(220) Rainbow Bamboo, Hobbii

60 \% bamboo, 40 \% cotton $100 \mathrm{~g}(3.5 \mathrm{oz})=250 \mathrm{~m}(273 \mathrm{yds})$

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=20 \mathrm{dc} \times 10$ rows

This cardigan is crochet from the top down, then joining yarn to make the sleeves and edging. The chest size will have a positive ease of 1-2 inches.

## INFO AND TIPS

Each row is starting with a ch1, then either double or single crochet in the same.
$3 l o$ at the beginning of the row means to work all stitches in that row into the 3rd loop.

It can be crochet into the normal loop but it won't have a ridge effect.

It can be made without the ruffle on the last row just do one dc into each stitch instead of three.

Row 1 (mc) chain 57, sc in the second chain from hook, sc 7, 3 sc in the next, sc 9, 3 sc in the next, sc 18, 3 sc in the next, sc 9, 3 sc in the next, sc 8. (64) Turn

Row 2 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc $8,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next, dc $11,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next, $\mathrm{dc} 20,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next, dc 11, 3 dc in the next, dc 9. (72) Turn

Row 3 (cc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 9,3 sc in the next, sc 13,3 sc in the next, sc 22,3 sc in the next, sc 13,3 sc in the next, sc 10. (80) Turn

Row 4 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc 10, 3 dc in the next, dc 15, 3 dc in the next, dc 24, 3 dc in the next, dc 15, 3 dc in the next, dc 11. (88) Turn

## Dividing for armholes

Row 10 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc 16, 3 dc in the next, skip 27, 3 dc in the next, dc 36, 3 dc in the next, skip 27, 3 dc in the next, dc 17. (82) Turn

Row 11 (cc) ch1, sc in the same, sc to end. (82) Turn
Row 12 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc to end. (82) Turn
Repeat rows 11 and 12 until work measures 8" from shoulder, then complete the last row if you want to add ruffles.

Last row (mc) ch1, 3 dc in the same, 3 dc in each stitch to the end, then continue to the button band on page 12.

## Sleeves

Start the sleeves by joining yarn to the first unworked stitch under the arm. Where the gap under the arm is, add extra stitches. (this prevents a gap under the arm)

Row 1 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc to end, slst to the first. (34) Turn
Row 2 (cc) ch1, sc in same, sc to end, slst to the first. (34) Turn
Repeat rows 1 and 2 until the sleeve measures 7.5" from the shoulder.

## Cuff

Row 1 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc $1, * \mathrm{dec}, \mathrm{sc}$ * repeat $\times 10$, sc 2 , slst to the first. (24) Turn
Row 2-3 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc to end, slst to the first. (24) Turn
Fasten off.

## 0-3 Months

Row 1 (mc) chain 65 , sc in the second chain from hook, sc 9,3 sc in the next, sc 10,3 sc in the next, sc 20, 3 sc in the next, sc 10, 3 sc in the next, sc 10. (72) Turn

Row 2 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc 10, 3 dc in the next, $\mathrm{dc} 12,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next, $\mathrm{dc} 22,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next, dc 12, 3 dc in the next, dc 11. (80) Turn

Row 3 (cc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 11,3 sc in the next, sc 14,3 sc in the next, sc 24,3 sc in the next, sc 14, 3 sc in the next, sc 12. (88) Turn

Row 11 (cc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 19, 3 sc in the next, skip 30, 3 sc in the next, sc 40,3 sc in the next, skip 30, 3 sc in the next, sc 20. (92) Turn

Row 12 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc to end. (92) Turn

Row 13 (cc) ch1, sc in the same, sc to end. (92) Turn

Repeat rows 12-13 until work measures 9" from shoulder, then complete the last row if you want to add ruffles.

Last row (mc) ch1, 3 dc in the same, 3 dc in each stitch to the end, then continue to the button band on page 12.

## Sleeves

Start the sleeves by joining yarn to the first unworked stitch under the arm. Where the gap under the arm is, add extra stitches. (this prevents a gap under the arm)

Row 1 (cc) ch1, sc in same, sc to end, slst to the first. (36) Turn
Row 2 (mc) (work all stitches in bbo) ch1, dc in same, dc to end, slst to the first. (36) Turn

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until the sleeve measures $8.5^{\prime \prime}$ from the shoulder.

## Cuff

Row 1 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc $1,{ }^{*} \mathrm{dec}, \mathrm{sc}^{*} \times 10$, sc 4, slst to the first. (26) Turn
Row 2-3 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc to end, slst to the first. (26) Turn

Fasten off.

## 3-6 Months

Row 1 (mc) chain 73, sc in the second chain from hook, sc 10, 3 sc in the next, sc 11,3 sc in the next, sc 24,3 sc in the next, sc 11, 3 sc in the next, sc 11. (80) Turn

Row 2 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc 11.3 dc in the next, $\mathrm{dc} 13,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next, $\mathrm{dc} 26,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next, dc 13, 3 dc in the next, dc 12. (88) Turn

Row 3 (cc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 12,3 sc in the next, sc 15,3 sc in the next, sc 28,3 sc in the next, sc 15, 3 sc in the next, sc 13. (96) Turn

Row 4 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc 13, 3 dc in the next, dc 17, 3 dc in the next, dc 30, 3 dc in the next, dc 17, 3 dc in the next, dc 14. (104) Turn

Row 14 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc to end. (102) Turn

Repeat rows 13 and 14 until work measures $10^{\prime \prime}$ from shoulder, then complete the last row if you want to add ruffles.

Last row (mc) ch1, 3 dc in the same, 3 dc in each stitch to the end, then continue to the button band on page 12.

