Gunnar the Pig

MATERIALS

2 skeins of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 046 (Old Rose)
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 003 (Nude)

Safety eyes 6 mm
Scissors
Fiberfill
Pins
Needle for assembling
Crochet hook 2.5 mm

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii
100% Cotton 50 g (1.75 oz) = 170 meters (186 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
sl st(s) = slip stitch(es)
bl = back loop
Rnd(s) = round(s)
Inc = increase: 2 sc in the same stitch
Dec = decrease: Sc2tog
() = number of stitches after ended round
Color change: insert your hook in the next stitch and pull the yarn back through. Now you have 2 loops on your hook. Then, using the hook, pull the new color through the two loops – and you have made the color change. Cut off the old yarn and weave in the ends well.

One-size

MEASUREMENTS

Approx. 22 cm (8.8") tall

INFO AND TIPS

Each of the pieces is worked separately and after each crocheted piece you will find a description of how to assemble Gunnar.

HEAD

Color: 046 Old Rose

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: *1 sc, inc* x6 (18)

Rnd 4: *2 sc, inc* x6 (24)

Rnd 5: *3 sc, inc* x6 (30)

Rnd 6: *4 sc, inc* x6 (36)

Rnd 7: *5 sc, inc* x6 (42)

Rnd 8: 1 sc in each st (42)

Rnd 9: 1 sc in bl of each st (42)

Rnd 10: *5 sc, dec* x6 (36)

Rnds 11-15: 1 sc in each st (36)

Rnd 16: *5 sc, inc* x6 (42)

Rnd 17: 1 sc in each st (42)

Rnd 18: *6 sc, inc* x6 (48)

Rnd 19: 1 sc in each st (48)

Rnd 20: *7 sc, inc* x6 (54)

Rnd 21: 1 sc in each st (54)

Rnd 22: *8 sc, inc* x6 (60)

Rnd 23: 1 sc in each st (60)

Rnd 24: *9 sc, inc* x6 (66)

Rnds 25-28: 1 sc in each st (66)

Now, attach the safety eyes with 7 stitches in between, between rnds 16 and 17

Rnd 29: *9 sc, dec* x6 (60)

Rnd 30: *8 sc, dec* x6 (54)

Rnd 31: *7 sc, dec* x6 (48)

Rnd 32: *6 sc, dec* x6 (42)

Rnd 33: *5 sc, dec* x6 (36)

Rnd 34: *4 sc, dec* x6 (30)

Rnd 35: *3 sc, dec* x6 (24)

Now, stuff the head.

Rnd 36: *2 sc, dec* x6 (18)

Rnd 37: *1 sc, dec) x6 (12)

Stuff the head one last time

Rnd 38: dec x6 (6)

Now, sew together the last 6 sts. Sew through one of the loops of each of the last 6 sts. Pull the thread to close the hole and weave in the end.

Embroider two nostrils on the pig. Embroider them at rnd 4 and make them approx. 4 stitches wide.

BODY

Color: 046 Old Rose

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: *1 sc, inc* x6 (18)

Rnd 4: *2 sc, inc* x6 (24)

Rnd 5: *3 sc, inc* x6 (30)

Rnd 6: *4 sc, inc* x6 (36)

Rnd 7: *5 sc, inc* x6 (42)

Rnd 8: *6 sc, inc* x6 (48)

Rnd 9: *7 sc, inc* x6 (54)

Rnd 10: *8 sc, inc* x6 (60)

Rnd 11: *9 sc, inc* x6 (66)

Rnds 12-19: 1 sc in each st (66)

Rnd 20: *9 sc, dec* x6 (60)

Rnds 21-23: 1 sc in each st (60)

Rnd 24: *8 sc, dec* x6 (54)

Rnds 25-27: 1 sc in each st (54)

Rnd 28: *7 sc, dec* x6 (48)

Rnds 29-31: 1 sc in each st (48)

Rnd 32: *6 sc, dec* x6 (42)

Rnds 33-35: 1 sc in each st (42)

Begin stuffing the body.

Rnd 36: *5 sc, dec* x6 (36)

Rnds 37-39: 1 sc in each st (36)

Rnd 40: *4 sc, dec* x6 (30)

Rnds 41-42: 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 43: *3 sc, dec* x6 (24)

Rnd 44: 1 sc in each st (24)

Stuff the body well.

Cut off the yarn but be careful to leave a long tail for sewing the head onto the body. The head should point downward a little.

ARM X 2

Begin with color 003 Nude

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: *1 sc, inc* x6 (18)

Rnd 4: *2 sc, inc* x6 (24)

Rnds 5-6: 1 sc in each st (24)

Switch to color 046 Old Rose

Rnd 7: *2 sc, dec* x6 (18)

Rnd 8: 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 9: *4 sc, dec* x3 (15)

Rnds 10-27: 1 sc in each st (15)

Stuff the hand well and a little less in the actual arm. And finally, crochet the opening closed with 7 sl sts. Cut off the yarn but be careful to leave a long tail for sewing the arm on.

Cut a piece of yarn of the same color 003 nude. Pull the strand through the arm at the transition from one color to the other. Tie a tight double knot to create a "hoof" and weave in the ends. Sew the arm onto the top of the body.

LEG X 2

Begin with color 003 nude

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: *1 sc, inc* x6 (18)

Rnd 4: *2 sc, inc* x6 (24)

Rnd 5: *3 sc, inc* x6 (30)

Rnd 6: 1 sc in each st (30)

Switch to color 046 Old Rose

Rnd 7: 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 8: *3 sc, dec* x6 (24)

Rnd 9: 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 10: *2 sc, dec* x6 (18)

Rnd 11: 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnds 12-25: 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 26: *4 sc, dec* x3 (15)

Stuff the foot well and a little less in the actual leg. And finally, sl st the opening closed. Cut off the yarn but be careful to leave a long tail for sewing the leg on.

Cut a piece of yarn in color 003 nude. Pull the strand through the leg at the transition from one color to the other. Tie a tight double knot to create a "hoof" and weave in the ends.

Then sew the legs on under the body at rnd 3. The legs should point outward a bit.

EAR X 2

Color: 046 Old Rose

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a magic ring (6)

Rnd 2: inc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in each st (12)

Rnd 4: *1 sc, inc* x6 (18)

Rnds 5-6: 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 7: *2 sc, inc* x6 (24)

Rnds 8-10: 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 11: *2 sc, dec* x6 (18)

Rnds 12-13: 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 14: *1 sc, dec* x6 (12)

Fold the ear flat and crochet closed with 6 sl sts. Cut off the yarn but be careful to leave a long tail for sewing the ear onto the head. Sew the ears on 7 rounds behind the eyes with 9 stitches in between.

TAIL

Ch 13. Begin in the 2nd st from the hook and then work 2 dc in each st. Cut the yarn but be careful to leave a long tail for sewing the tail onto Gunnar.
