MATERIALS

2 skeins of Bungee Mini color Cream (04) 3 skeins of Bungee Mini color Rose (05) 1 skein of Bungee Mini color Red (17) Leftover yarn to embroider the eyes

Crochet hook 10 mm (US O/17), 9 mm (US J/9) Stitch markers Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

Bungee Mini, Hobbii 42% cotton, 58 % polyester 200 g / 7.1 oz. = 60 m / 66 yds

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 9 sts x 9 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

MR = Magic Ring st/s = stitch/es ch = chain sl st = slip stitch x sc = x stitch single crochet (amigurumi) tr = triple crochet inc = increase, 2 sts in the same st dec = decrease, 2 sts together

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 32 cm / 12.59" Length: 46 cm / 18.1" Hole height: 11 cm / 4.3"

INFO AND TIPS

The house is worked top to bottom, all around and in rows, with x sc- typical for amigurumi. To make the house stiff, work the sts very tightly. As you start to work in rounds, remember to place the stitch marker and replace it after

As you start to work in rounds, remember to place the stitch marker and replace each round.

HEAD AND BODY

```
With Cream yarn and a 10 mm crochet hook
Round 1 into a MR: 6 sc
Round 2: (place the stitch marker) inc around = 12 sts.
Round 3: (3 sc, inc) around =15 sts.
Round 4: (4 sc, inc) around = 18 sts.
Round 5: (5 \text{ sc}, \text{ inc}) \text{ around} = 21 \text{ sts}.
Round 6: (6 \text{ sc}, \text{ inc}) around = 24 sts.
Round 7: (7 \text{ sc, inc}) around = 27 sts.
Round 8: (8 \text{ sc, inc}) \text{ around} = 30 \text{ sts.}
Round 9: (9 sc, inc) around = 33 sts.
Round 10: (10 sc, inc) around = 36 sts.
Round 11: (11 sc, inc) around = 39 sts.
Round 12: (12 sc, inc) around = 42 sts.
Round 13: (13 sc, inc) around = 45 sts.
Round 14: (14 sc, inc) around = 48 sts.
Round 15: (15 sc, inc) around = 51 sts.
Round 16: (16 sc, inc) around = 54 sts.
Round 17: (17 sc, inc) around = 57 sts.
Round 18: (18 sc, inc) around = 60 sts.
Round 19: (19 sc, inc) around = 63 sts.
Round 20: (20 \text{ sc}, \text{ inc}) around = 66 sts.
Round 21: (21 sc, inc) around = 69 sts.
Round 22: (22 sc, inc) around, join with sl st to the first sc = 72 sts.
```

Attach the Rose yarn and continue without joining. Round 23-24: sc around. Now you will start to form a hole for the entrance. Round 25: ch 1, turn and start crocheting with sc (from the inside of the house) up to 15 sts before the end of the round, ch 1 and turn.

This is a good time to embroider, crest, beak and eyes.



BEAK

With Red yarn and a 9 mm crochet hook.

Once you see where the hole for the entrance is, insert the crochet hook in the middle, between rounds 11 and 12 counting from the top. Make 1 sl st, ch 2, and 1 tr. Close with sl st in same st (tr should fold in half). Secure the ends from the inside.

EYES

Embroider the eyes, or as I did, tie knots on between the 7th and 8th round, counting from the top, with 3 sts spacing between them, so that the beak is in the middle.

CREST

With Red yarn and a 10 mm crochet hook Insert the crochet hook into the MR at the very top. Ch 12, close with sl st in same st, repeat 2 more times. Secure the ends from the inside.

Rounds 26-32: sc till the end, ch 1, turn. Round 33: sc up to the opening, ch 15, join the round with sl st (it will be your first st of the round). Round 34: ch 1, sc around. Round 35- 39: sc around. Round 40: (10 sc, dec) around = 66 sts. Round 41: (9 sc, dec) around = 60 sts.Round 42: (8 sc, dec) around = 54 sts.Round 43: (7 sc, dec) around = 48 sts.Round 44: (6 sc, dec) around = 42 sts. Round 45: (5 sc, dec) around = 36 sts.Round 46: (4 sc, dec) around = 30 sts.Round 47: (3 sc, dec) around = 24 sts.Round 48: (2 sc, dec) around = 18 sts.Round 49: (1 sc, dec) around = 12 sts. Round 50: dec around = 6 sts. Fasten off.

To make the opening more firm, make 2 sl sts rounds, with a 9 mm crochet hook, around the hole. Fasten off. Secure all ends.
