# Peonie Flower

## MATERIALS

1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4 color 050  
1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4 color 044  
1 skein of Friends Cotton 8/4 color 116

Crochet hook 2,5 mm (US size C)  
Scissors  
Tapestry needle  
Stuffing  
Metal wire cable 0.08" x 197" (2 mm x 5 m),  
11.5" to 13.5" (30 to 35 cm)  
1 glue stick  
1 glue gun

## YARN QUALITY

 **Friends Cotton 8/4**, Hobbii  
100% Cotton / 1.75 oz (50 g) = 186 yds (160 m)

## ABBREVIATIONS

sc = single crochet  
st(s) = stitch(es)  
ch = chain  
sl st = slip stitch  
R = row  
inc = increase  
dec = decrease  
hdc = half double crochet  
dc = double crochet  
( ) = total stitches  
\* \* = repeats

## MEASUREMENTS

Diameter approx 3.5" (8,5 cm)

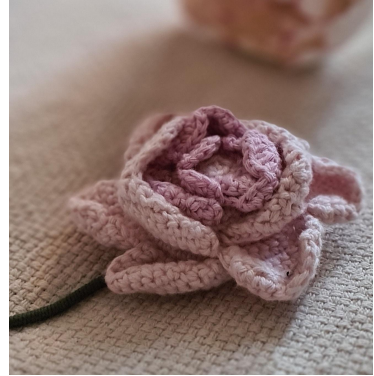

# Pattern



## HEART OF THE FLOWER

With Friends Cotton 8/4 yarn, color 050

- R 1 : 6 sc in a magic ring
- R 2: 6 inc (12 sts)
- R 3: \*1 sc, 1 inc\* 6 times (18 sts)
- R 4: \*2 sc, 1 inc\* 6 times (24 sts)
- R 5: \*3 sc, 1 inc\* 6 times (30 sts)
- R 6: \*4 sc, 1 inc\* 6 times (36 sts)
- R 7: \*5 sc, 1 inc\* 6 times (42 sts)
- R 8: 42 sc (42 sts)
- R 9: 42 sc in the back loops of the previous row (loops inside your work) (42 sts)
- R 10: \*1 sc, 1 dec\* 14 times (28 sts)
- R 11: 28 sc in the back loops of the previous row (28 sts)
- R 12: \*2 sc, 1 dec\* 7 times (21 sts)
- R 13: 21 sc in the back loops of the previous row (21 sts)
- R 14: 10 dec, 1 sc (11 sts)
- R 15: 11 sc in the back loops of the previous row (11 sts)

### STUFF

1 sl st, cut the yarn and close passing the thread through the front loops. Weave in ends.

## LINE 1: PETALS X 6

With Friends Cotton 8/4 yarn, color 050

**Work back and forth.**

**Hold your heart right side front of you.**

- R 1: 7 sc in the front loops of row 8 of the heart of the flower (loops outside your work) + ch 1 to turn
- R 2: 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc (9 sts) + ch 1 to turn
- R 3: 1 inc, 7 sc, 1 inc (11 sts) + ch 1 to turn
- R 4: 11 sc (11 sts) + ch 1 to turn
- R 5: 1 dec, 7 sc, 1 dec (9 sts) + ch 1 to turn
- R 6: 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec (7 sts) + ch 1 to turn
- R 7: 1 sc, 2 hdc, 1 dc, 1 hdc, 2 sc

At the end of row 7, continue to sc on the side of the petal until the first row of the petal, in order to continue the remaining 5 petals. Insert in the next front loop of row 8 of the heart of the flower to work your following petal.

**NOTE:** At the end of the last petal, do not cut the thread, and insert in the first front loop of row 10 of the heart of the flower.

## LINE 2: PETALS X 2

With Friends Cotton 8/4 yarn, color 050

**Work back and forth.**

R 1: 14 sc in the front loops of row 10 of the heart of the flower (14 sts) + ch 1 to turn  
R 2: \*1 sc, 1 inc\* 7 times (21 sts) + ch 1 to turn  
R 3-4: **2 rows** with 21 sc (21 sts) + ch 1 to turn  
R 5: \*1 sc, 1 dec\* 7 times (14 sts) + ch 1 to turn  
R 6: 5 sc, 2 dec, 5 sc (12 sts) + ch 1 to turn  
R 7: 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 inc dc, 1 hdc, 1 sc, 1 dec, 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 inc dc, 1 hdc, 1 sl st (13 sts)

At the end of row 7, continue to sc on the side of the petal until the first row of the petal, in order to continue the second petal. Insert in the next front loop of row 10 of the heart of the flower to make your following petal.

**NOTE:** At the end of the last petal, continue on the side of the petal with sc, then make 1 sl st, cut and weave in ends.

## LINE 3: PETALS X 3

With Friends Cotton 8/4 yarn, color 44

**Work back and forth.**

R 1: 7 sc in the front loops of row 12 of the heart of the flower (7 sts) + ch 1 to turn  
R 2: 1 inc, 5 sc, 1 inc (9 sts) + ch 1 to turn  
R 3: 9 sc (9 sts) + ch 1 to turn  
R 4: 1 dec, 5 sc, 1 dec (7 sts) + ch 1 to turn  
R 5: 1 sc, 1 hdc, 1 inc dc, 1 hdc, 1 sl st, 2 hdc

At the end of row 5, continue to sc on the side of the petal until the first row of the petal, in order to continue the two following petals. Insert in the next front loop of row 12 of the heart of the flower to make your following petal.

**NOTE:** At the end of the last petal, do not cut the thread, and insert in the first front loop of row 14 of the heart of the flower.

## LINE 4: PETALS X3

With Friends Cotton 8/4 yarn, color 044

**Work back and forth.**

R 1: 3 sc in front loops of row 14 of the heart of the flower (3 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 2: 1 inc, 1 sc, 1 inc (5 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 3: 1 dec, 1 dc, 1 dec

At the end of row 3, continue to sc on the side of the petal until the first row of the petal, in order to continue the two following petals. Insert in the next front loop of row 14 of the heart of the flower to make your following petal.

#### **LINE 4: 1 PETAL (2 sts remains)**

**With Friends Cotton 8/4 yarn, color 044**

R 1: 2 sc in the front loops of row 14 of the heart of the flower (3 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 2: 2 inc (4 sts) + ch 1 to turn

R 3: 1 dec, 1 dc, 1 sc

At the end of row 3, continue to sc on the side of the petal until the first row of the petal.  
1 sl st, cut and weave in ends.

#### **FINISHING**

For the stem: Cut approx 11.5" to 13.5" (30 to 35 cm) from a wire cable.

Take your glue stick and put it along the length of the cable.

Wrap the entire cable with **Friends Cotton 8/4 yarn Color 116**.

Using the glue gun, glue one end of the stem behind the heart of the flower.

Let it dry, and repeat for other flowers to get a beautiful eternal bouquet.
