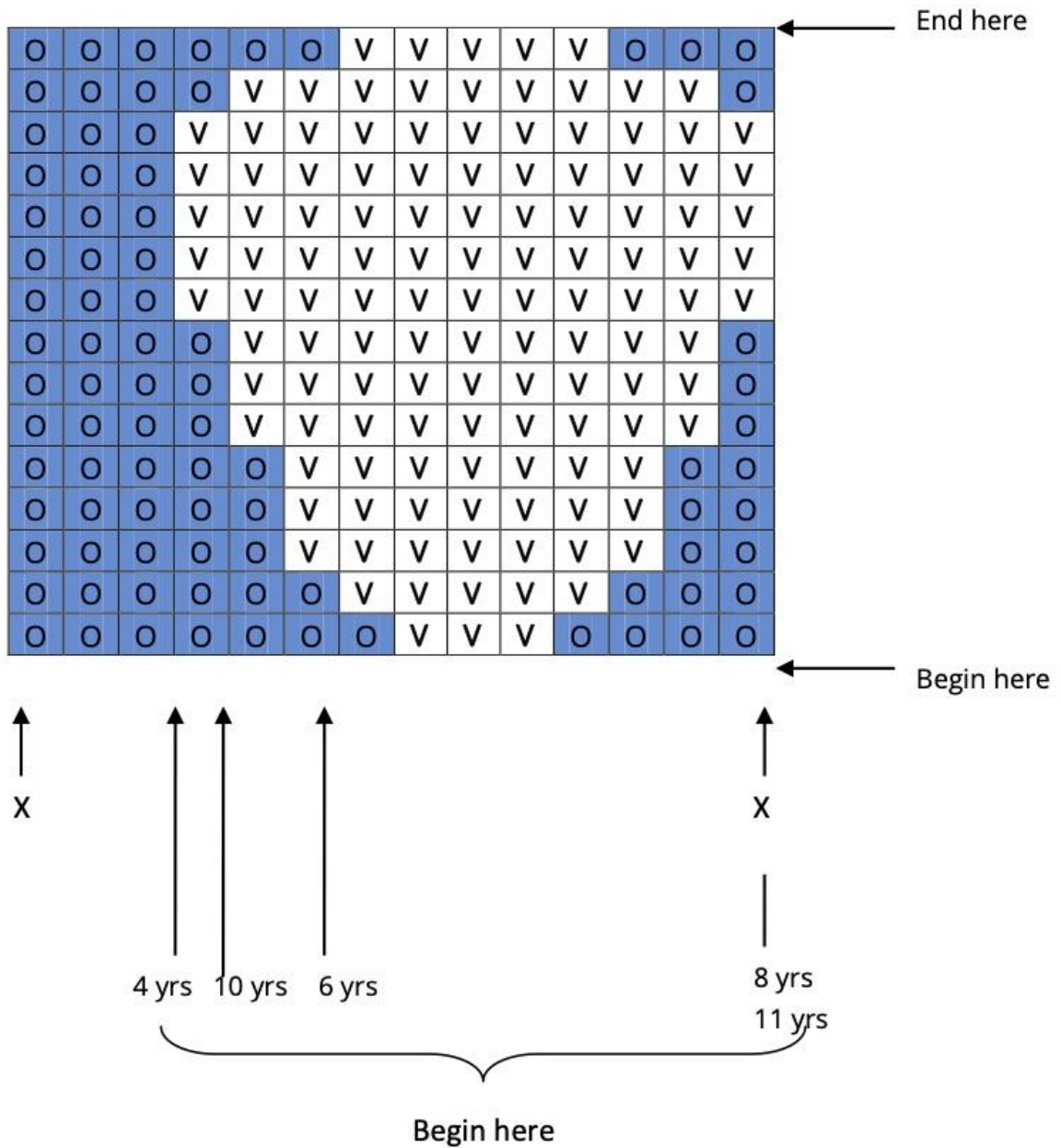


= CO 2

 Rows: Begin at "Arrow" and work given number of rows in text.

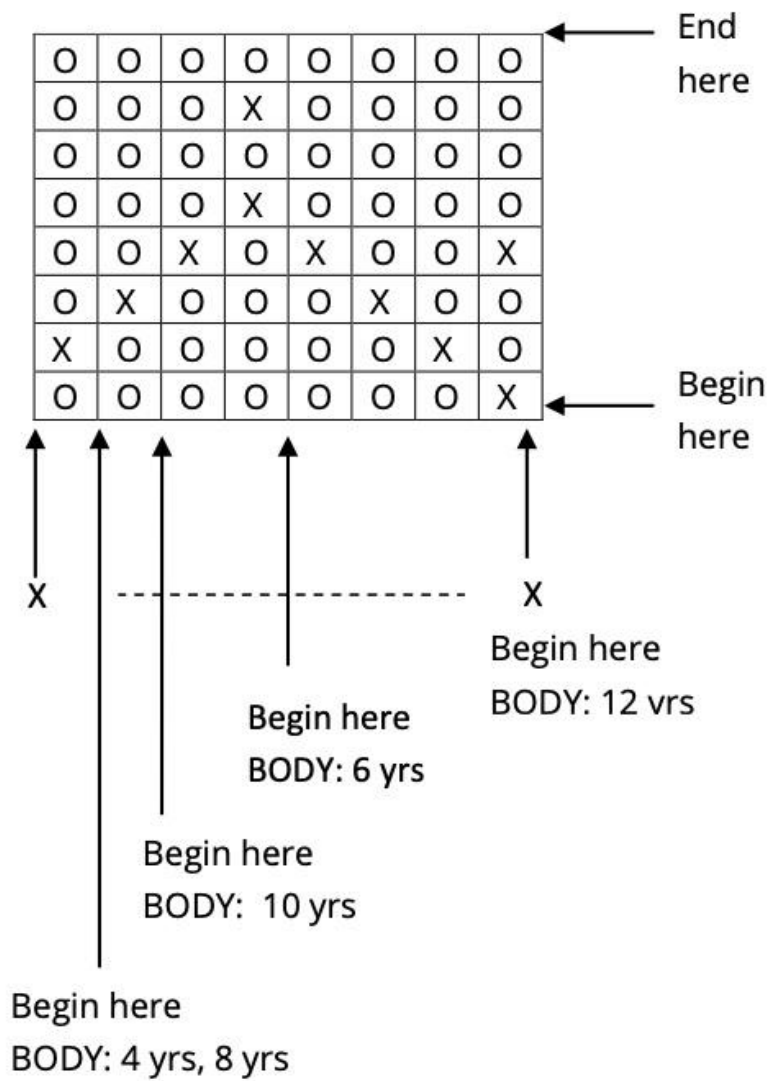

Rows: Begin at "arrow" and work given number of rows in text.
