# Chicky

## Sweater

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design



## MATERIALS

6 (6) 7 (8) skeins of Divina color Taupe (8)  
1 skein of Divina color Primrose (32)  
1 skein of Divina color Curry (31)

Scraps of yarn for embroidering chicken eyes, beaks and legs, or:

1 skein of Divina color Powder (10)  
1 skein of Divina color Light Petrol (27)  
1 skein of Divina color Sangria (15)

Knitting needles 5 mm (US 8)  
Knitting needles 6 mm (US 10)  
Circular needles 4 mm (US 7)  
Tapestry needle

## YARN QUALITY

 **Divina**, Hobbii

65% alpaca, 25% polyamide, 10% wool  
50 g (1.75 oz) = 150 m (164 yds)

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 19 sts x 27 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

st/sts = stitch/es

k = knit

p = Purl

inc = increase

CO = cast on

BO = bind off

## SIZE

S (M) L (XL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 46 (51) 56 (61) cm / 18 (20) 22 (24)"

Length: 46 (49) 56 (61) cm / 18 (19.2") 22 (24)"

Sleeve length: 44,5 (47) 47 (51) cm / 17.5 (18.5) 18.5 (20)"

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Super soft and adorable sweater, very comfortable and easy to make. The chicken motifs give it a cute look.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

Stitches used in the pattern:

- rib stitch- k2, p2,
- rib stitch- k1, p1,
- stockinette stitch- purl in odd rows, knit in even rows;

## BODY

### Back piece

With 5 mm (US 8) knitting needles and color Taupe CO 82 (92) 102 (112) sts.

Work 11 rows in rib stitch k2, p2.

In the 12<sup>th</sup> row increase 1 st every 8 (9) 10 (11) sts = 92 (102) 112 (122) sts.

Change to 6 mm (US 10) needles and work 14 rows in stockinette stitch. In the 15<sup>th</sup> row start the chicken motifs according to the diagram. Remember that you can swap the chicken colors as you want.

Continue knitting in stockinette stitch, on the 107<sup>th</sup> (121<sup>th</sup>) 135<sup>th</sup> (149<sup>th</sup>) row (in stockinette stitch), start the neckline.

Pass the middle 22 sts on the circular needles, and then, pass successively in every 2<sup>nd</sup> row on each side of the neckline: 3 sts, 2 sts and 1 st.

In the 115<sup>th</sup> (128<sup>th</sup>) 142<sup>th</sup> (156<sup>th</sup>) row, BO the remaining arms sts.

### Front piece

Work as back piece. Work the chicken motifs as on the back, swapping the chicken colors as desired.

Start the neckline in the 101<sup>st</sup> (115<sup>th</sup>) 129<sup>th</sup> (143<sup>rd</sup>) row.

In the 115<sup>th</sup> (128<sup>th</sup>) 142<sup>th</sup> (156<sup>th</sup>) row, BO the remaining arms sts.

Make sure that the number of stitches left for the arms and the number of rows finishing the front piece is the same as at the back.

## SLEEVES

With 5 mm (US 8) knitting needles CO 38 (44) 44 (44) sts.

Work 15 rows in rib stitch k2, p2.

In the 16<sup>th</sup> row inc 1 st every 6 sts = 44 (51) 51 (51) sts.

Change to 6 mm (US 10) needles and start to work in stockinette stitch.

In every 8<sup>th</sup> row, inc 1 st on both sides of the sleeve.

In the 18<sup>th</sup> row counting from the beginning of the stockinette stitch, insert the chicken motifs according to the diagram, remember, that you can use the colors alternately.

Continue to the 108<sup>th</sup> (112<sup>th</sup>) 112<sup>th</sup> (126<sup>th</sup>) row = 68 (75) 75 (77) sts.

BO all the sts.

## FINISHING

Sew parts of the sweater together with mattress stitch.

Work 16 rows of the sts on circular needles in rib stitch k1, p1, and BO. Fold in half and sew on the inside with back stitch.

Embroider the eyes, beaks and legs of the chicken with some leftover yarn.