## Sleeves

Start the sleeves by joining yarn to the first unworked stitch under the arm. Where the gap under the arm is, add extra stitches. (this prevents a gap under the arm)

Row 1 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in same, dc to end, slst to the first. (38) Turn
Row 2 (cc) ch1, sc in same, sc to end, slst to the first. (38) Turn
Repeat rows 1 and 2 until the sleeve measures $10^{\prime \prime}$ from the shoulder.

## Cuff

Row 1 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 7, *dec, sc* repeat to end, slst to the first. (28) Turn
Row 2-3 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc to end, slst to the first. (28) Turn
Fasten off.

## 6-12 Months

Row 1 (mc) chain 81, sc in the second chain from hook, sc $12,3 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next, $\mathrm{sc} 12,3 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next, sc 26,3 sc in the next, sc 12,3 sc in the next, sc 13. (88) Turn

Last row (mc) ch1, 3 dc in the same, 3 dc in each stitch to the end, then continue to the button band on page 12.

## Sleeves

Start the sleeves by joining yarn to the first unworked stitch under the arm. Where the gap under the arm is, add extra stitches. (this prevents a gap under the arm)

Row 1 (cc) ch1, sc in same, sc to end, slst to the first. (40) Turn
Row 2 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in same, dc to end, slst to the first. (40) Turn

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until the sleeve measures 12" from the shoulder.

## Cuff

Row 1 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 1, dec, *sc 1, dec* repeat to end, slst to the first. (30) Turn Row 2-3 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc to end, slst to the first. (30) Turn
Fasten off.

## 1-2 Years

Row 1 (mc) chain 87 , sc in the second chain from hook, sc $13,3 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next, sc $12,3 \mathrm{sc}$ in the next, sc 30, 3 sc in the next, sc 12, 3 sc in the next, sc 14. (94) Turn

Row 2 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc 14.3 dc in the next, dc 14, 3 dc in the next, dc 32, 3 dc in the next, dc 14, 3 dc in the next, dc 15. (102) Turn

Row 3 (cc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 15,3 sc in the next, sc 16,3 sc in the next, sc 34,3 sc in the next, sc 16,3 sc in the next, sc 16. (110) Turn

Repeat rows 15 and 16 until work measures 12.5" from shoulder, then complete the last row if you want to add ruffles.

Last row (mc) ch1, 3 dc in the same, 3 dc in each stitch to the end, then continue to the button band on page 12.

## Sleeves

Start the sleeves by joining yarn to the first unworked stitch under the arm. Where the gap under the arm is, add extra stitches (this prevents a gap under the arm)

Row 1 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc to end, slst to the first. (42) Turn
Row 2 (cc) ch1, sc in same, sc to end, slst to the first. (42) Turn

Repeat rows 1 and 2 until the sleeve measures 13" from the shoulder.

## Cuff

Row 1 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 3, dec, *sc 1, dec* x 9, slst to the first. (30) Turn
Row 2-3 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc to end, slst to the first. (30) Turn
Fasten off.

Row 12 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc 26, 3 dc in the next, dc 36,3 dc in the next, dc 54, 3 dc in the next, dc 36, 3 dc in the next, dc 27. (192) Turn

Row 13 (cc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 27,3 sc in the next, sc 38,3 sc in the next, sc 56,3 sc in the next, sc 38, 3 sc in the next, sc 28. (200) Turn

Row 14 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc $28,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next, dc $40,3 \mathrm{dc}$ in the next, dc 58, 3 dc in the next, dc 40, 3 dc in the next, dc 29. (208) Turn

## Dividing for armholes

Row 15 (cc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 29, 3 sc in the next, skip 42, 3 sc in the next, sc 60, 3 sc in the next, skip 42, 3 sc in the next, sc 30. (132) Turn

Row 16 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in the same, dc to end. (132) Turn

Row 17 (cc) ch1, sc in the same, sc to end. (132) Turn

Repeat rows 16 and 17 until work measures $14^{\prime \prime}$ from shoulder, then complete the last row if you want to add ruffles.

Last row (mc) ch1, 3 dc in the same, 3 dc in each stitch to the end, then continue to the button band on page 12.

## Sleeves

Start the sleeves by joining yarn to the first unworked stitch under the arm. Where the gap under the arm is, add extra stitches. (this prevents a gap under the arm)

Row 1 (cc) ch1, sc in same, sc to end, slst to the first. (46) Turn
Row 2 (mc) (3lo) ch1, dc in same, dc to end, slst to the first. (46) Turn
Repeat rows 1 and 2 until the sleeve measures 15" from the shoulder.

## Cuff

Row 1 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc 3, dec, *sc 1, dec* repeat to end, slst to the first. (32) Turn

Row 2-3 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc to end, slst to the first. (32) Turn

Fasten off.

## Button and Buttonhole bands all sizes

## Button band

Row 1 (mc) continue from the last row of body, ch1, 1 sc in the same, sc evenly to the top. Turn

Row 2 (mc) Ch1, sc in the same and each stitch back to bottom. Turn

Row 3 (mc) Ch1, sc in the same and each stitch.

Fasten off.

## Buttonhole band

Row $1(\mathrm{mc})$ join yarn to the top of the right hand side of the front edge, ch1, 1 sc in the same, work sc evenly across. Turn

Mark out where you want the button holes, on the next row ch1 and skip the one where the markers are.

Buttonhole row
Row 2 (mc) ch1, sc in the same, sc all, but ch1 and skip 1, where markers are to create button holes. Turn

Row 3 (mc) ch1, sc in same, sc in all including chains.
Fasten off and sew your buttons on to match the button holes and weave in all ends.
