## Harper

Gloves

## MATERIALS

2 skeins of Friends Wool col Chocolate (12)

Double pointed needles 4 mm
Stitch markers
Darning needle

## YARN QUALITY

(64) Friends Wool, Hobbii

100\% wool, non superwash
$50 \mathrm{~g}(1.75 \mathrm{oz})=100 \mathrm{~m}(109 \mathrm{yds})$

## GAUGE

20 sts $\times 26$ rows $=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}\left(4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}\right)$ in stockinette stitch

## ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on
$\mathrm{K}=$ knit
P = purl
St(s) = stitches
K2tog $=$ knit 2 sts together
Tbl = through back loop
M1L = make 1 left (increase)
M1R = make 1 right (increase)
Beg = beginning

## SIZES

S (M) L (XL)

## MEASUREMENTS

Circumference: approx. 16,5 (18) 19,5 (22) cm/6.5 (7) 7.7 (8.7) inches
Length: approx. 25,5 (26) 26,5 (28) cm/10
(10.2) 10.4 (11) inches

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Nice basic gloves worked in the round on double pointed needles from the cuff-up. Matches the Harper Hat.

## TIPS AND INFO

## Increases

Make one right (M1R)
Pick up the vertical bar between two sts by inserting the left-hand needle from back to front, under the bar between the stitches. Knit this bar through the front loop.

## Make one left (M1L)

Pick up the vertical bar between two sts by inserting the left-hand needle from front to back, under the bar between the stitches. Knit this bar through the back loop.

## Gloves

CO 33 (36) 39 (42) sts and divide on double pointed needles.

## Cuff

Place maker at the beginning of round.
Work p2, k1 around until cuff measures 12 (12) 13 (13) cm / 4.7 (4.7) 5.1 (5.1) inches

## Continue in stockinette

Knit 3 (3) 3,5 (4) cm / 1.2 (1.2) 1.6 inches

## Increasing for the thumb

Size S: knit until and including round 12
Size M: knit until and including round 14
Size L: knit until and including round 14
Size XL: knit until and including round 16

1. round: $\mathrm{k} 1, \mathrm{M} 1 \mathrm{~L}$, knit until marker, $\mathrm{M} 1 \mathrm{R}=3$ sts for the thumb
2. round: Knit all sts
3. round: $\mathrm{k} 2, \mathrm{M} 1 \mathrm{~L}$, knit until 1 sts before marker, M1R, $\mathrm{k} 1=5$ sts for the thumb
4. round: Knit all sts
5. round: k3, M1L, knit until 2 sts before marker, M1R, $k 2=7$ sts for the thumb
6. round: Knit all sts
7. round: k4, M1L, knit until 3 sts before marker, M1R, k3 = 9 sts for the thumb
8. round: Knit all sts
9. round: k5, M1L, knit until 4 sts before marker, M1R, k4 = 11 sts for the thumb
10. round: Knit all sts
11. round: $k 6, M 1 L$, knit until 5 sts before marker, $M 1 R, k 5=13$ sts for the thumb
12. round: Knit all sts
13. round: $k 7$, M1L, knit until 6 sts before marker, M1R, $k 6=175$ sts for the thumb
14. round: Knit all sts
15. round: k8, M1L, knit until 7 sts before marker, M1R, $k 7=17$ sts for the thumb
16. round: Knit all sts

Knit until 6 (7) 7 (8) sts before the beginning of the round. Place the 13 (15) 15 (17) sts for the thumb to rest on a piece of yarn. CO $2(1) 2(1)$ new st(s) and knit until end $=34(36) 40(42)$ sts on round.

Place marker to mark the beg of round:
Size M(XL) after the newly CO stitch
Size $S(\mathrm{~L})$ between the 2 newly CO sts

Knit until the stockinette stitch measures approx. ca. 17 (18) 19 (20) cm / 6.7 (7) 7.5 (7.9) inches

## Decreasing for fingertips

Place marker to mark the side of the glove $=17(18) 20(21)$ sts for each part.

1. round: *k2tog tbl, knit until 3 sts before next marker, k2tog, 1k, k2tog tbl, knit until 3 sts before next marker, k2tog,1 k*
= 4 decreases

Repeat *_* 5 (5) 6 (6) times $=10$ (12) 12 (14) sts
k2tog until end of round $=5(6) 6(7)$ sts

Break yarn and pull tail through the sts, pull tight and weave in securely.

## Thumb

Move the 13 (15) 15 (17) sts onto double pointed needles and pick up and knit 2 (1) 2 (1) sts on the glove $=14(16) 17$ (19). Knit in the round until thumb measures approx. 5 (5½) 6 (7) cm/2 (2.2) 2.4 (2.8) inches.
K2tog until 5 (6) 6 (7) sts remain. Break yarn and pull tail through the sts, pull tight and weave in securely.

Fold cuff.

Make one more glove the same way.
