## MATERIALS

Rainbow Cotton 8/8
9 (10) 10 skeins of color Powder Rose (063)
1 skein of color Beige (004)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US J/10)
Crochet hook 5 mm (US I/9)
Stitch markers

## YARN QUALITY

(93) Rainbow Cotton 8/8, Hobbii
$50 \mathrm{~g}(1.8 \mathrm{oz})=75 \mathrm{~m}$ (82 yds)

## GAUGE

$10 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)=16$ sts $\times 12$ rows with 6 mm hook

## INFO AND TIPS

This raglan cardigan is worked from top to bottom. It is made with sc alternating between rows in flo and blo, which gives it a loose structure.
Ch 1 at the beginning of a row does not count as a stitch.
To maintain the structure of the stitch, the sleeves are not worked in the round, after each row, join it with a sl st, turn the piece and continue in the other direction.
You can, of course, make a longer cardigan or sleeves, but remember that the amount of yarn given in the description is suitable for a cardigan with the specified measurements.

## BODY

With 6 mm hook and Powder Rose yarn, ch 51.
NOTE: Remember that you work alternately in the front loop or the back loop!
Row 1: sc in every ch, ch 1, turn (51)
Row 2 (FLO): 2 sc in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each ch to last ch, 2 sc in last ch, ch 1, turn (52)

Row 3 (BLO): $2 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next st, 10 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next st, 24 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch}$ $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next st, 10 sc , $(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in next st, 2 sc , ch 1 , turn ( 60 sts )
Row 4: 2 sc in $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{st}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$, ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $12 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $26 \mathrm{sc},(1$ sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 12 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last st, ch 1, turn ( 70 sts )
Row 5: $5 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $14 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc})$ in ch sp, 28 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 14 sc , ( 1 sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 5 sc , ch 1 , turn ( 78 sts )
Row 6: $6 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $16 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc})$ in ch sp, $30 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc})$ in ch sp, 16 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 6 sc , ch 1 , turn ( 86 sts )
Row 7: 2 sc in $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{st}$,6 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch $\mathrm{sp}, 18 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $32 \mathrm{sc},(1$
sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 18 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $6 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last st, ch 1 , turn ( 96 sts )
Row 8: 9 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 20 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 34 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $20 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $9 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1$, turn ( 104 sts )
Row 9: $10 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $22 \mathrm{sc},(1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc})$ in ch sp, 36 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 22 sc, ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 10 sc , ch 1, turn ( 112 sts )

Row 10: 2 sc in $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{st}$,10 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch $\mathrm{sp}, 24 \mathrm{sc}$, ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch $\mathrm{sp}, 38 \mathrm{sc},(1$ sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 24 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $10 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last st, ch 1 , turn ( 122 sts ) Row 11: 13 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 26 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 40 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 26 sc, ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 13 sc , ch 1, turn ( 130 sts )
Row 12: 14 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 28 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 42 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 28 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 14 sc , ch 1, turn ( 138 sts )
Row 13: 2 sc in $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{st}$,14 sc , ( 1 sc , ch 1, 1 sc ) in ch sp, 30 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $44 \mathrm{sc},(1$ sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 30 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $14 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last st, ch 1, turn ( 148 sts )
Row 14: 17 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 32 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 46 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 32 sc, ( 1 sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 17 sc , ch 1, turn (156 sts)
Row 15: 18 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 34 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 48 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 34 sc, ( 1 sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 18 sc , ch 1, turn ( 164 sts )
Row 16: 2 sc in $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{st}$,18 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch $\mathrm{sp}, 36 \mathrm{sc}$, ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $50 \mathrm{sc},(1$ sc, ch 1, 1 sc) in ch sp, 36 sc ( 1 sc ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $18 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last st, ch 1, turn (174 sts)
Row 17: 21 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 38 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 52 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 38 sc , ( 1 sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 21 sc , ch 1, turn ( 182 sts )
Row 18: 22 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 40 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 54 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 40 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 22 sc , ch 1, turn ( 190 sts )
Row 19: 2 sc in $1 \mathrm{st} \mathrm{st}$,22 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 42 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $56 \mathrm{sc},(1$ sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 42 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $22 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last st, ch 1, turn ( 200 sts )
Row 20: 25 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 44 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 58 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 44 sc, ( 1 sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 25 sc, ch 1, turn (208 sts)

## S size - finish here and go to the sleeves separation section.

Row 21: 26 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 46 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 60 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 46 sc, ( 1 sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 26 sc , ch 1, turn ( 216 sts)
Row 22: 2 sc in 1st st, 26 sc , ( 1 sc , ch 1, 1 sc ) in ch sp, 48 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $62 \mathrm{sc},(1$ sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 48 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $26 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last st, ch 1, turn ( 226 sts )
Row 23: 29 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 50 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 64 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 50 sc, ( 1 sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 29 sc , ch 1, turn ( 234 sts )

## M size - finish here and go to the sleeves separation section.

Row 24: 30 sc , ( 1 sc , ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 52 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 66 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 52 sc, ( 1 sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 30 sc , ch 1, turn ( 242 sts)
Row 25: 2 sc in 1st st, 30 sc , ( 1 sc , ch 1, 1 sc ) in ch sp, 54 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $68 \mathrm{sc},(1$ sc, ch $1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, 54 sc , ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in ch sp, $30 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{sc}$ in last st, ch 1, turn ( 252 sts )

L size - finish here and go to the sleeves separation section.

