Tweed Delight  
2/2/3/3/3/4/4 skeins of color 13  
1/1/1/1/1/2/2 skein(s) of color 15  
1 skein of color 10  
1 skein of color 18  
1 skein of color 02

Crochet hook 5 mm (US H/8)  
Tapestry needle  
Tape measure  
Scissors  
2 stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

 **Tweed Delight**, Hobbii  
85% Wool, 10% Acrylic, 5% Viscose  
50g = 100m

## GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 13 sts x 8 rows

st = stitch

## INFO AND TIPS

This pattern is split into sections for the main body, based on the size you are making, so make sure you follow the right instructions. If you are printing this you won't need to print every page!

When changing colour for the beginning of the sunset, I like to float my yarns along the back to save weaving in extra ends. A good way to do this is to cut a long length for each colour you need in that row, and as you change colour leave that long length so that next time you need it in the row above, you can pick that same yarn back up.

The colours are named like this throughout the pattern.

- (13) Geranium = G
- (15) Dusty Rose = R
- (18) Amber Glow = A
- (10) Dijon = D
- (02) Ivory Glow = I

## Body Panel (Find the section with the size you are making)

### 0-6 months

Ribbing: With yarn I and a 5mm hook chain 36. Dc in the 3rd ch from the hook and back to the start (34). Turn, ch2, fpdc in the first st and bpdc in the second. Do this alternating fp and bp stitches until you reach the end. Ch2, turn, and sc in each st until the end making sure you have (34). Turn.

Row 1: Swap to yarn A and ch2. We will now be creating the sun:  
Your ch2 will never count as a st. Dc in the first st and the second st, then change to your yarn D (I like to change colour as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 30 dc in the next 30 sts, then swap back to yarn A for the final 2 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 34. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 2A sts, 30D sts and 2A sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below changing colour where necessary.

All sts are dc

Row 3: 2A 30D 2A ch2 turn  
Row 4: 4A 26D 4A ch2 turn  
Row 5: 4A 26D 4A ch2 turn  
Row 6: 6A 22D 6A ,swap to R, ch2, turn

Row 7: 6R 22D 6R ch2 turn  
Row 8: 10R 14D 10R ch2 turn  
Row 9: 34R ch2 turn  
Row 10: 34R ch2 turn  
Row 11: 34R ch2 turn  
Row 12: 34R swap to G, ch2 turn

Row 13: 34G ch2 turn  
Row 14: 34G ch2 turn  
Row 15: 34G ch2 turn  
Row 16: 34G ch2 turn  
Row 17: 34G ch2 turn  
Row 18: 34G ch2 turn do not fo yet

For your front panel follow 'front shoulder' instructions below. For your back panel make another identical body panel but once you have completed row 18 repeat it 2 more times in G so you have another 2 rows of dc, then FO.

Front shoulders: Row 1: 7dc, 20 sc, 7dc, ch2 turn  
Row 2: 7dc, 20 sc,7dc then fo

Move on to 'Join together all Sizes'

## **6-12 months**

Ribbing: With your yarn I and a 5mm hook chain 39. Dc in the 3rd ch from the hook and back to the start (37). Turn, ch2, fpdc in the first st and bpdc in the second. Do this alternating fp and bp stitches until you reach the end. Ch2, turn, and sc in each st until the end making sure you have (37). Turn.

Row 1: Swap to yarn A and ch2. We will now be creating the sun.

Your ch2 will never count as a st. Dc in the first 3sts, then change to yarn D (I like to change colour as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 31 dc in the next 31 sts, then swap back to A for the final 3 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 37. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 3A sts, 31D sts and 3A sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below changing colour where necessary.

All sts are dc

Row 3: 3A 31D 3A ch2 turn  
Row 4: 5A 27D 5A ch2 turn  
Row 5: 5A 27D 5A ch2 turn  
Row 6: 7A 23D 7A , swap to R, ch2, turn

Row 7: 7R 23D 7R ch2 turn  
Row 8: 11R 15D 11R ch2 turn  
Row 9: 37R ch2 turn



Row 10: 37R ch2 turn  
Row 11: 37R ch2 turn  
Row 12: 37R ch2 turn  
Row 13: 37R swap to G, ch2 turn

Row 14: 37G ch2 turn  
Row 15: 37G ch2 turn  
Row 16: 37G ch2 turn

Row 19: 37G ch2 turn do not fo yet

For your front panel follow 'front shoulder' instructions below. For your back panel make another identical body panel but once you have completed row 19 repeat it 2 more times in G so you have another 2 rows of dc, then FO.

