



KNITTING PATTERN

Viola

Blouse

MATERIALS

2 (3) 3 skeins of Evergreen, Hunter Green (25)
2 (3) 3 skeins of Kid silk, Dark Citrus (64)

Knitting needle size 6 (4 mm)

YARN QUALITY

 **Evergreen Organic Wool**, Hobbii
100% Wool/ 50 g (1.75 oz) = 230 meter (252 yds)

 **Super Kid Silk**, Mayflower
76% Mohair, 24% Silk
25 g (0,9 oz) = 195 m (213 yards)

GAUGE

18 stitches on 4" (10 cm)
30 rows on 4" (10 cm)

ABBREVIATIONS

s: stitch
p: purl

SIZES

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width 17.3 (18.9) 20.5 inches (44 (48) 52 cm)

Length 19.7 (20.9) 22 inches (50 (53) 56 cm)

ABOUT THE PATTERN

The sweater is knitted down up.

The sleeves are knitted and then sewn onto the arm hole of the blouse. Please see picture at the end of the pattern.

INFO AND TIPS

- 1. row**, Evergreen: knit
 - 2. row**, Evergreen: purl.
 - 3. row**, Super Kid Silk: knit.
 - 4. row**, Super Kid Silk: knit.
- Repeat these four rows.

Back

Cast on 80 (86) 92 stitches in Evergreen and knit with needle size 6 (4 mm).
Continue the pattern (described above) until each side measures 12.6 (13.4) 14.2 inches (32 (34) 36 cm).

Arm hole

cast off 6 (7) 8 stitches on each side = 68 (72) 76 stitches.
Knit straight up till your work measures 19 (20) 21.2 inches (48 (51) 54 cm). End with 2 rows of Evergreen.
Cast of.
Place a marker 18 (19) 20 stitches into the back on each side

Front

The front is knitted in the same way as the back until the work measures 16.1 (17.3) 18.5 inches (41 (44) 47cm).
Neckline:
Knit 18 (19) 20 stitches, cast off 32 (34) 36 stitches and knit till the end of the row.
Knit just beyond these stitches till your work measures 19.7 (20.9) 22 inches (50 (53) 56 cm) = shoulder.
Knit 0.8 (0.8) 0.8 inches (2 (2) 2 cm) straight up. Finish with one row of Evergreen.
Cast off.
Knit the other side the same way.
Sew or knit the front to the back until you reach the stitch markers.

Sleeve

Cast on 40 (42) 44 stitches in Evergreen and knit the edge as you did on the back.
Continue the pattern by increasing 1 stitch every 10th row until you have 64 (68) 72 stitches.
Knit straight up till your work measures approx. 19.7 inches (50 cm). Finish with 2 rows of Evergreen.
Cast off in Evergreen.
Knit the other sleeve the same way.

Neckline

Sew the right shoulder seam together.

Knit the stitches of the neck in Evergreen and knit 4 rows knitwise by knitting 2 stitches together knitwise in each corner (= 4 times) on each row. Cast off loosely.

Sew the left shoulder seam and the neckline together.

Assembly

Sew the sleeves onto the indentation of the arm hole, sew the top 1.2-1.6 inches (3-4 cm) of the sleeve to the closure of the arm hole, sew the rest of the sleeve together.

Sew the side seams together.



The sleeve is sewn to the blouse in the indentation and the top of the sleeve seam is sewn to the closure.
