MATERIALS


6 skeins of Rainbow Cotton 8/8 color 013
1 skein of Diablo Multi color 018


For embroidery:

1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 063
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 055
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 098
1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 040

Crochet hook 5 mm (US H/8)
Crochet hook 3.5 mm (US E/4)
Snap Fasteners, 11 mm (0.43 inches)
Tapestry needle
Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii
100% cotton
50 g (1.8 oz) = 75 m (82 yds)

 **Diablo Multi**, Hobbii
40% acrylic, 30% mohair, 30% polyamide
50 g (1.75 oz) = 90 m (98 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 13 sts x 10 rows
(with double yarn)

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain
sc = single crochet
hdc = half double crochet
sl st = slip stitch

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: 25 cm / 9.8"
Width: 32 cm / 12.5"

INFO AND TIPS

The backpack is worked with double thread in rounds without joining.

To make a bobble: insert the crochet hook into the st and ch 3. Start working a dc in the first ch but do not finish it, so that you have 2 loops left on the crochet hook. Repeat 5 more times in the same st, yarn over and pull through all 7 loops. Ch 1 and finish with 1 sl st where you started the bobble. Cut the thread and secure the ends from the inside.

BAG

Round 1: ch 35, 4 hdc into the 2nd st from the hook, hdc up to the last st, 5 hdc into the last st, rotate and start working on the other side of the chain, hdc up to the first st, 1 hdc into the last st, sl st to the first st.

Round 2: ch 2, 1 hdc, 5 hdc in the middle st of the 5 hdc sts of the previous round, hdc up to the middle st of the 5 hdc sts of the previous round, 5 hdc in the middle st, hdc to the end of the round, do not join.

Round 3: 1 hdc in ch 2, place st marker, hdc around.

Round 4-23: hdc around, remember to replace the st marker after every round.

Close with sl st, fasten off.

FLAP

Attach Diablo Multi yarn to the st on the edge on the side from outside of the bag, and ch 1.

Row 1: hdc into the back loop only, ch 1 and turn.

Row 2: sc in the back loop only, ch 1, turn.

Row 3: sc in the front loop only, ch 1, turn.

Row 4: 2 sc in the back loop of the 2nd st from the hook, sc to the last st, 2 sc in the last st, ch 1, turn.

Row 5: repeat row 3.

Row 6: repeat row 4.

Row 7: repeat row 3.

Row 8: repeat row 2.

Row 9: repeat row 3.

Row 10-21: repeat alternating the row of sc in the back loop and the row of sc in the front loop.

Cut the yarn and fasten off.

Rejoin the yarn at the top edge of the flap and make 2 sl st rows along the whole edge, working 1 sl st, ch 1, 1 sl st in the corner st.

STRAPS

NOTE: The straps are sewn on and cannot be adjusted, so it is recommended to crochet exactly the desired length.

Ch 1 counts as 1 sc.

Using st markers, separate 6 middle sts on the top of the back.

Work 6 sc around the middle sts of the last row of the bag, ch 1, turn.

Start working on the first strip into the back loop of these 6 sts, 5 sc, ch 1 and turn.

Repeat: 5 sc, ch 1 and turn in every row until you reach the desired strap length (the model has 50 rows).

Sew the folded strap to the bottom corner of the backpack.

Start working on the second strap into the front loop of the 6 sts, 5 sc, ch 1 and turn.

Follow the instructions for the first strap.

Sew one button in the opening of the bag and two others on the sides of the flap.

Embroidery

Window

Use a 3.5 mm crochet hook and Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 063. The window has 10 ch sts.

Grass

Use a 3.5 mm crochet hook and Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 098.

Flowers

Use a 3.5 mm crochet hook and Rainbow Cotton 8/4 color 040 and color 055. Make some bobbles according to the instructions on page 1.

Weave in all the ends.
