



KNITTING PATTERN

Merry Sweater

MATERIALS

10 (12) 14 skein(s) of Snowstorm color 20 1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4 color 41 1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4 color 24 1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4 color 124

Knitting needles 8 mm (US 11) Knitting needles 9 mm (US 13) Crochet hook 3 mm (US D/3) Filling for the lights (Polyfil) Sewing needle

YARN QUALITY

Snowstorm, Hobbii 100 % Wool 50 g = 50 m (55 yrd) Friends Cotton 8/4, Hobbii 100% Cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 160 m (175 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 12 sts x 16 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

k = knit
p = purl
st/s = stitch/es
CO = cast on
BO = bind off
ch = chain
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
inc = increase
dec = decrease
sl st = slip stitch

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 48 (53) 57 cm / 18.9" (20.8") 22.4" Length: 52 (57) 65 cm / 20.4" (22.4") 25.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

Sweater reminiscent of a Christmas tree is knitted on straight needles, consisting of separate pieces that are sewn together at the end. Then, we crochet the lights and sew them onto the sweate.

INFO AND TIPS

The lights are crocheted in the round, without joining. There are 13 lights (6 red and 7 yellow) on the sweater in the photo, but the number, colors and placement are all up to you! You can also place lights on the back of the sweater.

BODY

Front Piece

With the 8 mm (US 11) needles CO 54 (60) 66 sts. Knit 8 rows with rib stitch (k2, p2). Change to 9 mm (US 13) needles and knit 60 (68) 76 rows with stockinette stitch. Start forming the neckline in the 61st (69th) 76th row as follows:

BO 12 (12) 14 sts in the middle of the front piece, and then on both sides of the neckline in every other row 2 sts, 1st and 1 st. Continue working the remaining stitches on both sides for 4 more rows.

Finish in the 73rd (81st) 88th row.

Back Piece

Work it like the front piece. Start forming the neckline in the 67th (76th) 83rd row as follows: BO 14 (14) 16 sts in the middle of the back piece, and then on both sides of the neckline in every other row 2 sts and 1 st.

SLEEVES

With the 8 mm (US 11) needles CO 30 (30) 32 sts. Knit 8 rows with rib stitch (k2, p2). Change to 9 mm (US 13) needles and work in stockinette stitch, increasing on each side of the sleeve in every 4th row, 5 times (7 times) 9 times = 40sts (44 sts) 50 sts. Next, inc in every 6th row, 6 times. Finish the sleeve in the 52 sts (56 sts) 62 sts.

NECKLINE

With 8 mm (US 11) needles CO 86 (86) 88 sts. Work 6 rows in rib stitch (k2, p2), BO.

FINISHING

First, sew the shoulders together with a mattress stitch, then sew the neck rib to the neckline flat with backstitch and the other parts of the sweater again with mattress stitch. Secure all cut ends.



CROCHET LIGHTS

With red or yellow color: Make 3 sc into a magic ring, work in round without joining.

Round 1: hdc inc around (6)

Round 2: hdc 2, hdc inc- all around (8)

Round 3: hdc 1, hdc inc (12)

Round 4: hdc 2, hdc inc (16)

Rounds 5-6: hdc around (16)

Round 7: hdc 2, hdc dec (12)

This is a good moment to stuff.

Round 8: hdc 1, hdc dec (8)

Change to black color.

Round 9: sc 1, sc dec (6)

Round 10: sc around (6)

Finish with sl st, cut the strands and tuck them inside.

FINISHING

Lay the sweater out flat and pin the lights on the surface of the sweater as you like. Using a crochet hook, attach the black yarn to the first light, and then with the sl st to the sweater, start crocheting the chain (leaving it loose) until you reach the next light, attach it to the sweater with the sl st, continue in the same way with the rest of the lights. Cut the yarn and weave the end.
