## MATERIALS

2 skeins of Hobbii Ribbon, "Rust" col 45

Crochet hook 6 mm (US H/9)

## YARN QUALITY

 **Ribbon**, Hobbii

100 % Cotton

250 g = 125 m

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

ch-sp = chain space

blo = back loop only

hdc = half double crochet

sk st = skip stitch

sl st = slip stitch

## SIZE

One size

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 28 cm / 11"

Length: 28 cm / 11"

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

Be careful not to miss the first dc after the ch-sps. Count your sts each round to check you haven't missed any,

## BODY

### Square 1

**Row 1:** Create a magic circle, work all sts in the magic circle.

Ch 2 (counts as dc), 3dc, \*ch 2, 4dc\* repeat \*\* two more times, ch 1, sc in top of ch-2.  
Knot magic circle to secure it.

(16 dc)

**Row 2 - 6:** Ch 2 (counts as dc), dc in ch-sp, \*dc in each st until next ch-sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) into ch-sp\*.

Repeat \*\* until last ch-sp. In last ch-sp 2 dc, ch 1, sc in top of ch-2

(32 dc)

Repeat four more times. Each row increases by 16 sts.

(96 dc)



**Row 7:** Ch 2 (counts as dc), dc in ch-sp, \*dc in each st until next ch-sp, (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) into ch-sp\*. Repeat \*\* until last ch-sp. In last ch-sp 2 dc, ch 2, sl st to ch-2

First square tie off and sew in the ends.

(112 dc)

### Square 2

Repeat Row 1 - 7 for the second square, but do not tie off after row 7. Instead proceed to Row 8.

**Row 8:** Ch 2, \*hdc 3rd blo across until ch-sp, 2 hdc in each ch-sp\*, repeat \*\* once more, hdc 3rd blo until last dc before ch-sp, turn

(92 hdc)

**Row 9:** Ch 2, hdc in each st round until end, tie off and sew in ends.

(92 hdc)

## SEAM

Place squares on top of each other with ws facing you.



Using a needle seam the sides together, starting at the first dc after ch-sp.

Go through both loops on the second square and the 3rd loop only of the first square.

When you reach the 2 dcs in the ch-sp on the second square seam 2 dcs into 1 dc of the first square.

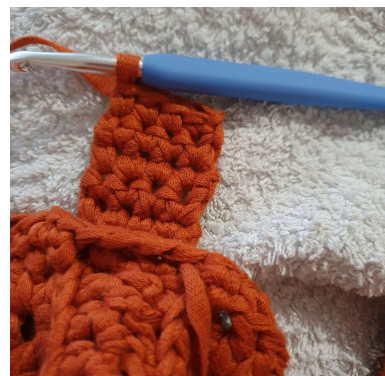
Continue around until the last dc before ch-sp. Leaving one side not seamed. Tie off and sew in the ends.

## BORDER

Attach yarn in dc after ch-sp

Ch 2, hdc blo in each st around until next ch-sp, ch 4 and dc in next dc.

Continue around until next ch-sp, ch 4 and sl st to first ch 2, tie off and sew in the ends.



## STRAP

Crochet back and forth

**Row 1:** Attach yarn in dcs under the 4 ch from border row. Ch 1 and sc across, turn

**Row 2-105:** Repeat Row 1 103 more times, tie off and sew strap under ch 4 from border row to the dcs.

(Total of 105 rows)