Front shoulders: Row 1: 8dc, 21 sc, 8dc, ch2 turn  
Row 2: 8dc, 21 sc, 8dc then fo

Move on to 'Join together all Sizes'

## **1-2 years**

Ribbing: With yarn I and a 5mm hook chain 41. Dc in the 3rd ch from the hook and back to the start (39). Turn, ch2, fpdc in the first st and bpdc in the second. Do this alternating fp and bp stitches until you reach the end. Ch2, turn, and sc in each st until the end making sure you have (39). Turn.

Row 1: Swap to yarn A and ch2. We will now be creating the sun.

Your ch2 will never count as a st. Dc in the first 4sts, then change to yarn D (I like to change colour as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 31 dc in the next 31 sts, then swap back to A for the final 4 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 39. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 4A sts, 31D sts and 4A sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below changing colour where necessary.

All sts are dc

Row 3: 4A 31D 4A ch2 turn  
Row 4: 4A 31D 4A ch2 turn  
Row 5: 6A 27D 6A ch2 turn  
Row 6: 6A 27D 6A ch2 turn  
Row 7: 8A 23D 8A ,swap to R, ch2, turn

Row 8: 8R 23D 8R ch2 turn  
Row 9: 12R 15D 12R ch2 turn  
Row 10: 39R ch2 turn  
Row 11: 39R ch2 turn  
Row 12: 39R ch2 turn  
Row 13: 39R ch2 turn  
Row 14: 39R swap to G, ch2 turn

Row 15: 39G ch2 turn

Row 16: 39G ch2 turn  
Row 17: 39G ch2 turn  
Row 18: 39G ch2 turn  
Row 19: 39G ch2 turn  
Row 20: 39G ch2 turn do not fo yet

For your front panel follow 'front shoulder' instructions below. For your back panel make another identical body panel but once you have completed row 20 repeat it 2 more times in G so you have another 2 rows of dc, then FO.

Front shoulders: Row 1: 8dc, 23 sc, 8dc, ch2 turn  
Row 2: 8dc, 23 sc, 8dc then fo

Move on to 'Join together all Sizes'

### **3-4 years**

Ribbing: With yarn I and a 5mm hook chain 44. Dc in the 3rd ch from the hook and back to the start (42). Turn, ch2, fpdc in the first st and bpdc in the second. Do this alternating fp and bp stitches until you reach the end. Ch2, turn, and sc in each st until the end making sure you have (42). Turn.

Row 1: Swap to yarn A and ch2. We will now be creating the sun so there will be a lot of colour changing.

Your ch2 will never count as a st. Dc in the first 3sts, then change to yarn D (I like to change colour as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 36 dc in the next 36 sts, then swap back to A for the final 3 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 42. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 3A sts, 36D sts and 3A sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below changing colour where necessary.

All sts are dc

Row 3: 3A 36D 3A ch2 turn  
Row 4: 3A 36D 3A ch2 turn  
Row 5: 5A 32D 5A ch2 turn  
Row 6: 5A 32D 5A ch2 turn  
Row 7: 5A 32D 5A ch2 turn  
Row 8: 8A 26D 8A ch2 turn swap to R, ch2, turn

Row 9: 11R 20D 11R ch2 turn  
Row 10: 14R 14D 14R ch2 turn  
Row 11: 42R ch2 turn  
Row 12: 42R ch2 turn  
Row 13: 42R ch2 turn  
Row 14: 42R ch2 turn  
Row 15: 42R ch2 turn  
Row 16: 42R swap to G, ch2 turn

Row 17: 42G ch2 turn  
Row 18: 42G ch2 turn  
Row 19: 42G ch2 turn  
Row 20: 42G ch2 turn



Row 21: 42G ch2 turn  
Row 22: 42G ch2 turn

For your front panel follow 'front shoulder' instructions below. For your back panel make another identical body panel but once you have completed row 23 repeat it 2 more times in G so you have another 2 rows of dc, then FO.

