## MATERIALS

### Rainbow Lace

- 1 skein of White (001)
- 1 skein of Petunia Pink (087)
- 1 skein of Purple (039)
- 1 skein of Light Turquoise (034)
- 1 skein of Dark Green (022)
- 1 skein of Yellow (054)
- 1 skein of Orange (057)
- 1 skein of Pastel Yellow (053)
- 1 skein of Black (009)

Crochet hook 1,5 mm  
Stuffing  
4 pair of earring hooks  
Needle  
Locking stitch marker

## YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Lace**, Hobbii  
100% merzerized cotton  
50 g (1.75 oz) = 280 m (306 yds)

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain  
sc = single crochet  
1 inc = single crochet 2 stitches in the same  
stitch  
1 dec = single crochet 2 stitches together

## MEASUREMENTS

Lemon and watermelon slice 5 x 2 cm  
Cherries 4 x 4 cm  
Rainbow 3,5 x 1,5 cm

# Pattern



## **RAINBOW** (make 2)

*With Purple*

Chain 6, join

**Round 1:** [1 inc] x6 (12)

Change to Light Turquoise

**Round 2:** [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

Change to Dark Green

**Round 3:** 1 sc, 1 inc, [2 sc, 1 inc] x5, 1 sc (24)

Change to Yellow

**Round 4:** [3 sc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

Change to Orange

**Round 5:** 2 sc, 1 inc, [4 sc, 1 inc] x5, 2 sc (36)

Change to Petunia Pink

**Round 6:** [5 sc, 1 inc] x6 (42)

Cut the yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

Weave in all threads on the backside except for the first purple strand.

Fold the rainbow, use the purple thread to sew the purple sides together.

Start sewing the top part together, when you reach the middle top of the rainbow attach an earring hook and sew it on before closing the rainbow all the way.

## **CHERRIES** (make 4)

*With Petunia Pink*

Start with a magic ring

**Round 1:** 6 sc into the ring (6)

**Round 2:** [1 inc] x6 (12)

**Round 3:** [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

**Round 4:** [2 sc, 1 inc] x6 (24)

**Rounds 5-7:** 24 sc (3 rounds, 24)

**Round 8:** [2 sc, 1 dec] x6 (18)

**Round 9:** [1 sc, 1 dec] x6 (12)

Start stuffing the cherry

**Round 10:** [1 dec] x6 (6)

Sew the hole together and fasten the thread

When you have made all your cherries it is time to crochet the green part.

Using Dark Green.

Insert your hook into one of the cherries and pull up a loop, ch 10, then crochet 1 stitch through one of the earring hooks, make 1 sc into the last 3 chains. Ch 7. Finish with 1 stitch into the second cherry. Fasten all threads.

### **LEMON SLICE** (make 2)

With Pastel Yellow

Start with a magic ring

**Round 1:** 6 sc into the ring (6)

**Round 2:** [1 inc] x6 (12)

**Round 3:** [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

**Round 4:** 1 sc, 1 inc, [2 sc, 1 inc] x5, 1 sc (24)

**Round 5:** [3 sc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

**Round 6:** 2 sc, 1 inc, [4 sc, 1 inc] x5, 2 sc (36)

**Round 7:** [5 sc, 1 inc] x6 (42)

**Round 8:** 3 sc, 1 inc, [6 sc, 1 inc] x5, 3 sc (48)

Change to White

**Round 9:** [7 sc, 1 inc] x6 (54)

Change to Yellow

**Round 10:** 4 sc, 1 inc, [8 sc, 1 inc] x5, 4 sc (60)

Cut the yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

Fasten the rest of the threads onto the back.

Embroider slices onto the lemon using White.

Fold the lemon slice and sew it together. When you reach the top take an earring hook and sew it on.

### **WATERMELON SLICE** (make 2)

With Petunia Pink

Start with a magic ring

**Round 1:** 6 sc into the ring (6)

**Round 2:** [1 inc] x6 (12)

**Round 3:** [1 sc, 1 inc] x6 (18)

**Round 4:** 1 sc, 1 inc, [2 sc, 1 inc] x5, 1 sc (24)

**Round 5:** [3 sc, 1 inc] x6 (30)

**Round 6:** 2 sc, 1 inc, [4 sc, 1 inc] x5, 2 sc (36)

**Round 7:** [5 sc, 1 inc] x6 (42)

**Round 8:** 3 sc, 1 inc, [6 sc, 1 inc] x5, 3 sc (48)

Change to White

**Round 9:** [7 sc, 1 inc] x6 (54)

Change to Dark Green

**Round 10:** 4 sc, 1 inc, [8 sc, 1 inc] x5, 4 sc (60)

Cut the yarn but leave a long tail for sewing.

Fasten the rest of the threads onto the back.

Embroider seeds onto the watermelon using Black.

Fold the watermelon slice and sew it together. When you reach the top take an earring hook and sew it on.
