# **Cat Scarf**

#### **MATERIALS**

3 skeins of Baby Snuggle Solid, 10 Koala 1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8, 001 White 1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8, 04 Pink 1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8, 043 Baby Pink 1 skein of Rainbow Cotton 8/8, 009 Black

White sewing thread Black embroidery floss

Crochet hooks 6.0, 5.5 and 3.5 mm

#### **YARN QUALITY**

**Rainbow Cotton 8/8**, Hobbii 100% Cotton/ 50 g = 75 meter

**Baby Snuggle Solid**, Hobbii 100% Polyester/ 100 g = 120 meter

#### **GAUGE**

9 double crochet and 5 rounds = 10 cm in Baby Snuggle with 6.0 mm hook

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch: chain sc: single crochet

1 inc: single crochet 2 stitches in the same

stitch

1 dec: single crochet 2 stitches together

sl: slip stitch dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet t-ch: turning chain

#### SIZE

One size

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

The length of the scarf is approximately 145 cm, if you want a longer scarf you will need one more skein of Baby Snuggle Solid.

#### PATTERN INFORMATION

Now you can crochet this cute Cat Scarf! It is guaranteed to keep you warm and looking nice at the same time.

### **Pattern**







#### HOOD

Using Baby Snuggle Solid in Koala and a 5.5 mm hook Chain 19.

**Rnd 1:** 1 dc in the third ch from the hook, 15 dc, 3 dc in the same st. Turn around the corner without turning the piece over, 15 dc. 2 dc in the last st. Turn.

**Rnd 2:** ch 2, skip the first st, 15 dc. [1 inc] x5, 15 dc. 1 dc in the t-ch. Turn

**Rnd 3:** ch 2, skip the first st, 15 dc [1 inc] x10, 15 dc. 1 dc in the t-ch. Turn

**Rnd 4:** ch 2, skip the first st, 1 dc in each st. 1 dc in the t-ch. Turn.

**Rnd 5:** ch 2, skip the first st, 17 dc [1 inc, 1 dc] x8, 17 dc. 1 dc in the t-ch. Turn

**Rnd 6:** ch 2, skip the first st, 1 dc in each st. 1 dc in the t-ch. Turn.

**Rnd 7:** ch 2, skip the first st, 18 dc [1 inc, 2 dc] x8, 16 dc. 1 dc in the t-ch. Turn

Rnd 8-16: ch 2, skip the first st, 1 dc in each st. 1 dc in the t-ch. Turn (9 rounds)

Cut yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

#### **SCARF**

Using Baby Snuggle Solid in Koala and a 6.0 mm hook Chain 20.

**Rnd 1:** 1 dc in the third st from the hook. 1 dc in each st. Turn

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (counts as 1 dc) skip the first st. 1 dc in each st. Turn

Repeat round 2 until the scarf measures 145 cm.

If you want a longer scarf just make a few more rounds. But note that if so you may need one more skein of Baby Snuggle Solid.

Do not cut the yarn.

#### Attaching the hood

Measure out the middle of the scarf and place the hood along one of the wide sides of the scarf. Make sure that the hood is in the middle of it.

Sew on the hood.

Single crochet using a 6.0 mm hook all around the scarf and the hood. In each corner make 3 sc. Fasten all threads.

#### **POCKET** (make 2)

Using Baby Snuggle Solid in Koala and a 6.0 mm hook Chain 15

**Rnd 1:** 1 dc in the third ch from the hook. 1 dc in each st. Turn

Rnd 2-6: Ch 2 (counts as 1 dc) skip the first st. 1 dc in each st. Turn

Single crochet around 3 of the sides. In each corner make 3 sc.

Fasten all threads

Sew on the pockets using sewing thread.



#### EAR (make 2)

Using Baby Snuggle Solid in Koala and a 5.5 hook

Start with a magic ring

**Rnd 1:** 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

**Rnd 2:** 6 sc (6)

**Rnd 3:** [1 inc] x6 (12)

**Rnd 4:** 12 sc (12)

**Rnd 5:** [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18) **Rnd 6-9:** 18 sc (4 rounds, 18)

**Rnd 10:** [1 dec] x6 (12)

Cut yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

#### **EYEWHITES** (make 2)

Using Rainbow 8/8 in White and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring

**Rnd 1:** 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

**Rnd 2:** [1 inc] x6 (12)

**Rnd 3:** [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

**Rnd 4:** 1 sc, 1 inc [2 sc, 1 inc] x5, 1 sc (24)

**Rnd 5:** [3 sc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

Fasten all threads.

Embroider eyelashes using black embroidery floss.

#### **CHEEKS** (make 2)

Using Rainbow 8/8 in Pink and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring

**Rnd 1:** 6 sc in the magic ring (6)

**Rnd 2:** [1 inc] x6 (12)

**Rnd 3:** [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Fasten all threads.

#### **NOSE**

Using Rainbow 8/8 in Baby Pink and a 3.5 mm hook

Start with a magic ring, don't pull it together.

Make 9 dc into the magic ring, join with 1 sl to the first dc. Pull the ring together a little bit.

In the 2nd dc – do 3 dc

In the 3rd dc – do 1 dc, 1 hdc

In the 4th dc – do 2 sc

In the 5th dc – do 1 hdc, 1 dc

In the 6th dc – do 1 dc, 1 hdc

In the 7th dc - do 2 sc

In the 8th dc – do 1 hdc, 1 dc

In the 9th dc – do 3 dc

Finish off with 1 sl

Fasten off but leave a 20 cm long yarn tail for sewing.

Pull the ring together tightly.



#### **ASSEMBLING**

Pin the ears to the hood and sew them on.
Pin the eyes, nose and cheeks on to the hood and sew them on.
Embroider whiskers using Rainbow Cotton 8/8 in Black.
Cut pieces of yarn in Baby Pink and use them as fringes. See pictures further down in the pattern.


