Rainbow Cotton 8/4
1 (1) 2 skein(s) of White (001)
1 (1) 2 skein(s) of Curry (056)
1 (1) 2 skein(s) of Blue (031)
1 (1) 2 skein(s) of Malachite Green (099)
1 (1) 2 skein(s) of Petunia Pink (087)
1 (1) 2 skein(s) of Bordeaux (060)
Crochet hook 3 mm (US 3)

## YARN QUALITY

(10) Rainbow Cotton 8/4, Hobbii

100\% cotton,
$50 \mathrm{~g} / 1.75 \mathrm{oz} .=170 \mathrm{~m} / 186 \mathrm{yds}$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=27$ sts $\times 38$ rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

## ch = chain

sc = single crochet
dc = double crochet
V-st $=$ V-stitch
V-stitch: 2 dc with ch-1 between in the same stitch,
picot - crochet 3 chain stitches, insert your hook in the third chain from the hook, yarn over and draw yarn through the stitch and the loop on the hook

XS-S, (M), L-XL

Circumference: 84-93 cm, (94-110 cm), 111-120 cm / 33-36.5", (37-43"), 43.5-47" Length: $57 \mathrm{~cm} / 22.5^{\prime \prime}$

## INFO AND TIPS

Measure the fullest part of your chest and start crocheting according to your measurement.
XS-S (84-93 cm), M (94-110 cm), L-XL (111-120 cm)
The pattern is a multiple of $8+1$

## SIZE XS-S

Row 1 (Curry): foundation dc (17 dc)
Row 2 (Curry): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1 st dc, ch-1, skip next 3 dc , dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, skip next 3 dc , V-st in next dc, ch-1, skip next 3 dc , dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, skip next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the last dc

Connect Petunia Pink yarn to the last dc of the previous row
Row 3 (Petunia Pink): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, 2 dc in the last dc, cut the yarn

Row 4 (Petunia Pink): repeat Row 3, cut the yarn
Row 5 (Bordeaux): connect Bordeaux yarn to the last dc of the previous row and repeat Row 3
Row 6 (Bordeaux): repeat Row 3, cut the yarn
Row 7 (White): connect White yarn to the last dc of the previous row and repeat Row 3
Row 8 (White): repeat Row 3, cut the yarn
Row 9 (Malachite Green): connect Malachite Green yarn to the last dc of the previous row and repeat Row 3

Row 10 (Malachite Green): repeat Row 3, cut the yarn
Row 11 (Blue): connect Blue yarn to the last dc of the previous row and repeat Row 3
The 1st increase row (+ 8 sts). Right side row:

Row 12 (Blue): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in next 5 dc, 4 dc in next ch-2 space, dc in next ch-1 space, dc in each st of the V-st (in dc, ch-1, dc), dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-2 space, dc in next ch-1 space, dc in the last 2 dc , cut the yarn ( 25 dc )

Row 13 (Curry): connect Curry yarn to the last dc of the previous row, ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, (ch-1, skip next 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, skip next 3 dc, V-st in next dc) rep once, ch-1, skip next 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, 2 dc in the last dc

Row 14 (Curry): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, (ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, $V$-st in next V-st) rep once, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, 2 dc in the last dc, cut the yarn

Row 15 (Petunia Pink): connect Petunia Pink yarn to the last dc of the previous row and repeat Row 14

## The 2nd increase row (+ 8 sts). Right side row:

Row 16 (Petunia Pink): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in next 5 dc, 4 dc in next ch-2 space, (dc in next ch-1 space, dc in the middle of the V-st, skip next dc, dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-2 space) rep once, dc in next ch-1 space, dc in the last 2 dc , cut the yarn ( 33 dc )

Row 17 (Bordeaux): connect Bordeaux yarn to the last dc of the previous row, ch-3 (count as the 1 st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, (ch-1, skip next 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, skip next 3 dc, V-st in next dc) rep twice, ch-1, skip next 3 dc, dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, 2 dc in the last dc

Row 18 (Bordeaux): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, (ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, V-st in next V-st) rep twice, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, 2 dc in the last dc, cut the yarn

Row 19 (White): connect White yarn to the last dc of the previous row and repeat Row 18

## SIZE M

## The 3rd increase row (+ 8 sts). Right side row:

Row 20 (White): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in next 5 dc, 4 dc in next ch-2 space, dc in next ch-1 space, (dc in the middle of the V-st, skip next dc, dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-2 space) rep twice, $d c$ in next ch-1 space, $d c$ in the last 2 dc , cut the yarn ( 41 dc )

Row 21 (Malachite Green): connect Malachite Green yarn to the last dc of the previous row, ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, (ch-1, skip next 3 dc , dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, skip next 3 dc, V-st in next dc) rep three times, ch-1, skip next 3 dc , dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, 2 dc in the last dc

Row 22 (Malachite Green): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, (ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, V-st in next V-st) rep three times, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, 2 dc in the last dc, cut the yarn

Row 23 (Blue): connect Blue yarn to the last dc of the previous row and repeat Row 22

## SIZE L-XL

## The 4th increase row (+ 8 sts). Right side row:

Row 24 (Blue): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in next $5 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-2 space, (dc in the middle of the $V$-st, skip next dc, dc in next $4 \mathrm{dc}, 4 \mathrm{dc}$ in next ch-2 space) rep three times, dc in next ch-1 space, dc in the last 2 dc , cut the yarn (49 dc)

