

CROCHET PATTERN Twister Flower

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Amigo XL - Wisteria (A58)
1 skein of Amigo XL - Dark Magenta (A52)
1 skein of Amigo XL - Egg Yolk (A37)
1 skein of Atlas Happy Feet - Blaze (13)
1 skein of Glitter Deluxe - Terracotta (17518)

Crochet hook 4.5 mm (US 7)
Metal wire 5 meters ( 5.47 yards) of 2 mm
Fiberfill

## YARN QUALITY

(64) Amigo XL, Hobbii

100 \% HB Acrylic
$150 \mathrm{~g}(5.25 \mathrm{oz})=100 \mathrm{~m}(109 \mathrm{yds})$
(a10) Atlas Happy Feet, Hobbii
75 \% superwash-treated wool
25 \% polyamide
$100 \mathrm{~g}(5.25 \mathrm{oz})=420 \mathrm{~m}(459 \mathrm{yds})$
Glitter Deluxe, Go Handmade
100 \% polyester
$30 \mathrm{~g}(1.1 \mathrm{oz})=1800-2100$ meters
(1950-2300 yds)

## GAUGE

$10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=17 \mathrm{sc} \times 23$ rows
worked in rounds

ABBREVIATIONS<br>sc = single crochet<br>ch $=$ chain<br>rw = row<br>tog = together (is used when crocheting two stitches together as one)<br>$\mathrm{dc}=$ double crochet

## SIZE

Onesize

## MEASUREMENTS

Length, stem 1: 70 cm (28")
Length, stem 2: 80 cm (32")

## INFO AND TIPS

Twister Flower is worked as two separate stems with one and two heads respectively, each consisting of a round carpel and two layers of petals, which are attached at the end before the stems are twisted together.

Stuff with fiberfill as you go.

## STEM 1

Amigo XL Dark - Magenta (A52)
Begin with 6 sc in a magic ring (6).
Work 1 rnd of 2 sc in each st (12).
Work 1 sc in each stitch until your piece measures 62 cm (24.8")
Work another rnd of 2 sc in each st (24).
Then 1 rnd of 1 sc in each st.
End with a sl st and break the yarn. Pass a long piece of wire down through the stem.

## STEM 2

Amigo XL - Wisteria (A58)
Begin with 6 sc in a magic ring (6).
Work 1 rnd of 2 sc in each st (12).
Work 1 sc in each st until your piece measures $50 \mathrm{~cm}\left(20^{\prime \prime}\right)$
Work another rnd of 2 sc in each st (24).

Begin to make the branching by skipping 11 sts and work 1 sc in the 12 th st so that the stem splits in two.

Branching 1
Work in the round, 1 sc in each stitch (12) and continue until the branching measures $20 \mathrm{~cm}\left(8^{\prime \prime}\right)$.

Work another rnd of 2 sc in each st (24).
Then 1 rnd of 1 sc in each st.
End with a sl st and break the yarn. Pass a long piece of wire down through the branching and down through the stem. Then continue with the second branching.

Branching 2
Work in the round, 1 sc in each stitch (12) and continue until the branching measures 5 cm ( $8^{\prime \prime}$ ).

Work another rnd of 2 sc in each st (24).
Then 1 rnd of 1 sc in each st.

End with a sl st and break the yarn.

## CARPELS (3 PCS)

Work with 3 threads: Amigo XL - Egg Yolk (A37), Atlas Happy Feet - Blaze (13), and Glitter Deluxe Terracotta (17518)

Begin with 6 sc in a magic ring (6).
Rnd 1: 2 sc in each st (12).
Rnd 2: (1 sc, 2 sc in one st) 6 times (18).
Rnd 3: (2 sc, 2 sc in one st) 6 times (24).
Rnd 4: (2 sc, 2 sc in one st) 8 times (32).
Rnds 5-10: 1 sc in each st.
Rnd 11: (2 sc, sc2tog) 8 times (24).
End with a sl st and break the yarn.

## FLOWER PETALS

Atlas Happy Feet - Blaze (13)

## INNER PETALS (3 pcs)

Ch $24+1$, which is a turning chain (24).

Row 1: 1 sc in each st (24).
Row 2: Skip 2 sts, ( 5 dc in one st, skip 2 sts) 7 times, 5 dc in last st.
Rows 3-5: Begin in 3rd dc from previous row. Work (5 dc in one st, skip 4 sts) 8 times. Work 1 dc in last st.
Row 6: Work (5 dc in the space above the previous row, 5 dc in the middle dc of the dc shell from the previous row) 8 times. Work 1 st in last st.
Row 7: ( 10 dc in the middle dc of the dc shell from the previous row, 1 sc in the space between the dc shells from the previous row) 16 times. NOTE! Work last sc in last st.

## OUTER PETALS (3 pcs)

Ch $24+1$, which is a turning chain (24).

Row 1: 1 sc in each st (24).
Row 2: Skip 2 sts, ( 5 dc in one st, skip 2 sts) 7 times, 5 dc in last st.
Row 3: Begin in 3rd st from previous row. Work ( 5 sts in one st, skip 4 sts) 8 times. Work 1 st in last st.

Row 4: Work (5 dc in the space above the previous row, 5 dc in the middle dc of the dc shell from the previous row) 8 times. Work 1 dc in last st.
Row 5: (10 dc in the middle dc of the dc shell from the previous row, 1 sc in the space between the dc shells from the previous row) 16 times. NOTE! Work last sc in last st.

Fasten off and leave a long thread for assembling.

## ASSEMBLING

For assembling of CARPELS, use the same color as for the stem. Place the open end of the carpel over the open end of the stem and join the two pieces by working 1 sc in each st through both layers (24). Make sure that carpel and stem are stuffed completely with pillow stuffing before closing the last sts.

Before assembling of FLOWER PETALS, join the INNER and OUTER by working 24 sc along row 1. Then sew them to the 24 sts on the carpel and sew up along the sides to close them. In addition, sew a few stitches around in the bottom of the carpel to avoid that the petals drop down.

The metal wire is used for stiffening the stems. Pass the wire through the stitches from the bottom of the stem and up. It can be a bit tricky, but a good tip is to always make sure that the wire is as straight as possible. Don't cut the wire until you have passed it all the way through the stem and push the end in so that it is covered by the pillow stuffing. Do the same at the branches. Depending on how you want to arrange the flowers, it may be an idea to push an extra piece of wire into the long branching as well as the top of stem 1.
