

KNITTING PATTERN

Marianne Top

Design: Knit Gang | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

3 (4) 4 skeins of Acacia color 17

Knitting needles 4 mm (US 6) Knitting needles 4.5 mm (US 7)

YARN QUALITY

Acacia, Hobbii 51% acrylic, 49% cotton 100 g (3.5) = 250 m (273 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4'' x 4'') = 20 sts x 28 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

st/s = stitch/es k = knit p = purl k2tog = knit 2 sts together k3tog = knit 3 sts together CO = Cast On BO = Bind Off yo = yarn over

SIZE

S (M) L

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 48 (52) 56 cm / 18.8" (20.4") 22" Length: 50 (54) 58 cm / 19.6" (21.2") 22.8"

PATTERN INFORMATION

An easy to make top with a ruffle bottom and a deep back. Made in a soft cotton blend perfect for summer!

INFO AND TIPS

The top consists of two pieces, front and back, sewn together at the end. Stitches used in the pattern:

Stockinette stitch knit in odd rows, purl in even rows.

BODY BACK PIECE

CO 242 (254) 262 sts on 4 mm needles. Work 16 (16) 22 rows in stockinette stitch.

On row 17 (17) 23 reduce the number of sts by working as follows: 1 edge st, $k2\log$ k3tog alternating across the entire row, 1 edge st = 96 (104) 112 sts. Knit the next row in stockinette stitch.

Now change to 4,5 mm needles and work in stockinette stitch. This will be the first row from which you will count the following rows. Work straight 46 (58) 64 rows.

Now start forming the underarms:

BO on both sides of the back, in every other row: 4 sts, 3 sts and then 5 x 1 st.

In row 61 (70) 79, divide the sts on the needle in two and place a marker. From this point on, the two parts will be made separately.

Form the neckline on both sides like this: in every 3rd row work k2tog from the neckline side. Repeat for 62 rows. BO sts on the shoulders.

FRONT PIECE

Make the front the same way as the back, but start the neckline at row 81 (93) 99. Form the neckline on both sides like this: in every 2nd row work k2tog. Repeat for 42 rows.

Finishing

Sew the front and the back pieces together with mattress stitches.