Row 25 (Curry): connect Curry yarn to the last dc of the previous row, ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, (ch-1, skip next 3 dc , dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, skip next 3 dc , V-st in next dc) rep four times, ch-1, skip next 3 dc , dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, 2 dc in the last dc

Row 26 (Curry): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, (ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, $V$-st in next $V$-st) rep four times, ch- 1 , dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, 2 dc in the last dc , cut the yarn

Row 27 (Petunia Pink): connect Petunia Pink yarn to the last dc of the previous row and repeat Row 26

## ALL SIZES

Connect Curry yarn to the 1st dc of the 1st Row (it's a shoulder line)
Row 1 (Curry): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, ch-1, skip next 3 dc , dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, skip next 3 dc , V-st in next dc, ch-1, skip next 3 dc , dc in next dc, ch-2, 4 dc in same dc, skip next $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in the last dc

Row 2 (Curry): ch-3 (count as the 1st dc), turn, dc in the 1st dc, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, 2 dc in the last dc, cut the yarn

Connect Petunia Pink yarn and repeat Rows 3-19 (XS-S), 3-23 (M), 3-27(L-XL). You'll get the back part of the top. Crochet the second detail in the same way. After that, fold two details on the shoulder line and start crocheting a row of the pattern around two parts.

## BODY PART

NOTE: start working in turning rounds and don't forget changing the color of the yarn every two rows

We are going to make a side seam, so you should connect the yarn (White yarn (XS-S), Blue yarn (M) or Petunia Pink yarn (L-XL) to the armhole through the last 2 stitches to join the front and the back parts together

Right side row
Round 1: ch-4, dc in the same place (count as the 1 st $V$-st), ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, * V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space **, rep from * to ** until you reach the middle point of the top,
work V -st through the last dc of the 1st part of the top and the 1 st dc of the 2 nd part of the top, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, then repeat from * to ** to the 2nd armhole,
work V -st through the last dc and the 1st dc of the front and the back parts of the 2 nd part of the top, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, then rep from * to ** until you reach the middle point of the top,
work V -st through the last dc of the 2nd part of the top and the 1 st dc of the 1 st part of the top, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, then repeat from * to ** to the 1st armhole, join with sl st to top of ch-3, cut the yarn

Round 2: change the color of the yarn. Connect the yarn to the armhole seam (to the 1st V-st) from the wrong side, ch-4, dc in the same place (count as the 1st V-st), ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, * V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 3: sl st in ch-1 space, ch-4, turn, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, * V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, dc in the 1st ch-1 space, ch-1, join with sl st to top of ch-3, cut the yarn

Repeat Rounds 2-3 until you reach the desired length (I crocheted 15 colorful lines). After that repeat Round 2 with White color and start crocheting the last round:

Last round: sl st in ch-1 space, ch-1, turn, sc in same space, ch-2, dc in next ch-2 space, picot, (dc in same space, picot) repeat three times, dc in same space, * ch-2, sc in next V-st, ch-2, dc in next ch-2 space, picot, (dc in same space, picot) repeat three times, dc in same space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, ch-2, join with sl st to the 1st sc.

## NECKLINE

Round 1: connect Malachite Green yarn to any place, ch-1, sc in same space, crochet a row af sc around the neckline, join with sl st to the 1st sc

Round 2: ch-1, sc in the 1st sc, ch-1, * sc in next sc, ch-1 ** rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to the 1st sc

## SLEEVES

Start working in turning rounds. The number of stitches is a multiple of 8 (XS-S ( 80 sc ), M (88), L, XL (104). Don't forget changing the color of yarn every two rows.

Round 1: connect Curry yarn to the armhole and crochet a row of sc around, join with sl st to the 1st sc

Round 2: ch-4, turn, dc in same space (count as the 1st V-st), * ch-1, skip next 3 sc , dc in next sc, ch-2, 3 dc in same space, skip next $3 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{V}$-st in next sc ** rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 3: sl st in next ch-1 space, ch-4, turn, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, * V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, $d c$ in the 1 st ch-1 space, ch-1, join with sl st to top of ch-3, cut the yarn

Round 4: change the color of the yarn (Petunia Pink). Connect the yarn to the 1st V-st from the wrong side, ch-4, dc in the same place (count as the 1st V-st), ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, * V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 5: sl st in next ch-1 space, ch-4, turn, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, * V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, dc in the 1st ch-1 space, ch-1, join with sl st to top of ch-3, cut the yarn

Round 6: change the color of the yarn (Bordeaux). Connect the yarn to the 1st V-st from the wrong side, ch-4, dc in the same place (count as the 1 st V-st), ch-1, dc in next ch- 2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, * V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 7: sl st in next ch-1 space, ch-4, turn, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, * V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, $d$ in the 1 st ch-1 space, ch-1, join with sl st to top of ch-3, cut the yarn

Round 8: change the color of the yarn (White). Connect the yarn to the 1st V-st from the wrong side, ch-4, dc in the same place (count as the 1st V-st), ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space, * V-st in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, ch-2, 4 dc in same space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, join with sl st to top of ch-3

Round 9: sl st in ch-1 space, ch-1, turn, sc in same space, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, picot, (dc in same space, picot) repeat three times, dc in same space, * ch-1, sc in next V-st, ch-1, dc in next ch-2 space, picot, (dc in same space, picot) repeat three times, dc in same space **, rep from * to ** to the end of the round, ch-1, join with sl st to the 1st sc, cut the thread.