Front shoulders: Row 1: 9dc, 24 sc, 9dc, ch2 turn  
Row 2: 9dc, 24 sc, 9dc then fo

Move on to 'Join together all Sizes'

### **5-6 years**

Ribbing: With yarn I and a 5mm hook chain 48. Dc in the 3rd ch from the hook and back to the start (46). Turn, ch2, fpdc in the first st and bpdc in the second. Do this alternating fp and bp stitches until you reach the end. Ch2, turn, and sc in each st until the end making sure you have (46). Turn.

Row 1: Swap to yarn A and ch2. We will now be creating the sun so there will be a lot of colour changing.

Your ch2 will never count as a st. Dc in the first 3sts, then change to yarn D (I like to change colour as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 40 dc in the next 40 sts, then swap back to A for the final 3 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 46. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 3A sts, 40D sts and 3A sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below changing colour where necessary.

All sts are dc

Row 3: 3A 40D 3A ch2 turn  
Row 4: 3A 40D 3A ch2 turn  
Row 5: 5A 36D 5A ch2 turn  
Row 6: 5A 36D 5A ch2 turn  
Row 7: 5A 36D 5A ch2 turn  
Row 8: 9A 28D 9A ch2 turn swap to R, ch2, turn

Row 9: 12R 22D 12R  
Row 10: 15R 16D 15R ch2 turn  
Row 11: 46R ch2 turn  
Row 12: 46R ch2 turn  
Row 13: 46R ch2 turn  
Row 14: 46R ch2 turn  
Row 15: 46R ch2 turn

Front shoulders: Row 1: 11dc, 24 sc, 11dc, ch2 turn  
Row 2: 11dc, 24 sc, 11dc then fo

Move on to 'Join together all Sizes'

### **7-8 years**

Ribbing: With yarn I and a 5mm hook chain 53. Dc in the 3rd ch from the hook and back to the start (51). Turn, ch2, fpdc in the first st and bpdc in the second. Do this alternating fp and bp stitches until you reach the end. Ch2, turn, and sc in each st until the end making sure you have (51). Turn.

Row 1: Swap to yarn A and ch2. We will now be creating the sun so there will be a lot of colour changing.

Your ch2 will never count as a st. Dc in the first 3sts, then change to yarn D (I like to change colour as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 45 dc in the next 45 sts, then swap back to A for the final 3 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 51. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 3A sts, 45D sts and 3A sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions below changing colour where necessary.

All sts are dc

Row 3: 3A 45D 3A ch2 turn  
Row 4: 3A 45D 3A ch2 turn  
Row 5: 7A 37D 7A ch2 turn  
Row 6: 7A 37D 7A ch2 turn  
Row 7: 7A 37D 7A ch2 turn  
Row 8: 10A 31D 10A ch2 turn  
Row 9: 10A 31D 10A ch2 turn swap to R, ch2, turn

Row 10: 14R 23D 14R ch2 turn  
Row 11: 17R 17D 17R ch2 turn  
Row 12: 51R ch2 turn  
Row 13: 51R ch2 turn  
Row 14: 51R ch2 turn  
Row 15: 51R ch2 turn  
Row 16: 51R ch2 turn  
Row 17: 51R ch2 turn  
Row 18: 51R swap to G, ch2 turn

Row 19: 51G ch2 turn

For your front panel follow 'front shoulder' instructions below. For your back panel make another identical body panel but once you have completed row 27 repeat it 2 more times in G so you have another 2 rows of dc, then FO.

Front shoulders: Row 1: 13dc, 25 sc, 13dc, ch2 turn  
Row 2: 13dc, 25sc, 13dc then fo

Move on to 'Join together all Sizes'

### **9-10 years**

Ribbing: With yarn I and a 5mm hook chain 55. Dc in the 3rd ch from the hook and back to the start (53). Turn, ch2, fpdc in the first st and bpdc in the second. Do this alternating fp and bp stitches until you reach the end. Ch2, turn, and sc in each st until the end making sure you have (53). Turn.

Row 1: Swap to yarn A and ch2. We will now be creating the sun so there will be a lot of colour changing.

Your ch2 will never count as a st. Dc in the first 3sts, then change to yarn D (I like to change colour as I'm making the final part of the dc and pulling the last loop through). Make 47 dc in the next 47 sts, then swap back to A for the final 3 sts. For this row and every row your st count will be 53. Turn and ch2.

Row 2: Repeat row 1 with 3A sts, 47D sts and 3A sts before turning and ch2 again. From here you will follow the instructions changing colour where necessary.

