MATERIALS

1 skein of Amigo color 02
 1 skein of Amigo color 28
 1 skein of Amigo color 38
 1 skein of Amigo color 42

Double pointed needles 4 mm Darning needle Scissors

YARN QUALITY

Amigo, Hobbii
 100% HB acrylic 50 g (1.75 oz) = 175 m (191 yds)

GAUGE

10 cm x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 22 sts x 34 rows

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on K = knit P = purl St(s) = stitch(es) K2tog = knit 2 stitches together P2tog = purl 2 stitches together RS = right side of work WS = wrong side of work BO = bind off

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Sweater Width: approx. 13 cm/5.1 inches (from sleeve to sleeve) Length: approx. 6,5 cm/2.6 inches

Beanie / Christmas hat Width: 4,5 cm / 4,5 cm (1.8 inches / 1.8 inches) Length: 4 cm / 9 cm (1.6 inches / 3.5 inches)

TIPS AND INFO

The little sweaters are worked flat and sewn together afterwards. You will then pick up stitches for the collar and knit this around using double pointed needles.

The little hats are worked in the round using double pointed needles and are finished with a small pom-pom or tassel.

The pattern comes with several suggestions for colour combinations, but let your imagination run free.

BASE PATTERN: MINI-SWEATER

Front panel

CO 14 sts using 4 mm needles. work 2 rows of rib stitch (k1, p1) Work 12 rows of stockinette stitch (k on RS, p on WS).

BO for neck: k4, BO 6 sts, k4



Front panel, bind-off for neck





Cast-on for neck, back panel

Back and front panels finished



Back panel

Continue in stockinette stitch. First row is a WS-row: P4, CO 6 sts, p4 Work 12 rows of stockinette stitch Work 2 rows of rib stitch (k1, p1) BO

Sleeves

Pick up and knit 12 sts for sleeves (6 on each back and front panel) Work 8 rows of stockinette stitch. First row is a WS-row Work 1 row with decreases: p1, p2tog, p6, p2tog, p1 Work 2 rows of rib stitch (k1, p1) BO leaving approx. 20 cm (8 inches) of yarn tail for sewing.

Make the other sleeve the same way.

Picking up sts for collar

Collar

Pick up and knit 14 sts along the neck opening using double pointed needles 4 mm. Work 2 rows of rib stitch and bind off.

Finishing

Sew the sweater together with RS facing using mattress stitches. Fold the sweater and sew from sleeve to bottom hem.

Weave in ends.

Attach a loop at the back neck of the sweater if you want to use it for hanging.

VARIATION 1: STRIPES

Color A = main color Color B = stripe



Follow the base pattern and change colors as described:

Front panel

Work 4 rows with Color A Work 1 row with Color B Work 2 rows with Color A Work 1 row with Color B Work 2 rows with Color A Work 1 row with Color B Work 4 rows with Color A

Back panel

Work 4 rows with Color A Work 1 row with Color B Work 2 rows with Color A Work 1 row with Color B Work 2 rows with Color A Work 1 row with Color B Work 4 rows with Color A

Sleeves

Work 3 rows with Color A Work 1 row with Color B Work 2 rows with Color A Work 1 row with Color B Work 5 rows with Color A



VARIATION 2: Hearts



Make a white mini-sweater. Before sewing together, embroider little red hearts on the body of the sweater using Kitchener stitches.

Insert yarn from WS into the middle of a stitch. Sew under the two 'legs' of the stitch above, go back and insert the needle the same place it came out. Be careful not to pull the yarn too tight. Make as many hearts as you wish.





VARIATION 3: Dots



Make a green mini sweater. Before sewing together, embroider little yellow, red, and white dots on the sweater. Pick a color and wrap yarn 3 times around one leg of a stitch. Tie a knot on the WS of work after every dot. Make as many dots as you wish.

VARIATION 4: Snowflake



Make a red mini sweater. Before sewing together, embroider a white snowflake on the front of the sweater (see picture guide)

MINI-HATS



Beanie Work in the round using double pointed needles 4 mm

CO 20 sts. Work 2 rounds of rib stitch (p1, k1) Work 10 rounds of stockinette stitch

Decrease

1. round: *k2tog* until end. = 10 sts on needles

Cut yarn, pull the yarn tail through the 10 sts and weave in securely.

Make a mini pom-pom and attach it on top of your hat.

Christmas hat

Work in the round using double pointed needles 4 mm

CO 20 sts. Work 2 rounds of rib stitch (p1, k1) Work 14 rounds of stockinette stitch

Decrease 1. round: *k2, k2tog* until end. = 15 sts around.

Work 9 round of stockinette stitch

Decrease 1. round: *k2, k2tog* until end. = 10 sts around.

Cut yarn, pull the yarn tail through the 10 sts and weave in securely.

Make a mini pom-pom or small tassel and attach it on top of your hat.



Finishing Weave in ends Attack a loop to the hat for hanging (in the length you wish)
