Chicky

Children's dress

MATERIALS

2 (3) 3 skeins of Divina color Light Petrol (27)
1 skein of Divina color Primrose (32)
1 skein of Divina color Curry (31)

Scraps of yarn for embroidering chicken eyes,
beaks and legs

Knitting needles 5 mm (US 8)
Crochet hook 3 mm (US D)
Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

 **Divina**, Hobbii
65% alpaca, 25% polyamide, 10% wool
50 g (1.75 oz)= 150 m (164 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 20 sts x 28 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

st/sts = stitch/es
k = knit
p = Purl
CO = cast on
BO = bind off
sc = single crochet

SIZE

104/4 yrs (110/5 yrs) 116/6 yrs

MEASUREMENTS

Width at the bottom: 42,5 (47,5) 47,5 cm / 16.7"
(18.7") 18.7"
Length: 44 (48) 48 cm / 17.5" (18.8") 18.8"
Length from an armpit: 12 (12) 14,5 / 4,7" (4,7")
5,7"

Super soft and adorable little dress, very
comfortable and easy to make. Can be worn
under a sweater or on a blouse.
The chicken motif gives it a cute look.

INFO AND TIPS

Stitches used in the pattern:

- stockinette stitch: purl in odd rows, knit in even rows;
- garter stitch: purl in every row.

BODY

Back piece

With 5 mm (US 8) knitting needles and color Light Petrol CO 85 (95) 95 sts.

Work 6 rows in garter stitch.

Now you will start to work in stockinette stitch and the rows will count from that point.

Rows 1-6: work in stockinette stitch.

Row 7: decrease 1 st on each side.

Rows 8-14: work in stockinette stitch.

Row 15: decrease 1 st on each side.

Repeat the sequence of 7 rows in stockinette stitch and 1 decrease row until you have a total of 70 rows = 69 (79) 79 sts.

Continue in stockinette stitch 14 (20) 20 more rows.

Now you will start to work in garter stitch and you will continue with it till the end of the dress.

Work 4 rows, then start the armhole, decreasing in every second row on both sides consecutively: 3 sts, 2 sts, 1 st, 1 st.

Continue knitting through 26 (26) 34 rows.

Next, BO 11 middle sts for the neckline, and then on both sides, in every second row BO:

4 yrs size: 4 sts, 3 sts, 2 sts, 1 st = 12 sts left on each arm

5, 6 yrs size: 5 sts, 4 sts, 3 sts, 2 sts, 1 st = 12 sts left on each arm.

In the 133rd (149th) 149th row, BO 12 sts on arms.

Front piece

Work as back piece until armholes, but in the 15th row of stockinette stitch start knitting the chicken motif according to the diagram. When you have finished the armholes, make 16 (16) 24 more rows. BO the sts for the neckline as in the back piece.

In the 133rd (149th) 149th row BO 12 sts on arms.

FINISHING

Sew parts of the dress together with mattress stitch.

Make one round of sc around the neckline.

Embroider the eyes, beaks and legs of the chickens with some leftover yarn.