All sts are dc

Row 3: 3A 47D 3A ch2 turn  
Row 4: 3A 47D 3A ch2 turn  
Row 5: 3A 47D 3A ch2 turn  
Row 6: 7A 39D 7A ch2 turn  
Row 7: 7A 39D 7A ch2 turn  
Row 8: 7A 39D 7A ch2 turn  
Row 9: 10A 33D 10A ch2 turn  
Row 10: 10A 33D 10A ch2 turn swap to R, ch2, turn

Row 11: 14R 25D 14R ch2 turn  
Row 12: 18R 17D 18R ch2 turn  
Row 13: 53R ch2 turn  
Row 14: 53R ch2 turn  
Row 15: 53R ch2 turn  
Row 16: 53R ch2 turn  
Row 17: 53R ch2 turn  
Row 18: 53R ch2 turn  
Row 19: 53R ch2 turn  
Row 20: 53R swap to G, ch2 turn

Row 21: 53G ch2 turn  
 Row 22: 53G ch2 turn  
 Row 23: 53G ch2 turn  
 Row 24: 53G ch2 turn  
 Row 25: 53G ch2 turn  
 Row 26: 53G ch2 turn  
 Row 27: 53G ch2 turn

For your front panel follow 'front shoulder' instructions below. For your back panel make another identical body panel but once you have completed row 29 repeat it 2 more times in G so you have another 2 rows of dc, then FO.

Front shoulders: Row 1: 14dc, 25 sc 14dc, ch2 turn  
 Row 2: 14dc, 25 sc 14dc, then fo

Move on to 'Join together all Sizes'

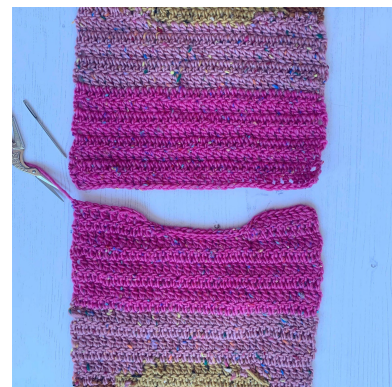
### Join Together (All Sizes)

Place your front and back panels with the shoulders touching (and wrong side facing up for both). Use yarn G to stitch them together across the dc from your front panel (so 7/8/8/9/11/13/14) on each shoulder, then fo and weave in your ends.

### Neckband

If your headhole looks a little small you can add 2 increases on each side while doing the neckband. If the headhole looks a little big you can do 2 decreases on each side instead!

Join your yarn I in any dc along the back of the neck and ch2. Dc in the next st and each st around, then sl st into the top of your ch2.



### Sleeves all Sizes

These are worked flat and then sewn on.

Take your yarn I (leave a long tail before your starting slip knot, you will use this later to sew the cuff up) and ch 18/20/22/24/26/28/30

then in the 3rd ch from the hook dc, and in each st along to the end.

Row 1: ch2 turn and fpdc/bpdc alternating along to the end. ch2, turn (16/18/20/22/24/26/28)

Row 2: Sc in each st, at the end swap to geranium then ch2 and turn (16/18/20/22/24/26/28)

Row 3: 2dc in the first st, 2dc in the second st, dc in each st until the last 2 sts, 2dc in the next st and then 2dc in the last st (20/22/24/26/28/30/32) ch2 turn

Row 4: 2dc in first st, dc in each st until the last, 2dc in last st, ch2 and turn (22/24/26/28/30/32/34)

Row 5: 2dc in first st, dc in each st until the last, 2dc in last st, ch2 and turn (24/26/28/30/32/34/36)

Row 6: 2dc in first st, dc in each st until the last, 2dc in last st, ch2 and turn (26/28/30/32/34/36/38)

Row 7: Dc in each st until the end, ch2 and turn (26/28/30/32/34/36/38)

Row 8: Repeat row 7 until your total sleeve length including the ribbing is 18/20/22/26/30/32/36cm then fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing.

### **Join Sleeves**

Turn your sweater inside out and use the long tail to sew the sleeve on. Tip - fold the sleeve in half and use stitch markers to mark where the top and bottom of the join should go to keep it even. Once you have sewn the sleeve on to the arm hole you will need to sew down the length of the sleeve, once you reach the cuff use the Ivory tail to sew this part up,, and fasten off.

Next sew from the armpit down to the waistband to close the side of the sweater (and you will need to sew the waistbands together too).

Weave in your ends, turn the right way around and you're all done!
