



KNITTING PATTERN

Grandpa

Cardigan

MATERIALS

Color A: 9 (10) 11 (12) skeins of Tweed Delight, Pickles (21)

Color B: 1 (1) 1 (1) skein of Winter Glow Solid, Cream (02)

Color C: 1 (1) 1 (1) skein of Winter Glow Solid, Copper (24)

Circular needle 5mm (US 8) 100 cm (39.3")

Stitching needle

Stitch marker

YARN QUALITY

 **Tweed Delight**, Hobbii

85 % Wool, 10% Acrylic, 5 % Viscose

50g (1.07 oz) = 100 m (109 yds)

 **Winter Glow Solid**, Hobbii

51% Wool, 49% Acrylic

100 g (3.5 oz) = 350 m (382 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 15 sts x 22 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

K = knit

P = Purl

YO1: Yarn over 1

Sl1 K1 PSSO = Slip 1 st, knit 1 st, pass over slipped st

K2tog = knit 2 together

P2Tog = Purl 2 together

BO = bind off

SM = stitch marker

k1 f&b = Knit a stitch, leaving stitch on left needle; knit into the back loop of this stitch.

SIZE

S (M) L (XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 62 (63) 65 (66) cm / 24.4" (24.8") 25.6" (25.9")

Length: 64 (66) 68 (70) cm / 25.2" (26") 26.7" (27.6")

PATTERN INFORMATION

Simple oversized cardigan made with seamless knitting techniques and beautiful embroidery. An easy pattern for beginners and intermediate knitter. The pattern is a mix of flat knitting and circular knitting.

INFO AND TIPS

Before you knit this cardigan, test your gauge. Always mark your sides and centre, and mark your rows so you don't lose count.

Tips: as you change from color A to B don't cut the yarn. This will reduce the loose ends.

BODY

Back rib edge

Cast on 91 (93) 95 (97) stitches. Knit rib stitches (1p, 1k).

Start with a purl stitch

Row 1-4: color A

Row 5-6: color B

Row 7-8: color A

Row 9-12: color C

Row 13-14: color A

Front rib edge (make 2 front panels)

Cast on 41 (42) 43 (44) sts. Knit rib stitches (1p, 1k).

Start with a purl stitch

Row 1- 4: color A

Row 5-6: color B

Row 7-8: color A

Row 9-12: color C

Row 13-14: color A

Now join all the pieces together to work the whole body. Line it up like this:

Left front rib edge 41 (42) 43 (44), place SM, Back rib edge 91 (93) 95 (97), place SM, Right front rib edge 41 (42) 43 (44)

(Left piece) Knit until there are 2 sts left on the left panel, k1 f&b, K1. *(Back piece)* K1, k1 f&b, knit until there are 2 sts left on the back piece, k1 f&b, K1. *(Right piece)* K1, k1 f&b, knit until the end.

Continue in stockinette sts until the work measures 30 (32) 34 (36) cm / 11.8" (12.6") 13.4" (14.2)" measured from the rib edge (approx. 74 (78) 82 (86) rows)

Knit until 3 sts before the first SM, BO 6. Knit until 3 sts before the next Sm BO 6. Knit until the end of the row.

Left shoulder

39 (40) 41 (42) sts on the needle

From the wrong side

Row 1: P all

Row 2: K 2, Sl1 K1 PSSO, K until the last 4 sts, K2tog, K 2

Row 3: P all

Row 4: K 2, Sl1 K1 PSSO, K until end of row

Row 5: P all

Row 6: K 2, Sl1 K1 PSSO, K until the last 4 sts, K2tog, K 2

Row 7: P all

Row 8: K all

Row 9: P all

Row 10: *K until the last 4 sts, K2tog, K 2

Row 11: P all

Row 12: K all

Row 13: P all*

Repeat Row *10-13* another 7 (7) 8 (8) times = 26 (27) 27 (28) stitches on the needle

Shoulder shaping, left shoulder

BO on the right side

Row 14: BO 5, K until last 4 sts, K2tog, K 2

Row 15: P all

Row 16: BO 5, K until end of row

Row 17: P all

Row 18: BO 5 (5) 5 (5) sts, K until end of row

Row 19: P all

Row 20: BO 5 (5) 5 (6) sts, K until end of row

Row 21: P all

Row 22: BO 5 (6) 6 (6) sts = 0 sts on the needle

Right shoulder

39 (40) 41 (42) sts on the needle

From the wrong side

Row 1: P all

Row 2: K 2, Sl1 K1 PSSO, K until the last 4 sts, K2tog, K 2

Row 3: P all

Row 4: K until the last 4 sts, K2tog, K 2

Row 5: P all

Row 6: K 2, Sl1 K1 PSSO, K until the last 4 sts, K2tog, K 2

Row 7: P all

Row 8: K all

Row 9: P all

Row 10: K 2, Sl1 K1 PSSO, K until end of row

Row 11: P all

Row 12: K all

Row 13: P all

Repeat Row *10-13* another 7 (7) 8 (8) times = 26 (27) 27 (28) stitches on the needle

Shoulder shaping, right shoulder

BO off on the the wrong side

Row 14: Knit 2, Sl1 K1 PSSO, K until end of row

Row 15: BO 5 purlwise, P until end of row

Row 16: K all

Row 17: BO 5 purlwise, P until end of row

Row 18: K all

Row 19: BO 5 (5) 5 (5) purlwise, P until end of row

Row 20: K all

Row 21: BO 5 (5) 5 (6) purlwise, P until end of row

Row 22: K all

Row 23: BO 5 (6) 6 (6) sts = 0 sts on the needle

BACK PIECE

Transfer the 87 (89) 91 (93) stitches to the working needle. Start on the wrong side.

Row 1: P all

Row 2: *K2, Sl1 K1 PSSO, K until the last 4 sts, K2tog, K2

Row 3: P all*

Repeat Row *2-3* another 2 times = 81 (83) 85 (87) sts on the needle

Continue 11,5 (11,5) 12,5 (13) cm / 4.5" (4.5") 4.9" (4.9") in stockinette sts (approx. 28 (28) 32 (32) rows). The back panel will be slightly shorter than the front.

Cast off

Shoulder joining

Line up the front and back shoulder line and use a stitching needle to stitch the front and back together.

SLEEVES

Worked top down in circular knitting

Pick up 60 (62) 64 (66) stitches using the 5mm needle and color A.

Place a SM to mark the beginning of the round in the centre under the arm

Row 1-10: K all

Row 11: K 1, K2tog, K until the last 3 sts, S11 K1 PSSO, K1

Continue in stockinette sts and repeat the decreases on every 11th round a total of 7 times
= 44 (46) 48 (50) stitches on your needle.

Continue until desired length before rib edge

Rib edge

In rib (1 K, 1 P)

Round 1: * K1, P2tog, K1, P1* repeat *-* until end of round

Round 2: Rib

Round 3-6: Rib with color C

Round 7-8: Rib with color A

Round 9-10: Rib with color B

Round 11-12: Rib with color A

Cast off

COLLAR

Pick up 232 (236) 240 (244) stitches using the 5mm needle and color A.

In rib (1 K, 1 P)

Row 1-4: Rib with color A

Row 5-8: Rib with color C

Round 9-10: Rib with color A

Cast off

Embroidery

Work with 2 yarns together when embroidery using color B & C.

Be as creative as you want. There are no rules on how you embellish your card!



Finishing

Slip in all the loose ends to finish your garment. Gently hand-wash and block.
