# Noisy

**Mini dress**

## MATERIALS

10 (10) 11 skeins of Highland Wool color  
Heather 36

Crochet hook 3.5 mm (US E-4)  
Yarn sewing needle  
Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

 **Highland Wool**, Hobbii  
100 % Peruvian Highland Wool  
50 g / 1.75 oz = 175 m / 191 yds

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 20 sts x 13 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain  
sc = single crochet  
dc = double crochet  
sl st = slip stitch  
inc = increase  
dec = decrease

## SIZE

S (M) L

## MEASUREMENTS

Bust approx.: 46 (48) 50 cm / 17.7" (18.1")  
19.6"  
Length: 82 (82) 82 cm / 32.2"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

Each shoulder ruffle is made from a one skein of yarn, so that they are the same size, start making each with a single skein.

## BACK PIECE

Ch 105 (105) 113.

Row 1: 1 dc in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, 1 dc to the end = 104 (104) 112 sts.

Row 2-8: ch 2 (counts as first dc), 1 dc to the end, turn.

Row 9: Dec in the beginning and at the end of every 3<sup>rd</sup> (4<sup>th</sup>) 4<sup>th</sup> row, until you have 78 (82) 86 sts.

Then, work 1 dc in each st until the piece measures 60 cm (23.5") = approx. 66 rows.

Fasten off.

To shape the armholes, join the yarn in the 7<sup>th</sup> st from the beginning, work 1 dc until 6 sts before the end of the row = 66 (70) 74 sts.

Work 1 dc in each st for about 19 cm (7.5").

To shape the neck, work first 17 (17) 19 sts and turn, repeat one more row. Fasten off.

Rejoin the yarn after 32 (36) 36 sts. Work 1 dc in the last 17 (17) 19 sts, turn and repeat one more row.

## FRONT PIECE

Work the same way as the Back piece until the armholes measures 5 cm (2").

To shape the neck, work 1 dc in the first 28 (29) 31 sts, turn.

Dec 1 dc at the neck edge on every row until you have 17 (17) 19 sts.

Work until the armhole measures the same as the back.

Fasten off.

Miss the 10 (12) 12 sts in the center, rejoin the yarn and work in the same way like at the other side.

## SLEEVES

Ch 53 (53) 57.

Row 1: 1 dc in the 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook, 1 dc to the end = 52 (52) 56 sts.

Row 2: ch 2, 1 dc to the end.

Row 3: ch 2, \*2 dc, inc\* repeat from \* to \* till the end of the row = 68 (68) 72 sts.

Work 1 dc in each st until the piece measures 30 cm (12") = approx. 38 rows.

Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Put the Front and Back right side together, and sew the shoulders with sl st.

Then, on the right side of work, make one sc round across the neckline.

Lay the dress and sleeves out flat and sew the sleeves on the wrong side with sc.

And finally, sew the sides of the dress and the sleeves, all with sc on the wrong side.

## RUFFLES

Lay the dress flat and put the stitch marker on the 7<sup>th</sup> st on the shoulder seam counting from the neckline, and the second one on the 19<sup>th</sup> st 25 rows below, so that they are more or less on the same line. Do the same on the Back.

On this line you will make a ruffle.

NOTE: finish each row with ch 1 and start the next row with 1 sl st in 2<sup>nd</sup> st from the beginning.

Insert your crochet hook into the st marked with a marker (at the bottom) and start crocheting towards the shoulder as follows:

Row 1: sc inc in the next 5 sts, hdc inc in the next 5 sts, dc inc up to 1 st before the shoulder seam, 3 dc in next st, 3 dc in the st right after the seam, dc inc up to 10 sts before the stitch marker, hdc inc in the next 5 sts, sc inc in the next 5 sts, ch 1, turn.

Work inserting the hook between sts, not into the st loop.

Row 2: Work respectively sc in sc, hdc in hdc, dc in dc but inc every 2 sts.

Row 3: Work respectively 1 sc in sc, 1 hdc in hdc, 1 dc in dc.

Repeat Row 3 almost to the end of the skein (approx. 23 rows), leaving long tail to sew.

Fold in half to the inside and sew to the 1<sup>st</sup> row.

Weave all the ends.