## SLEEVES SEPARATION

Row 1 (continue alternating): work 26 (30) 33 sc, 1 sc in ch sp, ch 7, skip the next scs (the sleeve) and join with 1 sc into the next ch sp, 1 sc in each st across to next ch sp, [60 (66) 70 sc], 1 sc in ch sp, ch 7, skip the next scs (the sleeve) and join with 1 sc into the next ch sp, 26 (30) 33 sc, ch 2, turn [130 (144) 154 sts]

S size

Row 2: 2 sc in 1st st, 1 sc in each st to the last st, 2 sc in the last st, ch 1, turn (132 sts)
Row 3: 1 sc in each st to end, ch 2, turn (132 sts)
Row 4: repeat row 3 (132 sts)
Row 5: repeat row 2 (134 sts)
Row 6: 1 sc in each st across to end, ch 1 , turn
Continue until the piece measures 45 cm , or until you reach the desired length.

## M size

Row 2: 1 sc in each st across to end, ch 1, turn (144 sts)
Continue until the piece measures 45 cm , or until you reach the desired length.

## L size

Row 2: 1 sc in each st to end, ch 1, turn (154 sts)
Row 3: repeat row 2 (154 sts)
Row 4: 2 sc in 1st st, 1 sc in each st to last st, 2 sc in last st, ch 1, turn (156 sts)
Row 5: 1 sc in each st across to end, ch 1, turn (156 sts)
Continue until the piece measures 50 cm , or until you reach the desired length.

Now you are going to work around the edge of the cardigan, you should do it on the right side starting from the bottom right corner. So if your last row is on the wrong side, cut off the yarn and attach it in the bottom right corner on the right side of the cardigan.

Work the sc loosely along the edge (1 sc per row) going up through the neck and back down. When you get to the left corner start working the bottom edge but with sls.
After you have worked the bottom edge, when you get to where you started, work the edge of the cardigan again heading up, through the neck, and then down, but this time loosely with $\mathbf{s l}$ sts. Close with a sl st to the $1^{\text {st }}$ st.

## SLEEVES

Attach the yarn in the middle, to the 4th chain under the armpit in a corresponding loop [blo (flo) blo] and ch 1.
Row 1-29: 1 sc in each st to end, join with sl st to the first st, ch 1, turn [46 (52) 56 sts]
Row 30: work sc, dec 4 times at equal lengths join with sl st to the first st, ch 1, turn [42 (48) 52].
Row 31: repeat row 1.
Row 32: work sc, dec 2 times at equal lengths join with sl st to the first st, ch 1, turn [40 (46) 50].
Row 33-35: repeat row 1.
Finish by making a round with sl st on the right side of the sleeve.

Make the second sleeve in the same way.

## POCKETS

Make 2.

With a 5 mm hook and Powder Rose yarn make a magic ring and ch 3 (counts as the $1^{\text {st }}$ tr). Round 1: 11 tr in the magic ring, close with sl st to ch 3 . Fasten off. ( 12 sts )

Round 2: attach the Beige yarn, ch 2, 1 dc in the same st, 2 dc in each st, close with sl st to ch 2 and ch 1. (24 sts)
Round 3: (sc, hdc) in next st, (dc, tr) in next st, (3 tr) in next st, (dc, tr) in next st, (sc, hdc) in next st, sl st in next st = one petal, repeat 3 more times join the last petal with sl st to the ch 1.

Round 4: sc in each st, working a sl st in each sl st between petals, join the round with a sl st, fasten off.
Round 5: attach the Powder Rose yarn to row 3, between two petals, and ch 3. Work *2 dc, 2 sc, 2 sc in the next st, (sc, ch 1, sc) in the next st (to the middle tr of the previous round), 2 sc in the next st, $2 \mathrm{sc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$, tr to the sl st of the previous round 3 (insert the hook to the st, pull the loop loosely to the height of row 4 and make a tr)*. Repeat from * to * 3 times finishing with a sl st in ch 3 after the last petal. Ch 1.
Round 6-7: sc around, working ( $1 \mathrm{sc}, \mathrm{ch} 1,1 \mathrm{sc}$ ) in each corner.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail to sew.

Sew the pockets in a place you like, tucking the edges inward.
Secure and weave all ends.
