MATERIALS

6 (7) 7 (8) 9 (9) 10 (10) 11 skeins of Metallico Espresso, color 13

Circular needle 5 mm (US 8), 40 cm (16") & 100 cm (40")

Stitch marker Tapestry needle Stitch holder

YARN QUALITY

Metallico, Hobbii
 70% Polyamide, 21% Acrylic, 9% Wool 50 g
 (1.75 oz) = 115 m (126 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 18 sts x 26 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit P = Purl Sts = stitches CO = cast on BO = bind off Rep = repeat SSK = slip slip knit K2TOG = knit 2 sts together WS = wrong side RS = Right side

SIZE

XS (S) M (L) XL (2XL) 3XL (4XL) 5XL

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 38 (43) 48 (53) 58 (64) 69 (74) 79 cm / 15" (17") 19" (21") 23" (25") 27" (29") 31" Length: 37 (38) 39 (42) 43 (44) 46 (47) 48 cm / 14.5" (15") 15.5" (16.5") 17" (17.5") 18" (18.5") 19

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Bleecker Street Turtleneck is a cropped turtleneck sweater with a relaxed fit and an extended ribbed cuff. The sweater is worked in the round and then divided for the front of back.

INFO AND TIPS

The sweater is worked in the round and then divided to create the front and back. The sleeves are picked up after the shoulders are seamed. Written for nine sizes: XS (S) M (L) XL (2XL) 3XL (4XL) 5XL

BODY

Turned hem:

CO 136 (154) 172 (190) 208 (226) 244 (262) 280 sts on 5mm 100 cm/40" circular needles, place stitch marker to mark the beginning of the round.

Round 1 – 4: K Round 5: P Round 6 – 9: K

You will now pick up stitches along the cast on edge and knit them together with your main stitches to create the turned hem.

Continue to knit in the round until the piece measures 20 cm/8".

You will now separate the back and front Row 1: K 63 (72) 81 (90) 97 (106) 115 (120) 129, BO 5 (5) 5 (5) 7 (7) 7 (11) 11, K 63 (72) 81 (90) 97 (106) 115 (120) 129, BO 5 (5) 5 (5) 7 (7) 7 (11) 11

Back Piece

Row 2: P Row 3: K Row 4: P



Repeat row 3 & 4 until piece measures 14 (15) 17 (19) 20 (22) 23 (24) 25 cm/ 5.5" (6") 6.5" (7.5") 8" (8.5") 9 (9.5") 10" Rows will restart for simplicity. Row 1: K 22 (26) 30 (34) 37 (41) 45 (46) 50, BO K 19 (20) 21 (22) 23 (24) 25 (28) 20, K 22 (26) 30 (34) 37 (41) 45 (46) 50).

Place stitches worked before bind off on a stitch holder and work stitches after bind off to form the left shoulder.

Left shoulder

Row 2 (WS): P Row 3 (RS): K1, SSK, Knit til end of row. 21 (25) 29 (33) 36 (40) 44 (45) 49 Row 4: P Row 5 (RS): K1, SSK, Knit til end of row. 20 (24) 28 (32) 35 (39) 43 (44) 48 Row 6: P Cast off stitches.

Right shoulder

Place stitches back on needles, reattach yarn at neckline Row 2 (WS): P Row 3 (RS): K until last 3 sts, K2TOG, K 1. 21 (25) 29 (33) 36 (40) 44 (45) 49 Row 4: P Row 5 (RS): K until last 3 sts, K2TOG, K 1. 20 (24) 28 (32) 35 (39) 43 (44) 48 Row 6: P Cast off stitches.

FRONT PIECE

Reattach the yarn on the purl side of the front. Set up row: P Row 1: K Row 2: P

Repeat row 1 & 2 until piece measures 9 (10) 11 (14) 15 (17) 18 (19) 20 cm/ 3.5" (4") 4.5" (5.5") 6" (6.5") 7 (7.5") 8" Rows will restart for simplicity.

Row 1: K 25 (29) 34 (38) 41 (45) 49 (51) 54, BO K 13 (14) 13 (14) 15 (16) 17 (18) 21, K 25 (29) 33 (38) 41 (45) 49 (51) 54.

Place stitches worked before bind off on a stitch holder and work stitches after bind off to form the right shoulder.

Right shoulder Sizes XS (S) Row 2 (WS): P



Row 3 (RS): K1, SSK, Knit til end of row. 24 (28) Row 4: P Row 5 - 12: Rep rows 3 & 4. 20 (24) Row 13: K Row 14: P Row 15 - 18: Rep rows 13 & 14 Cast off stitches.

Sizes M (L) XL (2XL), 3XL (5XL)

Row 2 (WS): P Row 3 (RS): K1, SSK, Knit til end of row. 33 (37) 40 (44) 48 (53) Row 4: P Row 5 - 14: Rep rows 3 & 4. 28 (32) 35 (39) 43 (48) Row 15: K Row 15: P Row 16: P Row 17 - 18: Rep rows 15 & 16. Cast off stitches.

Sizes 4XL

Row 2 (WS): P Row 3 (RS): K1, SSK, Knit til end of row. (51) Row 4: P Row 5 - 16: Rep rows 3 & 4. (44) Row 17: K Row 18: P Cast off stitches.

Left shoulder

Sizes XS (S) Row 2 (WS): P Row 3 (RS): K until the last 3 sts, K2TOG, K 1. 24 (28) Row 4: P Row 5 - 12: Rep rows 3 & 4. 20 (24) Row 13: K Row 14: P Row 15 - 18: Rep rows 13 & 14. Cast off stitches.

Sizes M (L) XL (2XL), 3XL (5XL)

Row 2 (WS): P Row 3 (RS): K until the last 3 sts, K2TOG, K 1. 33 (37) 40 (44) 48 (53) Row 4: P Row 5 - 14: Rep rows 3 & 4. 28 (32) 35 (39) 43 (48)



Row 15: K Row 16: P Row 17 - 18: Rep rows 15 & 16. Cast off stitches.

Sizes 4XL Row 2 (WS): P Row 3 (RS): K until the last 3 sts, K2TOG, K 1. (51) Row 4: P Row 5 - 16: Rep rows 3 & 4. (44) Row 17: K Row 18: P Cast off stitches. Seam shoulders together.

NECK RIBBING

Starting back right neck at bind off, pick up 20 (20) 22 (22) 24 (24) 26 (28) 30 sts across back neck, 15 (17) 16 (18) 16 (21) 21 (22) 21 sts up and over shoulder down to front, 14 (14) 14 (14) 16 (16) 18 (18) 22 sts across front neck, 15 (17) 16 (18) 16 (21) 21 (22) 21 sts up and over shoulder for a total of 64 (68) 68 (72) 72 (82) 86 (90) 94 sts.

Place marker on the beginning of the round. Knit in 1x1 rib (K1, P1) until ribbing measures 20 cm/8". Bind off using tubular bind off.

SLEEVES

Using your 16" 5mm needles, pick and knit 62 (68) 72 (80) 88 (92) 96 (104) 110. Knit in the round in stockinette until the sleeve measures 33 cm/13".

For the next round, K2TOG until you reach the end of the round. 31 (34) 36 (40) 44 (46) 48 (52) 55 sts remaining.

For the next round, *K2, K2TOG* 7 (8) 8 (10) 10 (10) 12 (12) 13 times then knit any remaining stitches until you reach the end of the round. 24 (26) 28 (30) 34 (36) 36 (40) 42 sts remaining.

Ribbing

Knit in 1x1 rib (K1, P1) until ribbing measures 10 cm/4". Bind off using tubular bind off. Repeat for the other sleeve.
